WYCLIFFE "WYC" GROUSBECK

Wyc is a two-time NBA champion, and an experienced investor, CEO and founder. He has led or co-founded successful enterprises in sports, business, entertainment and philanthropy. He is passionate about doing the right thing and helping others.

BUSINESS VENTURES

Wyc was born and raised in Boston and attended Princeton University, University of Michigan Law School, and Stanford Business School. He was a venture capital investor for 7 years before he conceived of the idea to buy the Boston Celtics and led the acquisition in 2002. He has been Lead Owner, Governor and CEO of the Celtics ever since, as the Celtics won their historic 17th and 18th championships in 2008 and 2024. The Celtics' success on the court is matched in the community, as they help over 1,600 charities a year through the Boston Celtics Shamrock Foundation.

Wyc continued his investing career as well, co-founding Causeway Partners in 2013. Causeway has raised three venture growth funds totaling over \$400 million and has invested in a number of successful sports-related businesses, including SeatGeek and most recently the recapitalization of golf's PGA Tour.

Together with his wife Emilia Fazzalari, Wyc co-founded award-winning Cincoro Tequila in 2016 with

Jeanie Buss (owner, LA Lakers), Wes Edens (owner, Milwaukee Bucks), and Michael Jordan (NBA icon). Cincoro is distributed throughout the United States, Europe, Middle East and Asian markets, and has sold over 2 million bottles to date.

PHILANTHROPY

Emilia and Wyc serve as the Trustees of Giving | Grousbeck Fazzalari ("GGF"), a charitable foundation that supports several important initiatives in healthcare, education, and justice.

Wyc and Emilia also strongly support leading healthcare institutions such as Mass Eye and Ear, the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, Mass General Hospital, Boston Children's Hospital, and the Brigham and Women's Hospital; social justice and reform programs such as the Reform Alliance; and the Earthshot Foundation, Boston Celtics Shamrock Foundation, Boys and Girls Clubs, Make-a-Wish, Big Brothers Big Sisters, and Robin Hood.

Emilia is a member of the Trust Board of Boston Children's Hospital, the President's Advisory Council at the Brigham and Women's Hospital and on the board of Reform Alliance. Wyc is the former Chair of Mass Eye and Ear, a world leader in fighting blindness and deafness. He raised over \$250 million for Mass Eye and Ear.

ENTERTAINMENT

Emilia and Wyc co-created a situation comedy concept with their friend George in 2021 and sold it to NBC, which put it on prime-time television as "Extended Family" in 2024. It can currently be seen on NBC's Peacock. Wyc is an avid musician and plays guitar and drums in two bands. He has shared musical bills with such artists as Billy Idol, Lenny Kravitz, Gregg Allman and the J. Geils Band.

HONORS AND AWARDS

In addition to accepting two NBA Championship trophies on behalf of the Celtics, Wyc has been awarded honorary degrees as a commencement speaker by the University of Michigan Law School and Suffolk University. He received the Citizen - Athlete Award from Princeton for "contributions to sport and society". He has guest lectured at Boston College's Carroll School of Business for 15 years and speaks regularly at the Harvard Business School and the MIT Sloan School of Management. He was honored as an all-Ivy rower as part of Princeton's 1983 champion lightweight crew.

Wyc has been Lead Owner and Governor of the Boston Celtics since he conceived of, and led, the purchase of the team in late 2002.

Wyc named the group "Banner 17 LLC" to signify his primary goal, the Celtics winning a 17th World Championship. That goal was achieved on June 17, 2008, as the Celtics defeated the Lakers by 39 points and became World Champions for the first time in 22 years.


In 2010 Wyc became Chairman of the Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary, a teaching hospital of Harvard Medical School. It has been a world leader in vision and hearing research, fighting blindness and deafness, for almost 200 years.

In 2013 Wyc co-founded Causeway Media Partners, LP, a private equity firm managing over \$340 million, focusing on sports and technology investments. Causeway's investments include Formula E Holdings, SeatGeek, SessionM, Peerfit and Flosports.

Wyc's earlier career involved experience as a venture capital investor in Boston and as a securities lawyer in Silicon Valley.

Wyc and his wife Emilia are involved in a number of charities including Mass. Eye and Ear, the Boston Celtics Shamrock Foundation, Boys and Girls Clubs of Boston, Camp Jabberwocky, National Braille Press, USA Rowing, Robin Hood, Boston Children's Hospital and the Lovelane Special Needs Riding Program.

Wyc holds a bachelor's degree in history from Princeton University (1983), where he rowed on an undefeated crew that claimed the national rowing championship; a law degree from the University of Michigan (1986); and an MBA from Stanford Business School where he was a Miller Scholar (1992). He serves on the NBA Board of Governors, the boards of Partners Health Care, NBC Sports Boston, Formula E Holdings, and Peerfit, and is the Chairman of the Rhodes Scholar Selection Committee for the New England Region.

H. IRVING GROUSBECK

H. Irving Grousbeck is a Managing Partner of the Boston Celtics as well as an Executive Committee Member. Father of Managing Partner & Governor Wyc Grousbeck, Mr. Grousbeck is a Consulting Professor of Management at Stanford University's Graduate School of Business, and was formerly co-head of the school's Center for Entrepreneurial Studies. His teaching focuses on an objective means to develop a greater understanding of the issues faced by entrepreneurial companies and individuals. In addition to his professorial duties, Mr. Grousbeck co-authored the textbook *New Business Ventures and the Entrepreneur*. From 1981 to 1985, he was a lecturer at Harvard University's Graduate School of Business Administration.

