Chicago Bulls' Prospectus

The Chicago Bulls were better than ever last year. Unfortunately, so were the teams they had to beat if they were to aspire to a National Basketball Association championship. A few years ago, perhaps, the Bulls and their fans would have been delighted with a season in which they won 57 games and lost only 25, the third best record in the entire N.B.A.

But the Bulls, having come of age under the tutelage of Coach Dick Motta, have passed the stage where they are willing to settle for third best or even second best. Midway thru last season they began to realize that they had a shot at division leader Milwaukee.

The Bulls didn't make it, but they never stopped trying and, for the first time in their history, they made the playoffs with plenty of room to spare. They did it by welding their talents into the kind of club Coach Motta seeks and demands.

On offense they ran their intricate patterns, controlling the flow of the play until someone could work loose for a high-percentage shot. Thus, although blessed with few outstanding pure shooters, the Bulls had the sixth highest scoring average in the league, 111.2 points a game.

On defense they were even better. In fact, they were the best defensive team in the N.B.A., permitting an average of 102.9 points a game and holding the opposition under 100 points on 27 separate occasions. That was a new league record.

Individual honors began to come the Bulls' way, too. Three of them—Jerry Sloan, Bob Love, and newcomer Norm Van Lier, were named to the N.B.A.'s all-defensive team at the end of the season. Sloan made the first string for the second time in four years.

Love also was a starter in the All-Star game for the first time in his career and made the final All-Star squad for the second year in a row.

But the Bulls' forte is not individual excellence but team cohesion and it was probably the addition of Van Lier that was the most significant factor in the club's continued improvement. Coach Motta had been looking for a ball-handling guard to trigger his many-splendored attack ever since he arrived from Utah four years ago.

Early in the campaign Van Lier became available and the Bulls were in a perfect position to take advantage. The Cincinnati Royals were in need of center men and the Bulls could spare Jim Fox because rookie Cliff Ray had performed far beyond anyone's expectations.

Van Lier gave the Bulls more "penetration" on offense than they'd ever had before. And Ray gave them the best backup center play they'd ever had.

During the off-season the Bulls made no significant moves. Aware that it was a lean year in the college draft, they named Ralph Simpson, the former Michigan State star who was already playing in the American Basketball Association, their No. 1 pick. It was a calculated risk, like the one they took a year ago with Howard Porter. This time it didn't pan out immediately, but Motta and General Manager Pat Williams agreed that they didn't see anyone on the draft list who could have made the team, anyway.

So the Bulls' hopes for overhauling the Bucks and Los Angeles Lakers will depend on improvement of the talent on hand. But that is not an idle hope. In Bob Love and Chet Walker, they already have the best tandem of forwards in basketball. The experience that Howard Porter and Ken McIntosh received last year should make that position more solid than ever.

Van Lier will be with the club for the entire season this time and, as he gets better acquainted with his new teammates, should be improved even over his standing play of a year ago.

But where the Bulls are really hoping for gains is at center, where Ray appeared to come of age in the playoffs. Forced to carry the whole burden after Tom Boerwinkle's knee injury, Ray played the great Wilt Chamberlain almost to a standstill.

So the Bulls are hoping that this will be the year Chicago sheds its "Second City" label forever. At least as far as its N.B.A. team is concerned.

Pat Williams

Executive Vice President and General Manager



Pat Williams, the general manager of the Bulls, is the kind of guy who does the difficult immediately; the impossible takes a little longer. Few expected that the young executive would be able to accomplish the seemingly impossible task of running a successful pro basketball franchise in Chicago, which had long proved to be the graveyard of the cage sport.

But in his first year, with a combination of hard work, enthusiasm, and more gimickry than has been seen in a pro sport since Bill Veeck left baseball, Williams had put an average of better than 10,000 people a game into the Chicago Stadium.

Each of his two succeeding years have been even better. Other Williams accomplishments have been the trades which brought Chet Walker and Norm Van Lier to the Bulls, plus the sensational coup of signing Howard Porter when everyone else in the league assumed he was tied to the rival A.B.A. Williams also managed to persuade Coach Dick Motta to stay in Chicago in the face of a lucrative offer from the Dallas Chapparals.

Originally a baseball executive, Williams was named Minor League Executive of the Year in 1967. The next year, switching to basketball, he produced an all-time attendance record for the Philadelphia 76ers.

