THE MANAGER AND HIS STAFF

Ed Lopat

Number 30

Ed Lopat will be starting his first season as the A's manager. One of baseball's great lefthanders, Lopat joined the Kansas City team last year as pitching coach. While pitching he compiled a record of 116 wins and 112 losses in a twelve year major league career with the White Sox, Yankees and Orioles. He managed Richmond from 1956-1959. In 1959 he became a scout for the Yankees, and

in 1960 he was named pitching coach of the Bombers. In 1961 he served as the pitching coach of the Minnesota Twins. Lopat makes his home in Hillsdale, New Jersey, with his wife and two children.

COACHES

Jimmie Dykes

Number 40

Joining the A's this year as third base coach and infield instructor is one of baseball's most colorful and outstanding personalities, Jimmie Dykes. Last year Dykes served in the same capacity with the Milwaukee Braves. In 1960, he managed the Cleveland Indians. He launched his career in baseball in 1917. The next year he began a 22 year career as one of the great third basemen in AL history. His lifetime batting average for 2,282 games was .280 and he batted .288 in three World Series and .667 as an AL representative in the All-Star Game. His first managerial post was with the Chicago White Sox in 1934. He was at the helm of the White Sox for 13 years. Since then he has piloted Philadelphia, Baltimore, Detroit and Cleveland in the junior circuit and Cincinnati in the National League. He resides in Norristown, Pennsylvania, with his wife.

Mel McGaha

Number 41

Another colorful addition to the coaching staff is Mel McGaha, who will be first base coach and outfield instructor. Manager of the Cleveland Indians in 1962, McGaha, an outstanding athlete while at the University of Arkansas, began his organized baseball career in 1948. In 1954 he became the manager of the Shreveport club of the Texas League and remained with that club for four years. He led the Sports to their first flag in Shreveport history in 1954. He managed Mobile of the Southern Association in 1958-59. Moving to Toronto in 1960, he piloted that club to an International League pennant. In 1961 he joined the Cleveland Indians as first base coach and was moved to the managerial slot last year. He resides in Shreveport, Louisiana with his wife and two children.

Gus Niarhos

Number 42

Returning for his second year with the A's, Gus Niarhos will be the bullpen coach. In his eight years of major league action Niarhos played for the Yankees, White Sox, Red Sox and Phillies. Niarhos makes his home in Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, with his wife and one child.