In 1963, Mr. Grousbeck co-founded Continental Cablevision and went on to serve as that company's President from 1964 to 1980 and Chairman of the Board from 1980 to 1985. Continental Cablevision was sold to U.S. West Media Group in November 1996.

Mr. Grousbeck is a graduate of Amherst College and the Harvard Business School. He was awarded an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree by Amherst College in 2000, and by Menlo College in 2015. He serves on a number of private company boards and was formerly a Trustee of Children's Hospital Boston, Newton-Wellesley Hospital, New England Eye Bank, the Hewlett Foundation, and the Massachusetts Board of Higher Education.

STEVE PAGLIUCA

Steve Pagliuca is a managing general partner and co-owner of the world champion Boston Celtics, where he also serves on the NBA Board of Governors. In his role as managing partner and chairman of the Basketball Committee, he has focused on advancing the Celtics' basketball operations.

Pagliuca serves as President of the Boston Celtics Shamrock Foundation, which helps children by providing access to essential services like housing and healthcare, in collaboration with local charities.

In 2020, Steve led the effort to build the Bill Russell statue, now standing in Boston's City Hall plaza, to honor Bill's dedication to equality and civil rights globally as well as his life long contributions to the Celtics organization.

Steve helped to launch the Celtics United for Social Justice initiative, a 10-year, \$25 million commitment aimed at addressing racial injustice and social inequities in America.

Steve is the founder and CEO of PagsGroup, an investment firm that focuses on building companies in the tech, biotech, sports and media sectors.

Pagliuca is also a principal owner and co-chairman of Atalanta Bergamasca Calcio, a Serie A football club based in Bergamo, Italy. Atalanta has been recognized for having one of the world's most successful soccer academies and was honored to win the 2024 Europa Cup Championship for the first time in 60 years.

Pagliuca is the co-founder and executive chair of Arena BioWorks, a biomedical institute dedicated to developing life-saving therapeutics with both societal and long term investment objectives.

Steve is a longtime partner and the former co-chair of Bain Capital, a \$180 billion global private equity firm, where he currently serves as a Senior Advisor.

In 2016, the Pagliuca Family Foundation helped create the Pagliuca Harvard Life Lab, a shared laboratory space for biotech innovation at Harvard University. Pagliuca holds a B.A. from Duke University and an M.B.A. from Harvard Business School and serves on Duke's Board of Trustees.

The Abbey Group is known in Boston as the developer of many successful real estate properties, including the notable 1.5 million square foot Landmark Center mixed-use development that anchors a prime area between Fenway Park and the Longwood Medical area in Boston, Lafayette City Center, a re-developed 650,000 square foot office center in Boston's Downtown Crossing, 45 Province, a 32-story condominium tower, located at the intersection of Beacon Hill and Government Center, The Viridian, a residential Tower on Boylston Street in the Fenway, and Exchange South End, a recently planned 1,600,000 square foot Life Science and Technology Center located in the South End.

Robert Epstein is the founding Partner of The Abbey Group. His reputation as a knowledgeable and innovative developer led to his appointment to several key

PAUL EDGERLEY

Paul Edgerley is a member of the Boston Celtics Executive Committee. As a member of the Executive Committee, he consults on the team's business and financial matters as well as the team's community and charitable activities.

Paul is a Managing Director and co-founder of VantEdge Partners, a private investment firm. Previously, he served as Managing Director at Bain Capital from 1990 until his retirement in January 2016. He continues to serve as a Senior Advisor to Bain Capital. Bain Capital is a private investment firm with approximately \$175 billion in assets under management with offices in Boston, Chicago, Dublin, Hong Kong, London, Luxembourg, Melbourne, Mumbai, Munich, New York, Palo Alto, San Francisco, Shanghai, Sydney and Tokyo.

Paul received an MBA, with Distinction, from Harvard Business School and is a Certified Public Accountant. He received a B.S. from Kansas State University.

Paul currently serves on the Board of Directors of Bluemont Group, Enjet Aero, Kansas City Royals, and JVE Partners LLC. He is a Co-Owner and an Executive Committee Member of Atlanta BC.

He is also on the board of several philanthropic organizations, serving as the National Board Chair of Year Up and the Co-Chair of the Dean's Advisory Board at Harvard Business School, as well as serving on the Board of Massachusetts General Hospital, the National Board of OneGoal

Graduation, and the Board of Boston Celtics Shamrock Foundation. Paul previously served as Commission Chair of Social Impact Partnerships to Pay for Results Act (SIPRA), a federal government bi-partisan commission. Additionally, he served as Co-Chair of the Harvard University Capital Campaign, Co-Chair of the Harvard Campaign for the Faculty of Arts and Sciences and served as a member of the Executive Committee of the Trust Board of Kansas State University, Children's Hospital Trust Board, the Board of New Profit, Inc., and the US Board of The Right to Play.

He lives in the greater Boston area with his wife, Sandy, and their four children.



GLENN HUTCHINS

Glenn Hutchins is chairman of North Island and North Island Ventures, and co-founder of Silver Lake.

He is vice chairman and lead independent director of Santander, on the Investment Board and the International Advisory Board of GIC, the sovereign wealth fund of Singapore, on the Executive Committee of the Boston Celtics Basketball Team (2024 and 2008 NBA World Champions), and a director of AT&T.