Williams reached another milestone on Oct. 21 with his marriage to the former Jill Marie Paige of Riverside, Ill., a graduate of Sterling (Kans.) College.

Dick Motta

Head Coach



Although Dick Motta did not retain the N.B.A. Coach of the Year honors he won in 1971, there were many who thought he did an even better job last year when he brought the Bulls home with a 57-25 record, the third best mark in the entire N.B.A.

It was also the most victories ever earned by a Chicago professional basketball team. But improvement is something people have come to expect from a Motta-coached team. The Bulls have gotten better every year since Motta came down from the mountains of Utah to guide their destiny in the N.B.A.

Using a disciplined, patterned offense based on six basic plays, each with as many as 25 variations, Motta's Bulls win many games against seemingly better material. But an even more distinguishing feature of a Motta-coached team, according to one N.B.A. coach, is that: "They never lose a game they should win."

Motta, who was not a good enough basketball player to make his college team, is a graduate of Utah State University. He began his coaching career in Grace, Idaho, where he met both his wife, Janice, and his current assistant coach, Phil Johnson.

His teams at Weber State College in Ogden, Utah, won six Big Sky Conference championships in nine years before Motta joined the Bulls. Born in Medvale, Utah, the 41-year-old Motta lives in Northbrook with his wife and three children.

Phil Johnson is serving his second tour of duty as an assistant to the Bulls' head coach, Dick Motta. Johnson, 31, spent four years as a Motta assistant at Weber State College, then succeeded him as head coach for three years when Motta left to coach the Bulls in 1968. Now they are reunited in Chicago. Johnson also played for Motta in junior high school and again at Weber Junior College. He captained the Utah State team as a college senior.

Johnson's Weber State teams lost only 15 games in three years and qualified for the NCAA playoffs each year. They lost only five games in the Big Sky Conference and he was named conference coach-of-the-year three times.

Johnson and his wife, Ann, have two sons.

Public Relations Director Ben Bentley is a Bulls' "original." Bentley was named the club's first public relations director when the city was awarded a franchise in 1966 and he's still doing business at the same stand.

25 CHET WALKER F 6-7 220 AGE 32 PRO 10 YRS. BRADLEY

Chet Walker is the kind of basketball player who responds to a challenge and so when it was suggested by some newspapermen midway through last season that the Jet appeared to be running out of fuel, what could be more natural than that he go out and have his greatest game ever?

That's exactly what Walker did, scoring a career-high 56 points in a game against Cincinnati. That was the single highest scoring total in the N.B.A. last season.

Actually, reports of Walker's demise were greatly exaggerated anyway. Although slowed at times by a nagging groin pull, Chet still ended the season with a 22-points-a-game average, tying his career high set the year before. In his three seasons with the Bulls Walker has never been below a 20-point average and with Bob Love forms the most potent forward combination in the N.B.A.

A brilliant one-on-one player Walker, in addition to being the 17th highest scorer in the league in 1971-72, had the eighth highest field goal percentage (.505) and the fourth best free throw shooting average (.847).

A former star at Bradley University, the 6-7 Walker played seven years for the Syracuse Nationals and Philadelphia Warriors before coming to the Bulls.

21 JIM KING G 6-2 175 AGE 31 PRO 9 YRS. TULSA

Jim King is the Cool Hand Luke of the Bulls, the kind of player who can come off the bench after an extended period of idleness and begin performing as if he'd been warming up all night.

Now recovered from the injuries which had threatened to put an early end to his career, King will be starting his 10th pro season this year. An original expansion draft choice of the Bulls, King didn't get to play for the Chicagoans until the 1970-71 season, when he was acquired from Cincinnati. In the interim he had been traded to the San Francisco Warriors in the deal that brought Guy Rodgers to Chicago.

A cerebral player, the 6-foot-2 King has been known to coach the team in an emergency. He played in 73 games for the Bulls last year, most of them spot performances.

4 JERRY SLOAN G 6-5 200 AGE 30 PRO 7 YRS. EVANSVILLE

Last season marked a milestone for Jerry Sloan. It was the first time in his seven-year N.B.A. career that the combative captain of the Bulls played in every one of his team's 82 games. Sloan is such a daring player that he has been frequently injured in the past, although he has now missed only two games in the last two seasons.

