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JERRY REINSDORF

Chairman / Alternate NBA Governor

Jerry Reinsdorf concluded his 44th season as chairman of the Chicago White Sox in 2024, only the seventh individual in Major League Baseball history to surpass the 40-year milestone as a club owner (Connie Mack holds the mark with 50 seasons in leadership of the Philadelphia A's).

During his time as chairman, Reinsdorf's two professional sports teams – the White Sox and the NBA's Chicago Bulls – have delivered seven World Championship titles to the city of Chicago and its fans. Reinsdorf accepted the Commissioner's Trophy from Bud Selig on October 26, 2005, after the White Sox swept their way to the team's first World Series Championship since 1917. The championship was celebrated by a ticker-tape parade attended by nearly 2 million Chicagoans.

The White Sox have reached the postseason seven times during Reinsdorf's tenure, most recently in 2021 when the team captured the American League Central title to reach the postseason in successive seasons for the first time in franchise history. The Sox also captured division titles in 1983, 1993, 2000, 2005 and 2008, as well as claiming a wild card berth in 2020. Every one of the club's Top 20 single-season attendance totals have come since 1981, including a franchise-record 2.95 million fans in 2006.

Reinsdorf's White Sox teams have featured three Most Valuable Player Award winners (Frank Thomas in 1993-94 and José Abreu in 2020), two Cy Young Award winners (Lamarr Hoyt in 1983 and Jack McDowell in 1993), four Rookies of the Year (last Abreu in 2014), five Managers of the Year (last Ozzie Guillen in 2005) and two Executives of the Year (Roland Hemond in 1983 and Rick Hahn in 2020).

Reinsdorf and the White Sox have received five prestigious honors in recognition of the franchise's ongoing commitment to giving back to the community. In December 2022, Reinsdorf and the White Sox received MLB's Allan H. Selig Award for Philanthropic Excellence, recognizing the team's Amateur City Elite (ACE) program which provides baseball and educational opportunities for underserved Chicago youth. Since its inception in 2007, more than 30 ACE players have been drafted, while more than 280 have signed scholarships to play college baseball. The White Sox are just the third franchise to be honored with the Selig Award twice, also being recognized in 2011 for the club's Volunteer Corps program, an initiative that activates staff, players, resources and over 5,000 fan volunteers for various projects improving the Chicagoland community.

In June 2011, Reinsdorf traveled to Washington D.C. to accept the Jefferson Award, one of the nation's top honors for community service and volunteerism, known as the "Nobel Prize for Public Service," while in August 2011, he received the Barnes and Thornburg Jackie Robinson Award for diversity in the workplace. In September 2012, Reinsdorf and the White Sox were again recognized nationally, receiving the Steve Patterson Award for Excellence in sports philanthropy for the team's Volunteer Corps program. Reinsdorf's life-long support for charitable and community organizations has resulted in numerous other awards and recognitions.

Both of Reinsdorf's sports franchises have donated millions of dollars to causes in the Chicago community through a variety of efforts, including Chicago White Sox Charities and Chicago Bulls Charities. Chicago White Sox Charities has donated more than \$47 million to worthy Chicagoland organizations in cumulative giving. In 2015, the Chicago Bulls received honors as the inaugural ESPN Sports Humanitarian Team of the Year, and in 2017, the White Sox were finalists for the same award, which celebrates and recognizes how members of the sports industry use sport to serve their communities and make a positive impact. In December 2017, owners for five Chicago sports teams – the Bears, Blackhawks, Bulls, Cubs and White Sox – joined together as the Chicago Sports Alliance to donate \$1 million annually to the UChicago Crime Lab and other worthy programs in an ongoing effort to support solutions to the violence that plagues some neighborhoods in Chicago.

Reinsdorf was instrumental in the formation of the Diverse Business Partners (DBP) Program in 1998, and Major League Baseball honored Reinsdorf and the White Sox with the Club Appreciation Award in 2018 to celebrate the program's 20th anniversary. Over the past 20-plus years, Major League Baseball and its clubs have purchased hundreds of millions of dollars in goods and services from minority and women-owned businesses, and the White Sox annually rank among baseball's leaders in the DBP program.

In recognition of his life-long commitment to promoting diversity, Reinsdorf's White Sox hosted Major League Baseball's 2013 Diversity Summit in Chicago, and the franchise also was chosen to host MLB's Civil Rights Game and Beacon Awards Luncheon in August 2014.