He is also co-chairman of Brookings Institution, vice-chair of the Obama Foundation, and chairman emeritus of CARE. He was previously chairman of the board of SunGard Data Systems, Inc. and Instinet, Inc. and a director of Nasdaq, Inc. and Virtu Financial.

Mr. Hutchins was a director and chair of the Audit and Risk Committee of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York from 2011-2020. He served President Clinton in both the transition and the White House as a special advisor on economic and healthcare policy. He was also a director of the Harvard Management Company for a decade and co-chairman of Harvard University's capital campaign.

Mr. Hutchins and his wife, Debbie, founded the Hutchins Family Foundation which, among other projects, is supporting the construction of the Obama Presidential Center and has created the Hutchins Center for African & African American Research at Harvard University, the Hutchins Center on Fiscal and Monetary

Policy at The Brookings Institution, the Hutchins Institute for Social Justice at the Lawrenceville School, and the Chronic Fatigue Initiative, which conducted basic research into the cause of chronic fatigue syndrome.

Mr. Hutchins has published essays on economic and public policy in the Wall Street Journal, New York Times, Washington Post, Financial Times, Fortune and Foreign Affairs. He is also a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.

Mr. Hutchins holds an A.B. from Harvard College, an M.B.A. from Harvard Business School, and a J.D. from Harvard Law School.

RICH GOTHAM

Rich Gotham is in his 22nd season with the 18-time world Champion Boston Celtics and his 18th season as team President. In this role, he is responsible for all aspects of the Celtics business operations and works closely with Celtics ownership, basketball operations staff, and the NBA on basketball related matters, as well as team and league initiatives. He succeeded Arnold "Red" Auerbach as Celtics team President and serves on the NBA Board of Governors. Prior to being named Team President, Rich served as the team's Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer.

Since joining the Celtics in 2003, Rich has been recognized for leading the team to new heights off the court while growing team revenues by over 500%. Under his leadership the team has established new records for attendance, ticket sales, sponsorship, merchandise, and television ratings, contributing to the team's NBA Championships in 2008 and 2024, as well as nine Eastern Conference Finals, and four NBA Finals appearances. In addition, he led negotiations for the construction and naming rights for the state of the art Red Auerbach training center in partnership with New Balance, as well as a long-term lease extension with the TD Garden. Rich also negotiated a long-term media rights and equity partnership with

Comcast SportsNet (now NBC Sports Boston), one of the largest such deals in NBA league history and negotiated the team's first jersey patch sponsorship with GE.

Rich and the Celtics have been widely recognized as thought leaders in the business of sports and the team's business achievements under Rich's direction have been chronicled by The Wall Street Journal, The New York Times, The Harvard Business Review, Investors' Business Daily, Bloomberg, Reuters, CNBC, and Fox Business News. During the 2008-2009 season the Celtics were recognized as the top franchise in all of professional sports by The Sports Business Journal.

Under Rich's guidance, the Celtics have significantly increased their efforts to help children in need throughout New England and their programs have been recognized by The White House and US Department of Education. With over 200 events and 140 player appearances annually, the Celtics lead the NBA in community engagement with initiatives that impact over 20,000 children each year. In addition, Rich is very active in multiple charitable and fundraising initiatives on behalf of the Boston Celtics Shamrock Foundation, for which he is a board member.

Rich joined the Celtics after a fifteen-year career in the tech industry, including five years with the global internet media company, Lycos, where he served as Vice President of Sales and Business Development. While at Lycos, he was part of a senior-management team that exceeded Wall Street analyst expectations for revenue and profitability growth for nineteen (19) consecutive quarters and played an integral role in helping to grow the Lycos Network into the most visited web site on the Internet in 2001. In addition, he sat on the Board of Directors for the Internet Advertising Bureau participating in the creation of multiple new internet advertising standards that are still in place today.

In addition to his duties with the Celtics, Rich currently serves as a board member for The Greater Boston Chamber of Commerce, The Make-A-Wish Foundation, and NBC Sports Boston. He also serves as a Trustee at Providence College, his alma mater.





BRAD STEVENS

Brad Stevens begins his fourth season as the team's President of Basketball Operations and his 12th season overall with the Celtics. He was named as the team's eighth President of Basketball Operations on June 2, 2021.

In his eight seasons as Head Coach for the Boston Celtics, he amassed a record of 354-282 (.557) in 636 regular season games that saw the Celtics make three appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals and seven straight trips to the playoffs from 2015-2021. He sits fourth in franchise history for most wins by a head coach behind just Red Auerbach, Tommy Heinsohn, and Doc Rivers. His 78 playoff games coached, and 38 wins, are fifth most in franchise history behind Red Auerbach, K.C. Jones, Tommy Heinsohn and Doc Rivers. During his coaching career for the Celtics, he was named the NBA's Eastern Conference Coach of the Month three times (April 2015, February 2016, November 2017) and was also given the honor of coaching the Eastern Conference during the 2017 NBA All-Star Game in New Orleans.

Stevens joined the Celtics after coaching Butler University where he boasted a 166-49 record, four league regular season championships, three league tournament titles and six trips to post-season tournament play. He has the top two single-season win totals in Butler and Horizon League history, and he became the only

coach in school history to lead a team to the NCAA Division I national championship game which he did twice. Stevens owns two Horizon League Coach of the Year awards and has rewritten the NCAA record book for Best Coaching Starts by Wins. During the 2012-13 season, he moved into the top spot on the six-year list with 165 victories. He captured the five-year record (139), moving ahead of Everett Case of North Carolina State (1947-51) in 2011-12, and he owns the three-year (89) and four-year (117) records. He is second on the two-year list with 56 wins.