It isn't due to any change in style, though, that 6-foot-5 Sloan has avoided injury. Jerry was as pug-nacious as ever last season when, swinging between guard and forward, he outrebounded both of the team's starting forwards and finished behind only the two centers with a total of 691 boards. Jerry also averaged 16.2 points a game, which was off his 18.3 pace of a year ago, but still better than his lifetime average.

Sloan is an all-out performer who refuses to let the possibility of physical damage deter him. His only object is to win. He once told Coach Dick Motta: "If Wilt Chamberlain were coming at me full speed and I thought I could help the team by drawing a charging foul, I'd let him run right over me." His theory is: "I can't stop to think about getting hurt. Most of the guys out there are better than me and I have to prove I belong with them."

To everyone but himself, Sloan has proved that long ago. He was named last season to the first-string N.B.A. all-defensive team. It was his fourth consecutive year on the all-defensive team and his second time as a first-stringer.

Jerry was an all-state performer at McLeansboro (Ill.) High School and a small college All-American at Evansville. Obtained from the Baltimore Bullets in the expansion draft before the 1966-67 season, Sloan is the only Bull remaining from the original team.

27 ROWLAND GARRETT F 6-6 212 AGE 22 PRO 0 YRS. FLORIDA STATE

Rowland Garrett, the Bulls' fifth pick in the 1972 NBA college draft, helped Florida State's Seminoles finish second behind powerful UCLA in the 1972 NCAA tournament. Garrett averaged 13 points and 7.9 rebounds during Florida State's 27-6 season. In the NCAA playoffs, Florida State eliminated Eastern Kentucky, Minnesota, Kentucky and North Carolina State before losing to UCLA.

As a junior, Garrett was voted the team's most improved player and was also co-captain. "He's great on defense, a good leaper and does a great job on the boards," says Florida State coach Hugh Durham of the Canton (Miss.) native who was a high school All-American.

10 BOB LOVE F 6-8 215 AGE 29 PRO 7 YRS. SOUTHERN U.

The "love affair" between Chicago fans and the Bulls' all-star forward grew hotter than ever last season. Getting better every year, Bob Love popped in an average of 25.8 points a game for the Bulls in 1971-72, and for the first time was a starter in the All-Star game.

By season's end, Bob was the sixth highest scorer in the league and had made the All-Star team for the second year in a row. In addition, his defensive talents gained recognition for the first time when he made the second squad on the all-defensive team.

Although he missed three games due to injury, Love was an iron man when he was in there, averaging better than 39 minutes a game. In the playoffs, although hobbled by a severe ankle sprain, he led the club in minutes played.

Bob scored more than 2,000 points for the second year in a row and is the only player in Bulls' history to accomplish that feat even once.

His is one of the real rags-to-riches success stories in N.B.A. history. Bob had played on two other teams before coming to the Bulls in a trade with the Milwaukee Bucks and he had never averaged better than 6-7 points a game.

But in his first full season with the Bulls—and his fourth in the N.B.A.—Love proved that all he needed to become one of the game's top scorers was the opportunity. He averaged 21 points a game that year and has improved on that in each of the last two seasons.

40 KENNEDY McINTOSH F 6-7 215 AGE 23 PRO 1 YR. E. MICHIGAN

The No. 1 draft choice of the Bulls last year, Kennedy McIntosh saw only limited action. This was not surprising, however, when you remember that the Bulls had the highest-scoring forward combination in the league and bonus baby Howard Porter playing ahead of him.

Getting into 43 games for a total of 405 minutes, McIntosh was not able to maintain the scoring touch that had made him a collegiate standout at Eastern Michigan University. But he did display flashes of brilliance and showed an aggressiveness on the boards that was no surprise to anyone familiar with his collegiate record.

McIntosh scored 2,219 points and hauled in 1,426 rebounds at Eastern Michigan and he is confident that, given more court time, he can make it big in the N.B.A.

14 CLIFFORD RAY C 6-9 235 AGE 23 PRO 1 YR. OKLAHOMA

Clifford Ray's rookie statistics of a 7-point scoring average and 869 rebounds may not look spectacular but in this instance the figures do lie. The head coaches of the 17 N.B.A. teams, after watching the 6-9 jumping-jack from Oklahoma play all season, named him to the first team N.B.A. all-rookie squad.

