INTRODUCING THE 1949 REDS

The 39 men comprising the Red squad represent a cross-section of our nation, hailing from 18 of the 48 states ranging from Virginia to Oregon.

The average Redleg is a big fellow, measuring 6 feet, 1 inch and weighing 190 pounds.

The average age of the players is slightly under 27 and only six have passed their thirtieth year. Veteran Harry Gumbert is the squad's senior member at 39 while catcher Hobert Landrith is the youngest at 19.

Eleven of the Reds' pitchers throw from the right side and six employ the unorthodox delivery. However, thirteen of the seventeen moundsmen bat right handed.

Of the remaining members of the squad, 16 bat right and six swing from the left side while 18 are orthodox throwers and four are left handers.

Only nine of the squadmen are unmarried and 26 Reds served their country in the armed forces in World War II.