Since heading the limited partnership that purchased the White Sox in January 1981, Reinsdorf has been involved in Major League Baseball initiatives at an industry-wide level. He served



on the Commissioner's Executive Council and many other committees, including Player Relations, Relocation, Ownership & Legislative, Business and Media Board and Long-Range Labor Planning.

In 2008, his long history of donating time to Major League Baseball led to Reinsdorf being asked to serve on the Board of The Baseball Hall of Fame. Frank Thomas and Tony La Russa were inducted as members of the Hall of Fame's Class of 2014, Tim Lincecum in 2017, Jim Thome in 2018, Harold Baines in 2019 and longtime great Minnie Minoso was inducted in July 2022. Ken "Hawk" Harrelson was honored with the Ford C. Frick Award for broadcasting excellence in 2020.

Reinsdorf expanded his involvement in professional sports in March 1985 by purchasing controlling interest in the Chicago Bulls. During his tenure as chairman of the Bulls – the third-largest in the NBA – the team has captured six World Championships (1991-93, '96-98). Reinsdorf was inducted into the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2016 in Springfield, Mass., becoming the 10th NBA owner to be honored.

Born in Brooklyn, N.Y. on February 25, 1936, Reinsdorf graduated from George Washington University and earned a law degree from Northwestern University after moving to Chicago in 1957. Reinsdorf and his wife, Martyl, have three surviving children, nine grandchildren and one great grandchild. ■

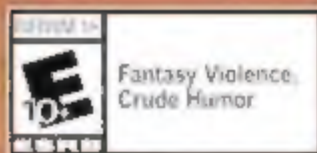

EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT



Arturas Karnišovas (Car-NISH-O-Vas) begins his fifth season as Executive Vice President – Basketball Operations for the Chicago Bulls in 2024-25 ... he is the seventh individual to head the basketball operations department in Bulls history, joining Dick Klein (1966-69), Pat Williams (1969-73), Dick Motta (1973-76), Rod Thorn (1978-85), Jerry Krause (1985-2003) and John Paxson (2004-2020) ... Karnišovas was the architect behind Chicago's first NBA Playoffs appearance since 2016-17, as the Bulls finished with a 46-36 regular season record to earn the sixth seed heading in the 2022 NBA Playoffs ... he brought in head coach Billy Donovan, multi-year All-Stars in DeMar DeRozan and Nikola Vucevic and Alex Caruso, a two-time NBA All-Defensive selection while with Chicago, within his first year at the helm of the Bulls front office ... throughout his tenure in Chicago, he is responsible for Chicago's selections of Patrick Williams (fourth overall, 2020), Ayo Dosunmu (38th overall, 2021), Dalen Terry (18th overall, 2022) and Matas Buzelis (11th overall, 2024), along with acquiring Julian Phillips (35th overall, 2023 by Boston) on draft night during the 2023 NBA Draft ... under Karnišovas' watch, the Bulls have continued to place an emphasis on player development, leading to the growth of many of its young players and resulting in two Rising Stars appearances for Dosunmu and a 2024 NBA Most Improved Player finalist in Coby White ... his recent transactions with Chicago include the acquisition of guard Josh Giddey in a trade with the Oklahoma City Thunder, in addition to the free-agent signing of Jalen Smith during the 2024 offseason ... Karnišovas previously

worked for the Denver Nuggets from 2013-2020, starting as the team's Assistant General Manager, then was promoted to Assistant General Manager and Vice President of Basketball Operations, before being elevated to General Manager while with Denver, he oversaw the notable Draft selections of Nikola Jokic (41st overall, 2014), Jamal Murray (seventh overall, 2017) and Michael Porter Jr. (14th overall, 2018) ... Karnišovas also played a role in the free-agent signing of Paul Millsap ... the Nuggets improved their winning percentage in each of Karnišovas' seasons with the team ... he was also involved with USA Basketball, serving as an International Personnel Scout for the 2014 FIBA World Cup squad that claimed gold in Spain ... prior to Denver, he spent five years with the Houston Rockets (2008-13), starting as their Director of Global Scouting before being elevated to Director of Scouting while with the Rockets, the team drafted Marcus Morris (14th overall, 2011) and Chandler Parsons (38th overall, 2011), as well as traded for Kyle Lowry, Goran Dragić and James Harden ... prior to joining a team, he worked more than four years at the NBA (2003-08) in its basketball operations division ... as a player, Karnišovas enjoyed a storied international career, where he played for Barcelona, Bologna, Olympiakos and Athens ... he helped his team advance to the Euroleague Final Four on three occasions, and he claimed FIBA's European Player of the Year in 1996 while with Barcelona ... Karnišovas was a three-time Spanish League champion with Barcelona (1996, 1997, 2001) ... as a member of Olympiakos Piraeus in the 1997 McDonald's Championship in Paris, he



