THE MANAGER

LOU BOUDREAU: Success in athletics has consistently been a part of the career of Lou Boudreau. About twenty years ago he was a member, the driving spark, of a high school basketball team in Harvey, Illinois, his home town, that achieved records that still make conversation pieces—the state finals for three consecutive years. Quite a record in Illinois.

Then Boudreau went on to the University of Illinois where he played on the great basketball teams of Doug Mills. And, of course, during the Spring he played baseball.

After university days Cedar Rapids and Buffalo were but brief interludes before a major league career started as a player and manager with Cleveland. Lou guided Cleveland to a pennant in 1948, nosing out the Red Sox and Yankees in one of the most hectic of all pennant races. That was the year the American League ended in a tie and play-off was necessary. Gene Bearden whipped Boston with a five hitter. Then the Indians went on to defeat the Boston Braves in six games in the world series.

Boston was the next baseball home for Boudreau. However, after three seasons with the Red Sox, he moved west as the new manager of the replanted Athletics. He was the man Arnold Johnson wanted for the job. His work last season warranted the confidence placed in him by the new owner.

In his playing days he was a catcher, a third baseman, a second baseman, and, of course, a very proficient shortstop. His versatility has developed in him depth, breadth, and baseball savvy that reflects in his sound managerial techniques. His drive, his successful background was evident last season as the new A's played with determination, hustle, and desire.

So, after the "new" year, Boudreau starts his second as pilot of a baseball club that will be working for a spot above the surprising sixth place finish of '55. And the fans of Kansas City believe they have the man who can get the job done. Lou Boudreau is their man.

THE COACHES

OSCAR MELILLO: A baseball veteran who has been associated with Lou Boudreau for many years. Melillo was on the strategy board at Cleveland and then went to Boston with Boudreau. A former infielder, Melillo was a member of the Milwaukee Brewers in the American Association and was accepted as one of the greatest at his position. He later enjoyed major league success with the St. Louis Browns.

HARRY CRAFT: Baseball, Kansas City, and Harry Craft have had a long and pleasant association. Craft was a member of the Cincinnati Reds in 1939 when that team was the champion of the National League. Later he played for the Blues under Billy Meyer. In the 1953 and 1954 seasons Craft managed the Kansas City entry in the American Association.

GEORGE SUSCE: Susce, like Melillo, has been with Manager Boudreau at Cleveland and Boston. Susce broke in with the Kansas City Blues in 1929, became one of the league's most able catchers and hitters while playing with Milwaukee. Susce spends most of his efforts and talents with the pitchers, and gets the relief pitchers ready from the bull pen.