Stevens left a position as a marketing associate at Eli Lilly and Company in Indianapolis to pursue a career in basketball coaching. He served in a volunteer capacity in Butler's basketball office during the summer of 2000, before eventually gaining a full-time administrative position under Thad Matta. Stevens joined the Bulldogs' staff in 2000-01 as coordinator of basketball operations, handling a variety of administrative duties. He was offered a full-time assistant coaching position by Todd Lickliter in 2001-02. Stevens worked with Lickliter for six seasons spanning from 2001-07. During Stevens' tenure as an assistant coach with the Bulldogs, Butler compiled a 131-61 record, won three Horizon League regular season championships and made four trips to post-season tournament play.

Stevens earned a B.A. degree in economics from DePauw in 1999. He was a four-year member of the basketball team at DePauw, earning the squad's "Coaches Award" in 1998-99. He and his wife, Tracy, have two children, son Brady and daughter Kinsley.



MICHAEL ZARREN

A lifelong Celtics fan and season ticket holder, Michael Zarren is now the Celtics' Vice President of Basketball Operations & Team Counsel. Now in his 22nd year with the team after starting as an unpaid intern, Zarren is widely recognized as one of the leaders in the field of advanced statistical analysis of basketball players and teams, and is an important part of the team's strategic planning and player personnel evaluation processes.

In addition to helping lead the Basketball Operations Department, Zarren is also the team's salary cap expert and lead in-house counsel for basketball issues, and is responsible for the development of new technologies for team use, including the team's statistical, sports science, and video database processes. He previously also served as the team's in-house counsel for all business-side legal work, including sponsorship agreements, broadcast deals, and vendor arrangements, among other legal matters.

A graduate of Harvard Law School (where he served as editor-in-chief of the Harvard Journal of Law and Technology) and of the University of Chicago, Zarren has also served as a law clerk on the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit. Zarren was previously a management consultant for Fortune 500 firms across a wide variety of industries. A native of Swampscott, MA, Zarren is a member of the bars of New York and Massachusetts and of the Boards of Directors of the Institute for Political Innovation and Voter

Choice Massachusetts, two charities focused on educating people about improvements to our nation's voting systems.

AUSTIN AINGE

Austin Ainge enters his 17th season with the Celtics in various roles. Ainge has been a scout, Head Coach of the Maine Red Claws of the NBA Development League (2009-11), Director of Scouting, Director of Player Personnel and now Assistant General Manager.

Ainge has previously worked at Southern Utah University where he was responsible for perimeter players, recruiting, player development, video breakdown, and developing game plans. While at BYU Austin went to three NCAA tournaments and one NIT. His senior year Austin was one of the top three-point shooters in the nation and led the conference by shooting .525 from behind the arc in conference play. Before playing at BYU, Austin put his basketball career on hold and served a two-year mission for his church, living in and serving the communities in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic where he learned to speak fluent Spanish.

Austin is married to the former Crystal Bluth and has three sons, Andre, Finley, and Otto.

Beyond the court, Feaster serves as a co-lead for Boston Celtics United, the Celtics' social justice initiative to impact social and racial inequities in Black and Brown communities in Greater Boston.

An avid champion of the advancement of women and girls, she also serves as a global advocate for sport, including serving on the NCAA Board of Governors and as a Sports Envoy for the US Department of State, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs. Feaster is married to Milt Newton and is the proud mom to Sarah, a first-year student-athlete at the University of Connecticut.





JOE MAZZULLA
Head Coach

JOE MAZZULLA

Entering his third season as the head coach of the Boston Celtics, Joe Mazzulla guided the team to 2024 NBA Championship with a 16-3 postseason record for the second-highest playoff winning percentage (.842) in the NBA since the first round expanded to a best-of-seven series in 2002-03.

Mazzulla led the Celtics to its 18th NBA championship for the most titles in NBA history. Mazzulla became the youngest head coach to win the NBA Finals since the 1968-69 season, when 35-year-old Bill Russell led the Celtics to the NBA championship as a player-coach.

In his first two seasons at the helm, Mazzulla owns a 121-43 regular season record for a .738 winning percentage and has gone 27-12 (.692 WP) in

the playoffs. Boston collected its NBA-record 14th 60-win season with a 64-18 record during the 2023-24 season, marking the second time since 1989 the Celtics registered at least 57 wins in consecutive seasons. In his short tenure, Mazzulla's accolades include being named the 2023 NBA All-Star Head Coach and is tied for the second-most NBA Coach of the Month honors in franchise history alongside Brad Stevens (3).

A native of Johnston, R.I., Mazzulla enters his sixth overall season with the organization after spending three years as an assistant coach and has also served as an assistant coach for the Maine Red Claws of the NBA G League. He was named the 19th head coach in franchise history on February 16, 2023.

Prior to joining the Celtics organization, Mazzulla was the head coach at Fairmont State and amassed a 43-17 record in his two seasons leading the Fighting Falcons. A former West Virginia University standout, Mazzulla spent five years coaching at the NCAA Division II level. Mazzulla began his coaching career as an assistant coach at Glenville State where he helped develop two All-WVIAC honorees and a pair of all-freshman team honorees in just two seasons.