scored 19 points against the Chicago Bulls ... in 1992, and again in 1996, he led his native Lithuania to bronze medals in the Summer Olympics ... native of Klaipėda, Lithuania, and came to the United States in 1990 at the age of 18 ... played for P.J. Carlesimo at Seton Hall, where he became the first player from the Soviet Union to play college basketball in the United States ... enjoyed a decorated collegiate career for the Pirates, where he was a four-year starter and helped the Hall claim two Big East Tournament titles and make four trips to the NCAA Tournament ... finished his collegiate playing days with 1,509 points and was a two-time Big East Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year ... in 2016, he received Seton Hall's Most Distinguished Alumnus Award, the university's most prestigious alumni award which is presented to an individual who has been recognized as an outstanding leader in his or her professional field ... he and his wife, Gina, have two sons, Eric and Michael ■



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MARC EVERSLEY

General Manager

Marc Eversley begins his fifth season with the Bulls as the team's General Manager for the upcoming 2024-25 campaign ... he reports to Executive Vice President – Basketball Operations Arturas Karnišovas and is primarily responsible for overseeing the implementation of all elements of the basketball operations process ... during his tenure in Chicago, Eversley has been instrumental in creating the culture that helped lead Chicago to its first NBA Playoff appearance in five seasons after finishing 46-36 during the regular season in 2022 ... he played a vital role in adding pivotal players such as multi-year All-Stars in DeMar DeRozan and Nikola Vucevic, along with two-time NBA All-Defensive selection Alex Caruso within his first year as General Manager for Chicago while working in lockstep with head coach Billy Donovan who joined the club in 2020 ... Eversley helped implement the Bulls long-term vision that resulted in an emphasis on developing young talent, leading to major growth from guard Ayo Dosunmu (drafted 38th overall, 2021), the emergence of a NBA Most Improved Player finalist from Coby White in his fifth NBA season and continued improvements from Dalen Terry (drafted 18th overall, 2022) and Julian Phillips (acquired via trade during 2023 NBA Draft) during the 2024 offseason. Eversley helped secure the selection of Matas Buzelis (drafted 11th overall, 2024) and the additions of guard Josh Giddey via trade with the Oklahoma City Thunder and Jalen Smith who was signed in free agency ... in 2021, Eversley

was elected as a Class A Director to the Canada Basketball Board of Directors ... he has 16 years of NBA experience working for the Toronto Raptors, Washington Wizards and Philadelphia 76ers ... most recently served as Senior Vice President of Player Personnel with the 76ers, where he not only oversaw personnel and talent evaluation, but was also involved in Philadelphia's recruiting and decision-making process ... Eversley was promoted to Senior Vice President after serving the first two seasons as Vice President of Player Personnel ... he also oversaw Philadelphia's scouting department on the collegiate, NBA and international levels ... Eversley was a part of the 76ers selecting Ben Simmons first-overall in the 2016 NBA Draft, and he helped Philadelphia transition from a team that won 28 games his first season in 2016-17 to one that won 50-plus games the next two seasons ... had a hand in acquiring such players as J.J. Redick, Jimmy Butler and Tobias Harris to fortify a roster that included Simmons and Joel Embiid ... prior to joining the 76ers, Eversley spent three seasons with the Washington Wizards as Vice President of Player Personnel ... began his NBA career with the Toronto Raptors where he spent seven seasons as an Assistant General Manager responsible for player development, then personnel scouting and evaluation, and he played a lead role in drafting DeMar DeRozan ninth-overall in the 2009 NBA Draft ... Eversley concluded the final two seasons of his Toronto tenure as the Vice President of College Scouting ... before working in

the NBA. Eversley spent five years at Nike's world headquarters in Oregon as its NBA Player Relationship Manager, which advanced his development in managing relationships with athletes, along with team and athlete brand management ... got his start in retail, managing Nike-owned stores in Ontario, before moving to Nike Canada's corporate office where he oversaw the basketball assets ... worked for six years with Nike Canada before moving to Oregon ... Eversley has participated in the NBA's Basketball Without Borders program in both September 2011 in Johannesburg, and in August 2017 in Europe ... attended high school in Brampton, Ontario, and went to college at Urbana University in Urbana, Ohio, on a basketball scholarship ... Eversley and his wife, Jen, have one daughter, Nora, and stepdaughter, Alison. ■