He was the only player to make the team who was not a first-round draft choice. Picked in the third round, Ray was such a pleasant surprise with his rebounding and defensive play, that the Bulls were able to trade Jim Fox for Norm Van Lier, assured that Cliff could adequately back up starting center Tom Boerwinkle.

What they didn't know was that the rookie would have to go it alone against the great Wilt Chamberlain in the playoffs. But with Boerwinkle injured that's exactly what happened, and Cliff responded with the greatest performance of his life.

In the four games against the eventual champion Lakers, Ray averaged 15.3 points and 16.5 rebounds a game. He outscored Chamberlain, although big Wilt outrebounded him by four boards a game.

Ray, who never played basketball until his senior year in high school, is a shot blocker on defense who tries to pattern himself after Bill Russell. In fact, Russell was his idol and Cliff hopes to be in the same super-star category himself one day.

13 FRANK RUSSELL 6-3 180 G AGE 23 PRO 0 YRS. DETROIT

Frank Russell is a 6-foot-3 rookie guard from the University of Detroit who was selected in the third round of last year's NBA draft by the Bulls.

The 185-pound Russell became the ninth player to join the 1,000-point club at Detroit. He led the Titans in scoring in his sophomore and junior years with 15.7 averages and wound up with a 16.2 career scoring average. Russell was captain and most valuable player as a senior.

"Frank is a great perimeter shooter with excellent penetration," said Detroit coach Jim Harding. Russell's younger brother, Campy, is a 6-7 sophomore star at the University of Michigan. They hail from Pontiac.

44 HOWARD PORTER F 6-8 220 AGE 24 PRO 1 YR. VILLANOVA

The Bulls' Howard Porter did not have a super campaign in his rookie season, but Coach Dick Motta calmly predicts: "He'll be a great one. I'm glad we've got him." Breaking into a lineup that features Bob Love and Chet Walker at forward is not easy for a rookie, particularly with a coach who believes in bringing his youngsters along slowly.

Nevertheless, Porter got into 67 games last year for the Bulls. His statistics were not brilliant, until you take into account that his 6 points a game and total of 183 rebounds were accomplished in only 730 minutes. Project those totals over 40 minutes a game and Howard would have averaged 26 points and totaled 800 rebounds.

Porter has an uncanny touch with his jump shot and although he appears slender, the 6-foot-8 sophomore crashes the boards with authority. His biggest weaknesses appeared to be on defense and he occasionally had trouble hanging onto a pass. But Motta feels these faults will be corrected with more work.

An alumnus of Villanova, Porter was named the Most Valuable Player in the N.C.A.A. tournament in his senior year, 1971.

Bob Weiss is one of those coach's delights—the bench-warmer de luxe. Actually, calling Weiss a bench-warmer is like calling Helen Hayes a character actress. Bobby had more playing time last year than all but three of the regulars, although he seldom started.

His specialty is coming off the bench to fire up a rally. There are a lot of people who see him play and can't imagine why he doesn't start. That includes all the basketball writers in Los Angeles, where Bob has had some of his greatest games. He averaged 13.5 points a game against the Lakers in the playoffs, exactly two points better than his season average.

The previous season, when the Bulls carried the Lakers to the full seven games, Weiss, as a starter, was the star of the series. The 6-3 former Penn State star is now in his eighth season as a pro. But it has only been in his last three, since coming to the Bulls from Milwaukee in the same trade that brought Bob Love, that he has lived up to his potential.

With 377 assists last season, Weiss was second only to Norm Van Lier on the Bulls. Not bad for a "bench warmer".

2 NORM VAN LIER G 6-1 175 AGE 25 PRO 3 YRS. ST. FRANCIS

The trade that brought Norm Van Lier to the Bulls early last season was probably the single most important factor in the Chicago club's outstanding season. Van Lier was exactly the kind of playmaking guard Coach Dick Motta had been seeking.

Ironically, the Bulls had Van Lier once and let him go. Norm signed with the Bulls after his senior year at St. Francis College in Philadelphia, but before his rookie season began he was traded to Cincinnati for Walt Wesley.

The Bulls desperately needed a backup center at the time and although Motta and Pat Williams hated to let Van Lier go, both agreed that Wesley helped get the Bulls into the playoffs that year.