Mazzulla played four collegiate seasons at West Virginia University for head coaches John Beilein and Bob Huggins. His teams made four straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including a Final Four berth in 2010. Mazzulla won a Big East Tournament Championship and NIT Tournament Championship at WVU and also excelled in the classroom, earning Big East Academic All-Star Team honors three times (2007, 2009, 2010).

Mazzulla and his wife Camai have two children.

SAM CASSELL

Sam Cassell returns to the Boston Celtics organization for his second season as an assistant coach after playing for the Celtics from 2007-2009. Cassell helped lead the Celtics to the 2024 NBA Championship in his first season on the Celtics bench. Prior to joining the Celtics, he spent three seasons as an assistant coach with the Philadelphia 76ers where he made three consecutive Eastern Conference Semifinal appearances. Cassell served on the Los Angeles Clippers staff for six years prior (2014-20) and began his coaching career with the Washington Wizards from 2009-2014.

Before becoming a coach, Cassell played 15 seasons in the NBA and was part of three championship teams, including back-to-back titles with the Houston Rockets in 1994 and 1995, and won a third title with the Boston Celtics in 2008 in his last season. The Baltimore, Maryland native suited up for eight teams during his NBA career and played in 993 career games (690 starts) with averages of 15.7 points, 3.2 rebounds, 6.0 assists, and 1.1 steals in 30.0 minutes per game.

He earned his undergraduate degree in history from Duke in 2016 and received a master's degree from Duke's Divinity School in 2017.



MATT REYNOLDS



ROSTER BREAKDOWN

BY TAYLOR SNOW



THE BALL HANDLERS

The ball-handling position is arguably the most important role on the basketball court, responsible for facilitating the offense and controlling the pace. Several Celtics are capable of handling the ball; however, there are four players in particular who specialize in the role.

JRUE HOLIDAY

The term "ball handler" doesn't fully encapsulate Jrue Holiday's impact on the

Celtics. The 15-year veteran handles the ball at a high level and defends the ball better than maybe any perimeter player in the NBA.

Holiday's addition right before the start of last season was an unexpected gift for an already-stacked contender. His facilitation, defensive ability, and willingness to sacrifice his personal production helped push the Celtics over the top to a championship.

During his first season in green, Holiday averaged 12.5 points, 4.8 assists, and a career-high 5.4 rebounds per game to go

along with a career-best and team-leading 3-point clip of 42.9 percent. His defensive impact earned him his sixth career All-Defensive Team nod.

When Holiday arrived last fall, he said he could envision winning "multiple rings" in Boston. Expect the 34-year-old point guard to come out hungry to repeat this coming campaign.

DERRICK WHITE

One would have thought that inserting Holiday into the rotation would have caused



Derrick White's stats to drop last season. Instead, the opposite occurred. Rather than stepping on each other's shoes, the duo complemented each other perfectly, and White posted career-high marks nearly across the board.

The seven-year vet posted 15.2 points, 5.2 assists, 4.2 rebounds, 1.0 steals, and 1.2 blocks per game while shooting 46.1 percent from the field, 39.6 percent from long range, and 90.1 percent from the free-throw line.

White's shot-blocking and ball-hawking skills earned him a spot alongside Holiday on the All-Defense Second Team, and he was a borderline All-Star.

The duo got even more reps alongside each other this summer, winning a gold medal with the U.S. Olympic team. So, their chemistry should be even stronger as they embark on their second season together.

PAYTON PRITCHARD

Payton Pritchard's minutes decreased from his rookie year to his sophomore year to his third year in the league, but he didn't let that discourage him. He came out for Year 4 last season with an opportunity to help fill the voids

of Marcus Smart and Malcolm Brogdon, and he turned up the dial for a breakout campaign.

Pritchard saw an increase of nine minutes per game from his third year (13.4) to his fourth year (22.3), which resulted in career-high marks of 9.6 points, 3.4 assists, and 3.2 rebounds per game with shooting splits of 46.8 percent from the field, 38.5 percent from deep, and 82.1 percent from the charity stripe.

Not often do you see a third option with confidence like Pritchard has displayed. He was fearless in his shot-taking, especially in the playoffs. He knocked down the most memorable shot of the entire championship run – a halfcourt buzzer-beater at the end of the first half of a title-clinching Game 5, which sucked the life out of the Dallas Mavericks.

Combining such confidence with his per-minute production would make Pritchard a starting-caliber player on several teams. The Celtics are fortunate to have such a talent quarterbacking their bench unit.

JD DAVISON

JD Davison will enter his third season as a two-way player in the Celtics organization,

splitting his time between Maine and Boston.

The 22-year-old may not have extensive big-game experience at the NBA level, but he does at the G League level, where he helped lead the Maine Celtics to the championship round this past spring.

He was the top all-around player on the Portland squad, averaging 20.8 points, 8.6 assists, 5.2 rebounds, and 1.6 steals per game, which earned him All-NBA G League Third Team honors.

Davison has shown strides in each of his three professional seasons, and that's why the Celtics continue to believe in the uber-athletic guard. His fourth season will be his most important yet – to show that he belongs in the NBA full-time.