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BILLY DONOVAN

Head Coach

Entering his fifth season as head coach of the Chicago Bulls for the 2024-25 season ... has posted a 399-319 (.556) record during his 10 seasons as an NBA head coach with Chicago (2020-present) and the Oklahoma City Thunder (2015-2020) ... entering this season, his 399 career wins is the 56th-most by any head coach in NBA history and ranks 11th among all active coaches ... holds a career record with the Bulls of 156-162 (.491) heading into the 2024-25 campaign, marking the fifth-most wins by any head coach in team history ... Donovan helped the Bulls return to the NBA Playoffs in 2021 for the first time since the 2016-17 season, securing a 46-36 regular season record to earn the sixth seed in postseason play ... the 46 regular season victories in 2021-22 was the franchise's highest win total since 2014-15 ... was named October/November NBA Coach of the Month in 2021-2022 ... Chicago made two Play-In Tournament finale appearances in both 2023 and 2024, advancing out of the first round of the tournament in each season before narrowly missing out on NBA Playoff action ... previously, Donovan spent five seasons as head coach for the Oklahoma City Thunder ... was named the 2020 recipient of the Michael H. Goldberg NBPA Coach of the Year Award, along with Mike Budenholzer ... while in OKC, his teams amassed a record of 243-157 (.608) and made five consecutive trips to the playoffs ... his winning percentage at the conclusion of the 2019-20 season ranked 16th (min. 100 games) in NBA history and trailed only Nick Nurse (.721), Steve Kerr (.709) and Gregg Popovich (.675) among active coaches ... he was also one of only four active first-time head coaches in the league at the time (along with Rick Carlisle, Steve Kerr and Erik Spoelstra) to lead their teams to the playoffs in each of their first five seasons as a

head coach ... in 2015-16, his first season with the Thunder, he guided the team to a record of 55-27 (.671), as it claimed the Northwest Division title and advanced to the Western Conference Finals ... Donovan's 55 wins that season put him in select company, as he became just the third first-year head coach over the previous 15 seasons to win 55 or more games in his first season ... on April 5, 2017, at Memphis, the Thunder defeated the Grizzlies 103-100 for Donovan's 100th career victory in the NBA, and with the win, he became the first NBA head coach to win 100 or more games in his first two seasons after coming straight from the collegiate level ... he claimed his 200th career coaching win on Oct. 27, 2019, versus Golden State ... prior to his arrival in Oklahoma City, Donovan held a 19-year stint as the head coach at the University of Florida ... he coached his teams to an overall record of 467-186 (.715), and his time was highlighted by back-to-back National Championships in 2006 and 2007 ... the consecutive titles marked the first time a men's program won two straight basketball championships since Duke in 1991 and 1992 ... he also led the Gators to the Final Four in 2000 (losing in the NCAA Championship Game) and 2014, while making 14 trips to the NCAA Tournament and two appearances in the NIT ... his Gator teams posted 16 straight seasons with 20 or more wins, three campaigns with 30 or more wins, 17 consecutive trips to the postseason and six SEC Championships ... in 2014-15, at the age of 49 years old, he became the second-youngest coach in NCAA history (Bobby Knight, 48-years old) to post 500 wins ... he has been the recipient of numerous collegiate coaching awards including ESPN.com's National Coach of the Year (2001), the Wooden Award's "Legends of Coaching" Honor (2010) and SEC Coach of

the Year (2011, 2013, 2014) ... Donovan's first experience as a head coach came in 1994 at Marshall University after serving as a graduate assistant at Kentucky from 1989-1994 ... In two seasons with the Thundering Herd, he posted a record of 35-20 (.636) ... he served as the head coach of USA's U18 and U19 National Teams from 2012-14 ... over that time, his squads compiled a record of 19-0 and claimed three gold medals during national team competition ... played four seasons at Providence (1983-87) and averaged 20.6 ppg his senior year, helping lead the Friars to the 1987 Final Four ... that season he earned Southeast Regional Most Outstanding Player honors, and also was named to the 1987 All-Big East first team, the 1987 Big East All-Tournament team and was an honorable mention All-American ... drafted by the Utah Jazz in the third round (68th overall) of the 1987 NBA Draft and played a total of 44 games with the New York Knicks in 1987-88 ... in 1999, he was inducted into the Providence College Hall of Fame ... 59 years old ... he and his wife, Christine, have four children: Billy, Hasbrouck, Bryan and Connor. ■

