THE MANAGER

Robert Irving Elliott

Robert Irving Elliott became the third manager of the Kansas City Athletics last November to put at rest all sorts of conjectures as to the man who would succeed Harry Craft at the helm. Craft, who had served as a coach under Lou Boudreau, replaced the latter in the latter part of 1957, held the job through 1958 and '59 and then was offered a position in the organization's farm system.

Elliott, who had managed in the coast league, was highly recommended by a number of baseball men who had been impressed by the managerial skill he had exercised in the minor leagues. One of them referred to him as the best major league managerial prospect in the minors. Offered the position with the Athletics, Bob accepted with alacrity. This was the chance he had been waiting for.

This husky, blond, blue-eyed former outfielder and third baseman, who was a member of the National League champion Boston Braves in 1948, began with little knowledge of what talent he had, but that he stated, was no handicap. He had spent virtually all his major league career in the National League although near the end of it he was with Bill Veeck's St. Louis Browns when he was obtained by Frank Lane's Chicago White Sox. Bob joined the Sox when their fortunes were at low ebb but he proved the spark they needed to move up in the race. "One of the greatest hustlers I ever saw," Lane complimented after that 1953 year. "Bob played every game as though a championship hinged on it."

That pretty well describes the new manager of the Athletics—a man who believes that desire often can effect wonders and who will insist on that virtue with his athletes. There is no substitute for hustle, this 44-year-old skipper maintains.

Bill is happily married to a Missouri girl, the father of two daughters, one of whom is an air line hostess. Mrs. Elliott was Miss Skipper, her husband calls her Skippy. So it's the skipper and Skippy in a new and what he hopes will be a very happy alliance.

COACHES

Fred Fitzsimmons

Is making his debut as a member of an American League organization after 19 years as a winning pitcher for the New York Giants and Brooklyn Dodgers. He then managed

the Phillies for three years and coached for the Boston Braves, New York Giants, and Chicago Cubs.

"Fat Freddie" was one tough competitor. His lifetime record in the National League was 217 wins, 146 losses and his 1940 record of 16 wins against two losses while pitching for Brooklyn is still a league record. He was a master of defense on and around the pitching mound with every appendage of his body being used to stop batted balls.

Fitzsimmons is an off-season resident of Arcadia, California, the winter residence of Don Heffner, another A's coach.

Walker Cooper

Is finally home after 24 years of baseball. Buckner, Missouri, just east of Kansas City, is Coop's home and he'll now be able to commute daily to the Stadium.

Cooper played for every team in the National League with two exceptions — Brooklyn and Philadelphia. He is probably best known as the catcher on the Cooper-Cooper battery. Brother Mort was the pitcher. He was a member of pennant winning Cardinal teams in 1942, '43 and '44, but in 1946, after military duty, he was sold to the Giants for \$175,000.

For the past two baseball seasons Cooper has been managing Indianapolis in the American Association.

He is married and has one daughter, a former Miss Missouri, who is now employed by an airline.

Don Heffner

Is the sole alumnus of the American League on the coaching staff of Bob Elliot. Heffner played his major league baseball in the American League, and for the past several seasons has been a coach for the Athletics.

Baseball for the Athletics has practically become a year-round job for Heffner. He is with the Athletics during the spring, summer and early fall. Then off to Florida to work the balance of the fall and early winter with the young players in the Florida Instructional Program. And this routine is a pleasant one for the hard working Heffner who enjoys baseball and then, a degree or two behind, golf. And he gets his share of both.

For a few months each year the Heffners call Arcadia, California their home. Their daughter, Dorothy, is a student at Stanford University.

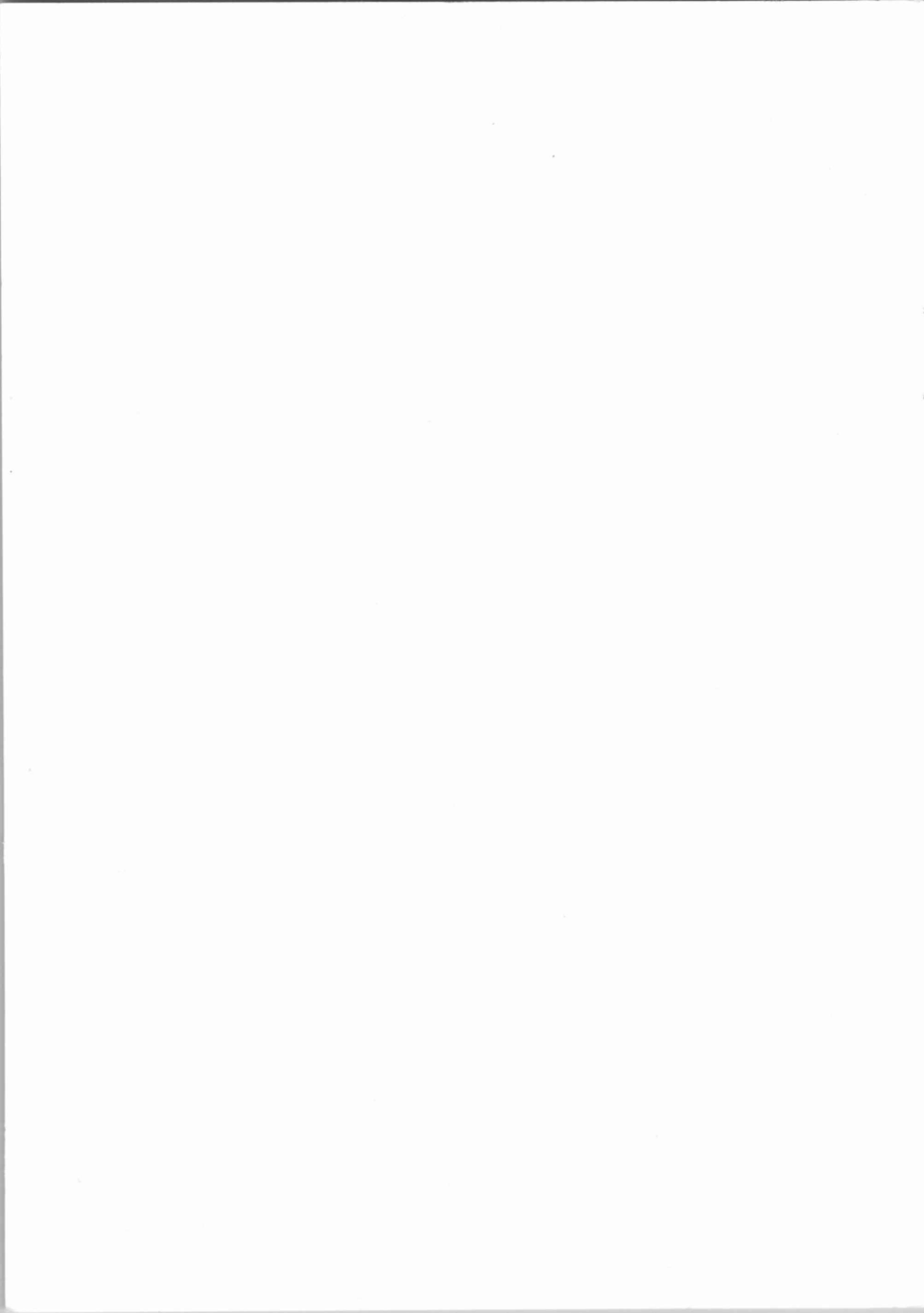