Last season, however, the shoe was on the other foot. Cincinnati was the team that needed a center and the Bulls had a spare one in Jim Fox. So the 6-foot-2 Van Lier was shipped back to Chicago.

Averaging nearly seven assists a game, Norm was sixth in the league in that category. In addition, he scored 12 points a game for the Bulls. But Norm is probably proudest of his accomplishments on defense. His critics said that because of his size, Van Lier would be a detriment on defense. But the quick-handed guard was one of three Bulls voted to the N.B.A. all-defensive team.

Tom Boerwinkle had his best season for the Bulls in 1971-72 even though his scoring average hit a four-year low for his N.B.A. career. Long Tom, who has never been below 9.8 points a game since coming to the Bulls as their No. 1 draft choice out of Tennessee, popped in only seven points a game last year.

But there was a simple explanation. With Cliff Ray around to take away some of the pressure, the 6-11 center was not required to play as many minutes of each game as he had done in the past.

Figures have never been a measure of Boerwinkle's worth to the Bulls. He sets one of the best picks in the game and is an excellent passer, both valuable assets in the Bulls' intricately-patterned style of play.

Tom's only disappointment last year was in missing the playoffs with a knee injury. He is always at his best in big games and against the big stars like Wilt Chamberlain and Kareem Jabbar.

MAJOR NBA RULE CHANGES

1. Elimination of the shooting of the first four team fouls.

The first four team fouls committed by a team in each quarter—the opponents shall put the ball into play at the sideline nearest where the foul occurred.

The first three team fouls committed by a team in each over-time period—the ball shall be put into play in the same manner as in the first four quarters.

Note: Shooting, back court and fighting (punching) fouls will carry their own penalties and are included in team totals.

2. Elimination of the restriction on players on the free throw lanes.

The free throw restriction applies until the ball leaves the free thrower's hands; except for the free thrower who may not cross the free throw line until the ball touches the ring or backboard or the free throw ends.

3. Time-outs

- regulation play (7)
- fourth quarter (4)
- last two minutes (3)
- over-time (2) (no restriction)

4. Time-out in back court

Once a team passes the ball into play from a point out-of-bounds that originates in their own back court, they may not call a time-out until the ball is in their front court.

Penalty: Illegal time-out—violation

If a request is made, the official shall sound his whistle for a violation and award the ball to the opposing team at mid-court.

In the case where possession may change, with the ball still in play, the team now in possession may call a time-out without penalty.

If a legal time-out is called in the back court in the last two minutes of regulation play or over-times, the ball shall be moved to mid-court. At all other times, the ball shall be passed in from a point out-of-bounds nearest to where the time-out was called.

5. Authorized Time-Outs

Each team must take at least one time-out per quarter. If neither team has taken a time-out during the first five minutes of each of the four regulation quarters, it shall be mandatory for the *official scorer* to take a time-out before the sixth minute of play is completed. If neither team has taken a second time-out before the tenth minute of play, it shall be mandatory for the *official scorer* to take a time-out before the eleventh minute of play has elapsed. If one team takes two time-outs during any single period, it is not mandatory for the *official scorer* to take a time-out.

Note: (1) The *official scorer* shall notify a team when it has been charged with a time-out.

(2) A time-out shall not be called after a score of any kind.

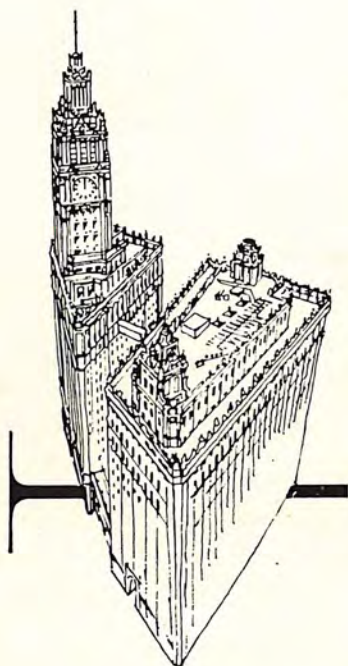
6. Thirty seconds to replace a disqualified player.

7. Coaches—A coach must remain in the immediate vicinity (area directly in front of) his bench at all times.

Note: A coach may go to the *scorer's table* only to check statistical items.