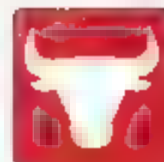

the team's annual grant program. Our engagement in this work is always enhanced by our passionate players who are eager to join us in our efforts to create a better Chicago for all. ■

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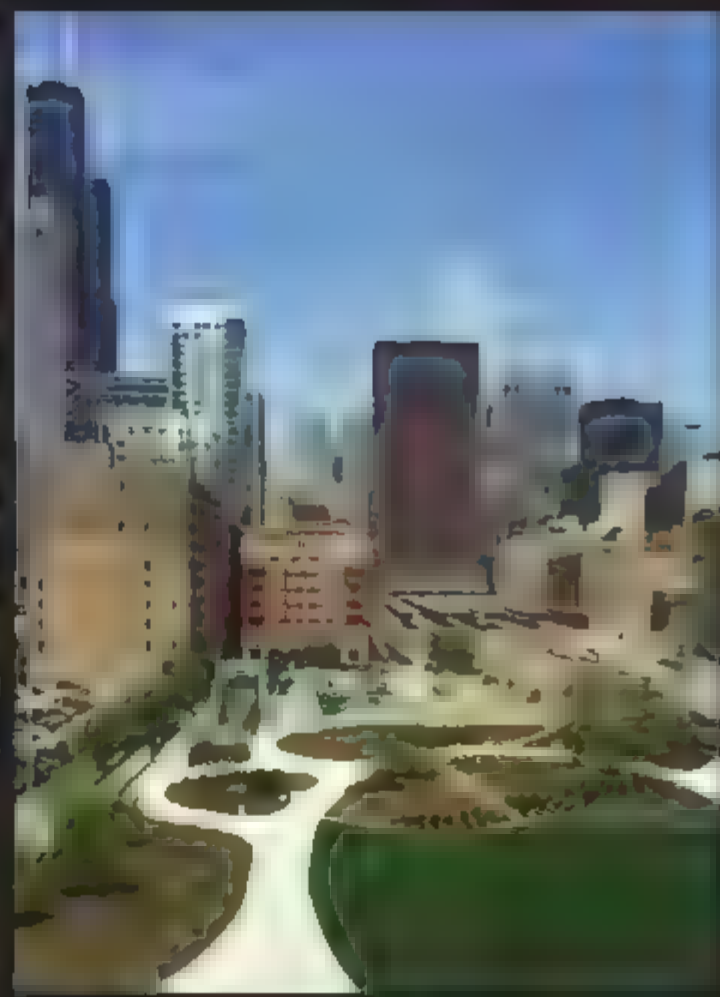
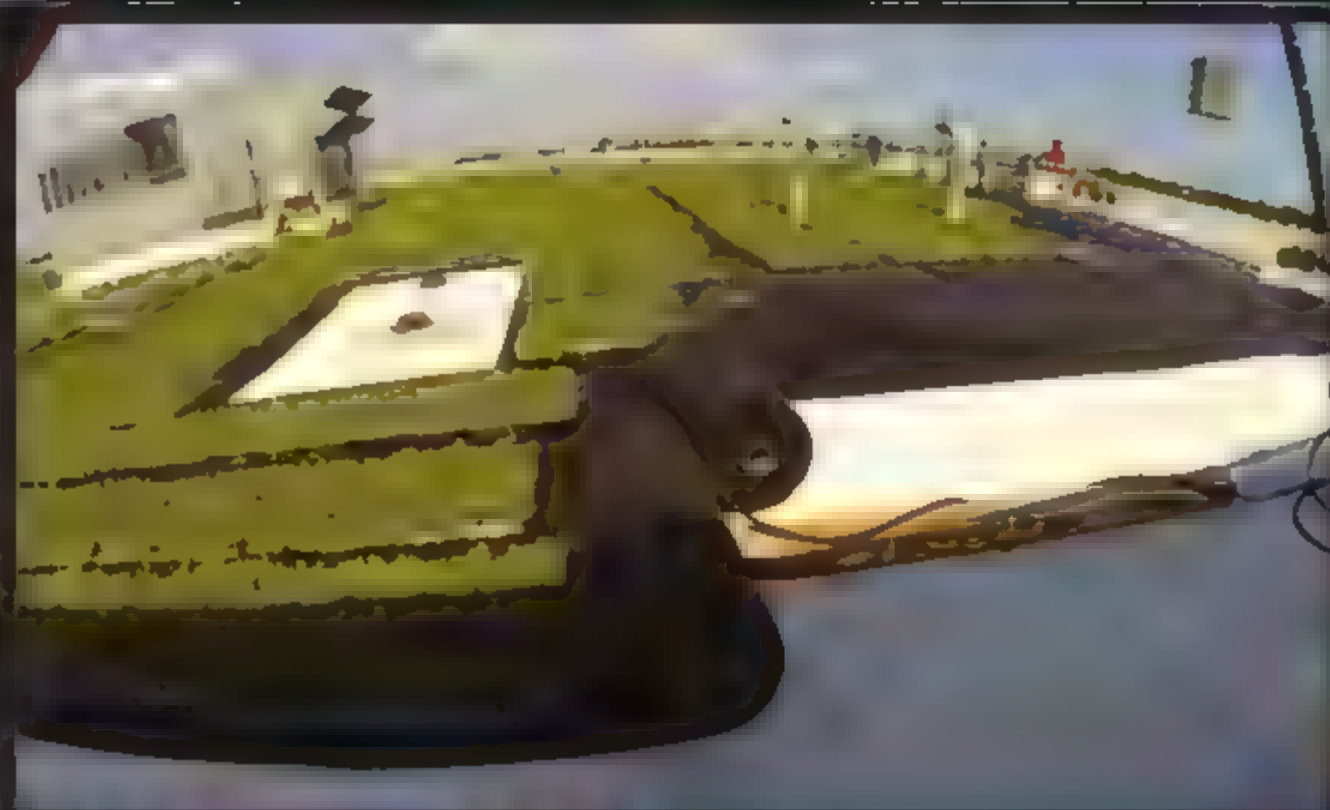