THE WINGS

Wings are often the most versatile players on the floor and are relied upon to take on a heavy scoring load. Defensively, they'll typically be tasked with suppressing elite

scorers on opposing teams. Depending on their skill set, they may also be assigned ball-handling duties, or they may slide into the frontcourt to take on opposing bigs. The Celtics have seven players who will be taking on that role this season

JAYSON TATUM

Jayson Tatum has made a case to be the most well-rounded wing in the NBA. At the very least, he has one of the more impressive resumes: five straight All-Star appearances, four All-NBA nods, three consecutive top-six MVP finishes, and now an NBA championship under his belt

attempted fewer than 20 shots per game, showing his willingness to sacrifice for the team. But that didn't prevent him from logging his fourth straight season of at least 26 points per game. He focused more on distribution, handing out a career-best 4.9 assists per game, and helped to clean the glass with a team-high 8.1 rebounds per game. The 26-year-old logged his best field-goal percentage (47.1 percent) since his rookie season and his best 3-point clip (37.6 percent) since the 2020-21 campaign.

Tatum has hardly slowed down since winning his first championship. Not long after the parade, he joined Team USA in Paris where he earned his second Olympic gold medal

JAYLEN BROWN

Only one player has been with the Celtics longer than Tatum, and that's his wing-mate, Jaylen Brown

Brown just wrapped up his eighth season, and it was by far his most impressive year yet. Not only was he an All-Star for the third time, but he also spearheaded the championship run, winning both the Eastern Conference Finals MVP and the NBA Finals MVP.

JB experienced similar statistical trends to Tatum in several ways. His shooting attempts dipped, but his efficiency rose to a career-best 49.9 percent while also posting a career-high 3.6 assists per game. In the playoffs, his shooting percentage rose to 51.6 percent, including a stellar 60.7 percent from inside the 3-point arc.

SAM HAUSER

In a matter of three years, Sam Hauser went from being an undrafted free agent to

Tatum made more (229 3-point makes), but JT also played nearly 1,000 more minutes

However, Hauser has proven to be more than just a 3-point shooter; he's also stepped up on the other end of the floor and was tabbed by Joe Mazzulla as one of the more underrated defensive players on the team

becoming a key cog off the bench for a championship team

Hauser was undoubtedly the best high-volume 3-point shooter on the team last season, finishing with 197 makes on 465 attempts (42.4 percent). Only Jayson

Hauser has added to his game each season, so it'll be exciting to see what he has in store for Year 4

JORDAN WALSH

Jordan Walsh got his first small taste of NBA life last season, appearing in 12 regular season and playoff games. Most of his time was spent developing in the G League, where the 20-year-old averaged 14.4 points, 5.6 rebounds, 2.1 assists, and 1.5 steals per game with the Maine Celtics

Walsh is a beast on the defensive end, using his 7-foot-3 wingspan to get deflections and steals. He's certainly NBA-ready on that end. However, he still has some work to do on the offensive end as he continues to work on his shooting

As the youngest player on the roster, Walsh has a bit of developing to do before he carves out a significant NBA role. But he should earn more minutes in Year 2 after having another offseason and Summer League under his belt

JADEN SPRINGER

The title of second-youngest player on the roster belongs to Jaden Springer, an under-the-radar trade deadline acquisition from last season.

Springer came to Boston via Philly in mid-February and saw limited minutes at the wing spot. He, too, impressed on the defensive end, and although he doesn't have nearly the wingspan that Walsh possesses, he's still capable of wreaking havoc on that end with his tenacious on-ball defense.

Springer is one of the more athletic players on the roster, but the 22-year-old still has some other areas to improve on before carving out a consistent role. Still, he's capable of providing energy off the bench, whether it's with his defense or acrobatic dunks.


DREW PETERSON

Drew Peterson joined the Celtics last December on a two-way contract, and he'll be back on another two-way deal this season.

Peterson fits a similar mold as Hauser, as an undrafted wing who has developed into a solid shooter, passer, and defender. He's not quite the shooter that Hauser is but is a bit more of a playmaker.

Last season with the Maine Celtics, Peterson averaged 16.1 points, 7.3 rebounds, and 4.1 assists per game. He only played 23 minutes for Boston, though he took advantage of his limited opportunity by scoring 11 points on 4-of-6 shooting from the field, including 2-of-3 from long range.

Expect to see Peterson in a similar type of role this season, playing a significant role with Maine while providing depth for Boston if needed.






BAYLOR SCHEIERMAN

Baylor Scheierman was about as well-rounded of a wing that was available in this year's NBA Draft, and the Celtics snagged him with pick No. 30.

The 6-foot-6 Nebraska native played five college seasons between South Dakota State and Creighton and became the first player in Division I men's history to amass at least 2,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 500 assists, and 300 3-pointers.

At age 24, Scheierman is one of the older rookies in his class. But that also makes him one of the more experienced rookies in his class, one who may not need as long to develop. He brings a hardworking mentality to the court, which was on display in Summer League, so we'll see if he can use that to help work his way up the depth chart.

THE BIGS

As their title indicates, the bigs are the largest players on the floor. They're responsible for

banging bodies in the post, protecting the rim, and using their high vantage points to communicate to the defense. The Celtics have six players who share this role.

KRISTAPS PORZINGIS

The only major difference in the Celtics' rotation is that there will be a 7-foot-2 void in the tip-off circle at the start of the season. It was announced in late June that Kristaps Porzingis would be sidelined for five to six months after undergoing surgery to repair a torn retinaculum and dislocated posterior tibialis tendon, putting his estimated return date somewhere between late November and late December.