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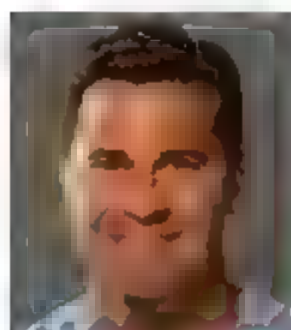
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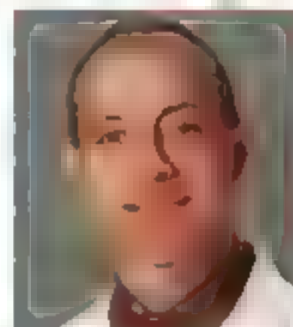
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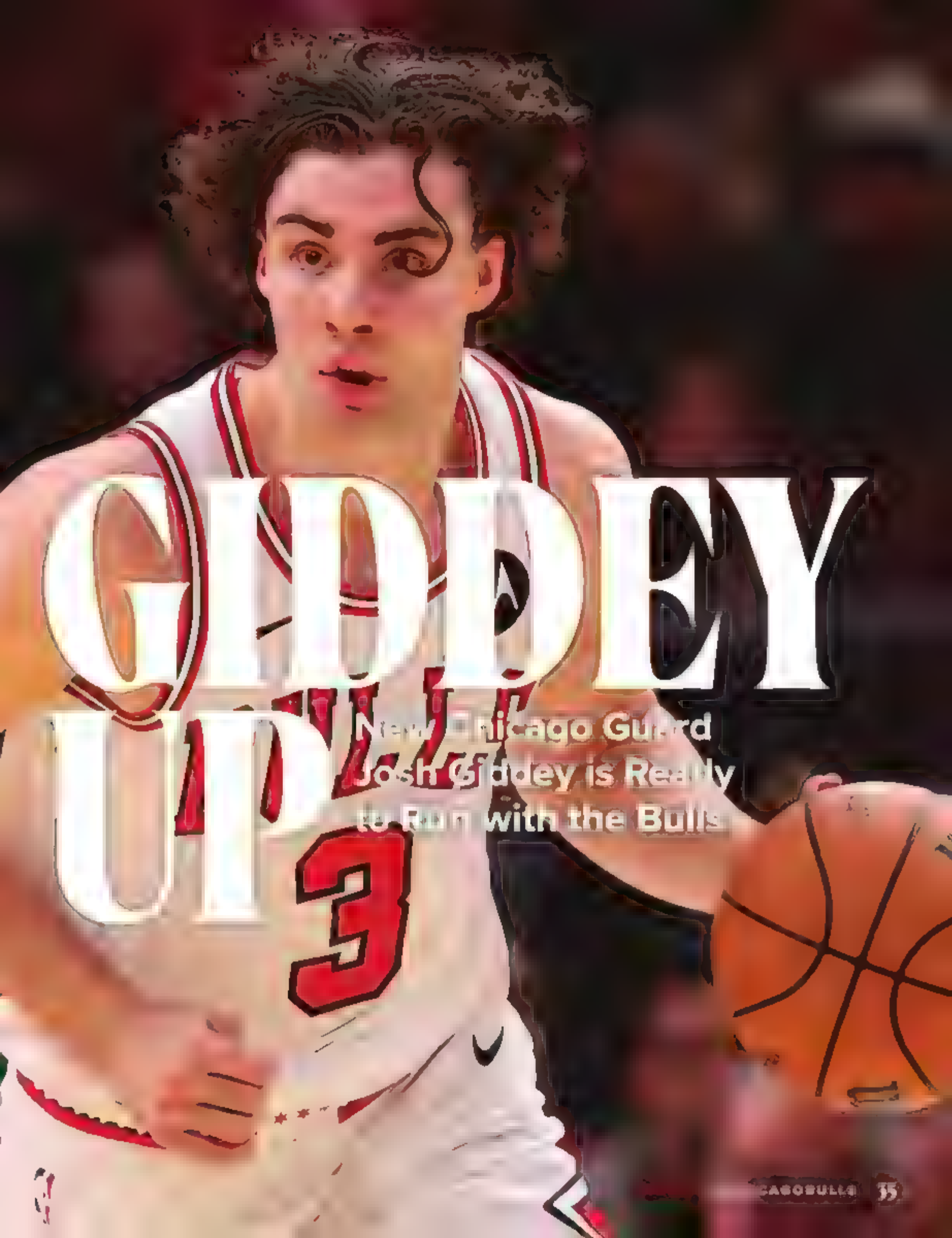

New Chicago Guard
Josh Giddey is Really

The summer of 2024 saw a significant change of direction for the Chicago Bulls as the team embraced the idea of shaking up its roster by trading veteran guard Alex Caruso to the Oklahoma City Thunder for potentially one of the NBA's brightest young stars, Josh Giddey.

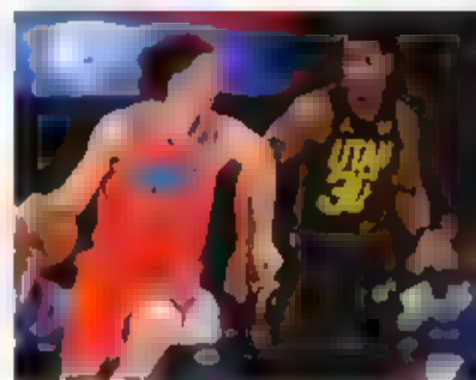
At 21 years old and now in his fourth NBA season, Giddey has shown plenty of flashes of brilliance on the hardwood. He is one of the league's most versatile playmakers. His Windy City arrival signifies a bold new chapter for a franchise looking to evolve, retool, and reclaim its place among the NBA's top teams.

For Josh Giddey, the move to Chicago is more than a change of scenery; it

is a golden opportunity for him to lead a young, hungry team back to relevance.

From Down Under to the Windy City

Born October 10, 2002, Josh Giddey's path to the NBA was never conventional, but it always seemed destined. Born in Melbourne, Australia, Giddey grew up in a basketball family. His father, Warrick, played professionally with the Melbourne Tigers in Australia's National Basketball League (NBL), and his mother, Kim, played professionally in the WNBL, also with the Melbourne Tigers. From a young age, Josh was taught the ins and outs of the game. His early years saw him rise quickly through Australia's youth basketball system, leading to a breakout season with the NBL's Adelaide

At 18, Giddey became the youngest player in NBL history to record a triple-double, drawing the attention of NBA scouts. Then, at the 2021 NBA Draft, the Oklahoma City Thunder selected him as the sixth overall pick, making Giddey the second-highest Australian (Ben Simmons, No. 1 in 2016) ever drafted.



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Giddey's rookie season with the Thunder far exceeded expectations. He showed an uncanny ability to control the game with his passing, court vision, and high basketball IQ. It didn't take long for him to be recognized as a standout among the league's young guards. As he did in Australia, Giddey, at 19, became the youngest player in NBA history to record a triple-double and matched Dallas' Luka Dončić for the most triple-doubles as a teenager in league history. He also joined the great Hall of Famer Oscar Robertson that first season as one of the only two rookies in NBA history to post three consecutive triple-doubles. And he was a four-time NBA Western Conference Rookie of the Month (2021-22: Nov., Dec., Jan., and Feb.)

As the Bulls endured an up-and-down 2023-24 campaign, it became apparent changes were necessary. Chicago's front office, long an admirer of Giddey, recognized his potential as a linchpin player for their future. On June 21, 2024, the trade was finalized, sending fan favorite and one of the NBA's top defensive players, Alex Caruso, to the Thunder, bringing Giddey to the Windy City.