In the three months since his operation, Porzingis has been rehabbing back home in Latvia. He'll continue his work back in Boston during Training Camp and the beginning of the regular season. If he can return sometime in December, it would provide an excellent quarter-season pick-me-up for the Celtics.

Last season he thrived as Boston's third

scoring option behind the Jays, averaging 20.1 points per game on a career-high 51.6 percent shooting from the field. He was also their top shot-blocker at 1.9 swats per game.

The C's proved they could still win without KP during the 2024 playoffs. But there's no question they are a far more formidable team when he is in the lineup, thanks to his interior presence on both ends.

The C's will miss his presence for the first month or two, but the rest of the guys on this list should have no problem stepping up as they've done in the past.

AL HORFORD

Al Horford played a huge part in filling in for Porzingis during the playoffs last spring, and he'll enter Year 18 doing the same.

The five-time All-Star was at the forefront of the team's "Whatever It Takes" mindset last season, accepting and embracing a bench role for the first time in his career because he knew that's what the team needed from him.



to reach its maximum potential. At the start of this season, he'll likely be elevated back into the starting center role until KP gets back.

Horford started 15 of 19 playoff games in the postseason, averaging 9.2 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.1 assists per game, and 30 minutes per game. He shot 47.8 percent from the field, including 36.8 percent from outside the arc and a league-high 72.1 percent from inside the arc. Not bad for a guy who, in the middle of that run, turned 38 years old.

Horford has shown that he is timeless and still has plenty of basketball left in the tank. He'll need to tap into his fuel reserve early in the season as he steps back into a starting role.

LUKE KORNET

In a matter of two years, Luke Kornet went from being nearly out of the league to the backup center for a championship team.

What a journey it has been.

Kornet had the most impactful season of his career last season, averaging 5.3 points and 4.1 rebounds per game, while playing in 76 total games, including seven spot starts.

The 7-foot-2 center is extraordinarily efficient whenever he's on the floor. Last season he shot 70 percent from the field and 90.7 percent from the free throw line. He also made his only 3-point attempt of the season, technically making him the only player in NBA history to finish a campaign with 70/100/90 splits. He was also the only player in the league to rank among the top five in both contested twos and threes per 36 minutes.

Expect some big minutes from Kornet throughout this season, not only during Porzingis' absence but also later in the campaign when the team is managing KP and Horford's minutes leading up to the playoffs.

XAVIER TILLMAN SR.

The Celtics didn't have to do much at last season's trade deadline, but one of the beneficial tweaks they made was dealing for Xavier Tillman Sr.

The 25-year-old power forward/center provided valuable frontcourt depth down the

final stretch of the regular season. He also hit one of the timeliest shots in the Finals when he knocked down a key 3-pointer during Boston's Game 3 rally against the Mavericks.

In re-signing Tillman over the summer, the C's retain a tough veteran, a skilled passer, and a versatile defender who can provide strong pick-and-roll defense and rim protection.

NEEMIAS QUETA

While playing on a two-way contract last season, Neemias Queta impressed the Celtics' front office brass so much that they opted to sign him to a full-time deal over the summer.

Queta dominated during his time in the G League where he was a double-double machine

and a shot-blocking nightmare for Maine. The 7-foot lob threat also took advantage of every opportunity during his 28 regular-season appearances for Boston, with per-36 averages of 16.6 points, 13.2 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 2.3 blocks, and 1.4 steals.

Queta should have even more time to shine in the NBA this season, so get ready for some high-flying dunks and electrifying blocks whenever he takes the floor.

ANTON WATSON

The only addition to Boston's frontcourt is second-round draft pick Anton Watson. The 6-foot-8 rookie is somewhat of an exception on this list because he is a tweener who can slot

in as either a big or a wing. He played a lot of small forward at Gonzaga, but he also has a strong interior skill set on both ends of the floor and said he strives for an Al Horford-type role.

Watson is an excellent ball hawk, ranking second on the Bulldogs' all-time steals list behind the NBA's steal king John Stockton. On the other end, he has the potential to be a 3-point threat. He shot 41.2 percent from deep during his senior season and has been implored by Brad Stevens to let the ball fly.

Watson is one of three Celtics on a two-way contract this season, so we'll see him suit up both in Boston and in Maine throughout his rookie campaign.



AFTER CAPTURING BANNER 18

BOSTON'S HUNGER FOR NEXT TITLE IS EVEN STRONGER

BOSTON – Jayson Tatum’s hunger for Banner 18 has been satiated. But his hunger for the next banner is stronger than ever.

The satisfaction of finally getting over the hump and capturing his first championship has been replaced by a yearning to experience it all over again.

Because that’s what legends do: they grind, they win, they celebrate. And they repeat that process for as long as their bodies and minds allow.

“It was never about trying to just win one,”

Tatum said before the start of Training Camp. “Now you get to at least be in the same room with the other Celtics great teams, great players. All the guys I looked up to growing up won at least one championship. Now it’s just a conversation of how great are you trying to be? What room or what tier are you trying to be mentioned in when it’s all said and done?”

It’s not just Tatum who feels that way. It’s the entire team. And that’s part of the reason why Brad Stevens is running it back with 13 of the 15 guys from last year’s championship roster.

The President of Basketball Operations said, “I generally wouldn’t mind a tweak or two just because I think that those things can galvanize you, can give you a jolt, can give you the juice that you need. But I think that these guys are galvanized by each other ... They have a unique chemistry that I truly believe matters. And they deserve the opportunity to attack this challenge together.”

Jayten Brown agrees that there is a unique chemistry with this group, one that he hadn’t experienced in his previous seven seasons with



the team. The longest-tenured Celtic believes that this isn't the type of chemistry that you want to alter, because this team knows how to win together and they love to win together.

"We've got a stellar group of guys – guys that just have great mentalities, so I don't think it will be as hard to maintain that consistency," Brown said. "We just gotta make sure that we continue to emphasize and hold each other accountable ... I'm looking forward to this journey because of the guys I get to share the locker room with."

They also have to be realistic, knowing that the journey won't come without ups and downs. Even last year's 80-win team had some bumps here and there, but they never lost their competitive edge whenever adversity hit.

"We won't always be perfect," said Stevens. "I'm sure we'll get drilled in a game early this

season and I'm sure we'll have our moments where we play really well. But the question is how can we stay consistent and are we about the things that we embraced last year to get there? Do we sacrifice for one another? Are we willing to take everybody's best shot? Do we look at it as a fun challenge? For me, this is as good of a challenge as you get if you're a competitor. So we should be excited about it."

Perhaps no one is more excited for the challenge than his head coach. Joe Mazzulla has often said how winning is just as dangerous as losing, and this is the first time he'll see how this team approaches coming off a fully successful season.

"I think being in a situation like this tests why you do what you do, because you can't only do it for the good times," said Mazzulla. "I think when you go through an

experience like last year, it really just tests your internal motivation. And if you're going to be externally motivated, that's going to die out and you'll kind of be exposed for your external motivation relatively quick. But I think going through successes and failures kind of tests your internal, intrinsic motivation as to what you're really going after."

They've gone after the same goal year after year, and this season is no different. But it feels different now that they understand what it's like to achieve their goal. And that just makes them hungrier.

"It does feel different being here as a champion," Tatum said. "Just knowing what it takes and wanting to be on the top of the mountain as many times as you can."



BOSTON – Just before the start of the season, Derrick White added to his champion resume – this time for his contributions off the court.

The 2024 NBA champ was recognized for his service in the Greater Boston Community, earning the 2024 Community Champion Award, which was presented to him at the Celtics' annual Shamrock Foundation Tip-Off Gala.

The award is presented to a Celtics player who extends the reach of the organization's championship legacy into the community

"The community is what it's all about and just trying to give back to the community, give back to the people less fortunate, and just trying to celebrate the successes that they have. So it's a great honor to win it and I'm just glad I can do stuff in this community."

White has been active in the Boston community ever since he stepped foot into

the city two and a half years ago. He's both spearheaded and participated in several events involving local youths and families, including a handful of programs this past year.

In February of 2024, White hosted a bowling event to help raise funds to support Special Olympics MA. He has been an avid supporter of Special Olympics athletes for his whole life, drawing inspiration from his aunt who competed in the Special Olympics for more than 30 years.

Fittingly, three Special Olympic athletes



presented White with his award Friday night and then participated with him, Jaylen Brown, and Jayson Tatum in a friendly Pop-A-Shot competition

The trophy itself is gargantuan, made of wood with White's green No. 9 on top

"It's going to be interesting what we're going to do with it," he said with a smile. "But that's not my job. I'll let wifey try to figure it out"

White also served as an ambassador for the Celtics' curbside Care Program, a mobile unit

that delivers BMC Pediatrics and Midwifery services to mothers and babies outside of their homes. In March, he donated strollers and essential baby items to families in need and in even rode along in the mobile unit so that he could connect with patients

Additionally, White participated in Boston Scientific's "Fit for a Cause" launch and Sun Life's "Fit to Win" program, both of which promote and embrace healthy lifestyle habits

This is the second community-based award that

White has earned this year. In April, he was the recipient of the Red Auerbach Award, given to the Celtics player or coach who best exemplifies the spirit of what it means to be a Celtic through exceptional performance on and off the court

Jaylen Brown, the winner of both awards the previous year, said there is no one more deserving than White for these community honors. "It means a lot for Derrick to be recognized for who he is as a player, but for who he is as a person, as well"

HelpCureHD aims to help improve the quality of life for those affected by Huntington's Disease by contributing financial, emotional, and mental support while trying to find the cure.

THE PROBLEM

There is no cure for Huntington's Disease. Currently, there is a 50/50 chance a child could inherit the disease if a parent has HD in their family line.

There is a way to stop the gene from being passed on, through in vitro fertilization, or IVF. A procedure that implants embryos that do not have the HD gene can cost upwards of \$25,000 - \$30,000. This treatment is the only way parents who are at risk can guarantee their biological child will be HD-free.

OUR GOALS

- Provide the finances for families who are at-risk and in financial need and are willing to undergo IVF in order to stop the HD gene from being passed on in their family line.
- Our broader focus is to continue developing partnerships with fertility clinics across the country and raising funds to help cover these costs for many more families.






The Massachusetts General Colored Association, dedicated to ending slavery and discrimination in America, met there. Abolitionists William Lloyd Garrison, Frederick Douglass, and Maria Stewart spoke there. William Lloyd Garrison founded the New England Anti-Slavery Society there. The New England Freedom Association assisted runaway slaves on the Underground Railroad there. The community celebrated the end of the international slave trade there.

One of the first African American Civil War regiments, the Massachusetts 54th Volunteer Regiment, was recruited there.