A New Dawn in Chicago

The Bulls are no strangers to star power, and Chicago has long been a place where greatness is expected. In Josh Giddey, Bulls fans are getting a player who has already displayed the makings of a franchise cornerstone. His arrival has shifted the team's focus toward a fast-paced, playmaking, pass-first offense that he is more than equipped to lead.

"We've got a hell of a playmaker in Josh," Zach LaVine, a two-time NBA All-Star with the Bulls, says with a smile. "I've played against him plenty of times, so I know what he brings. Josh makes the game fun and easier



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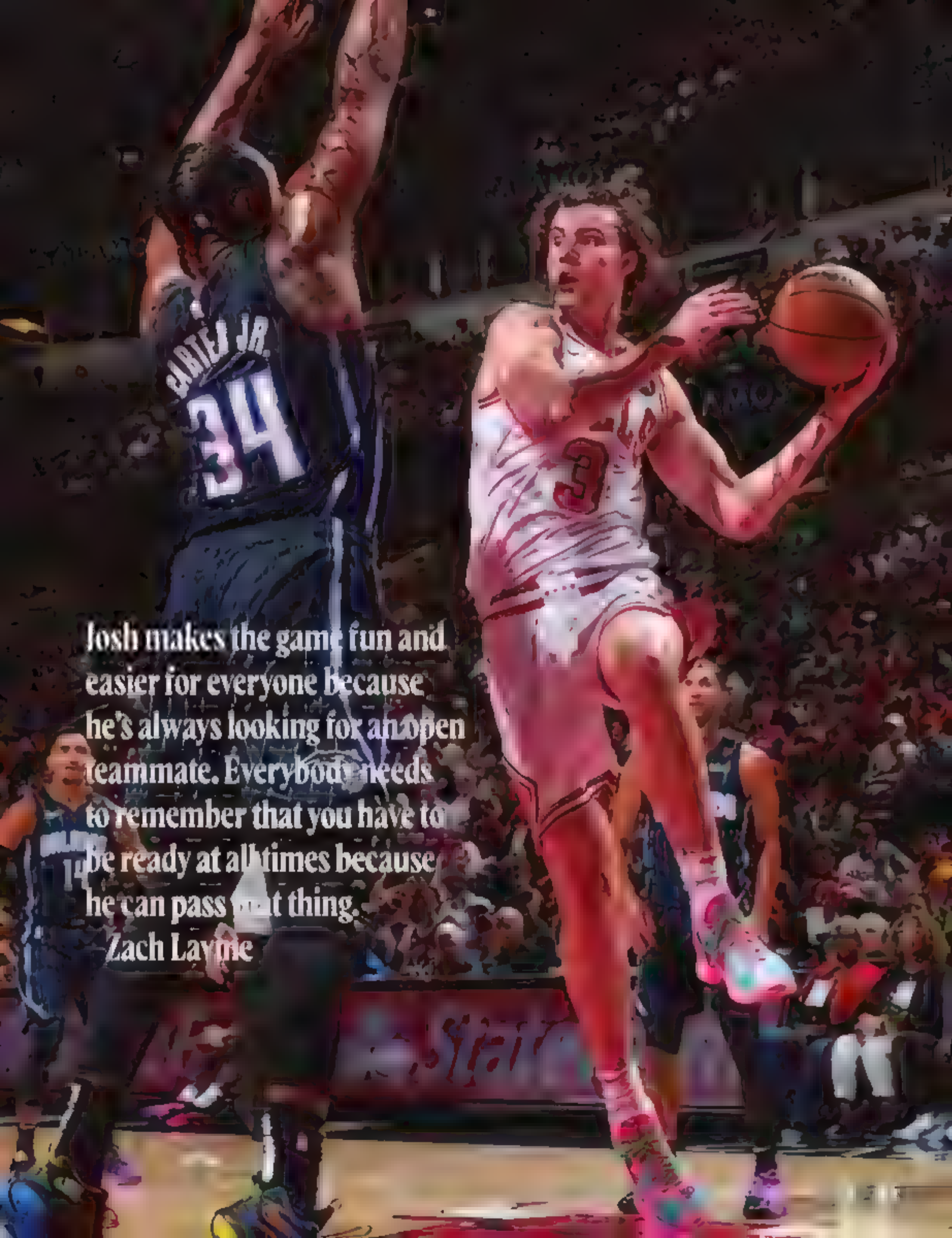


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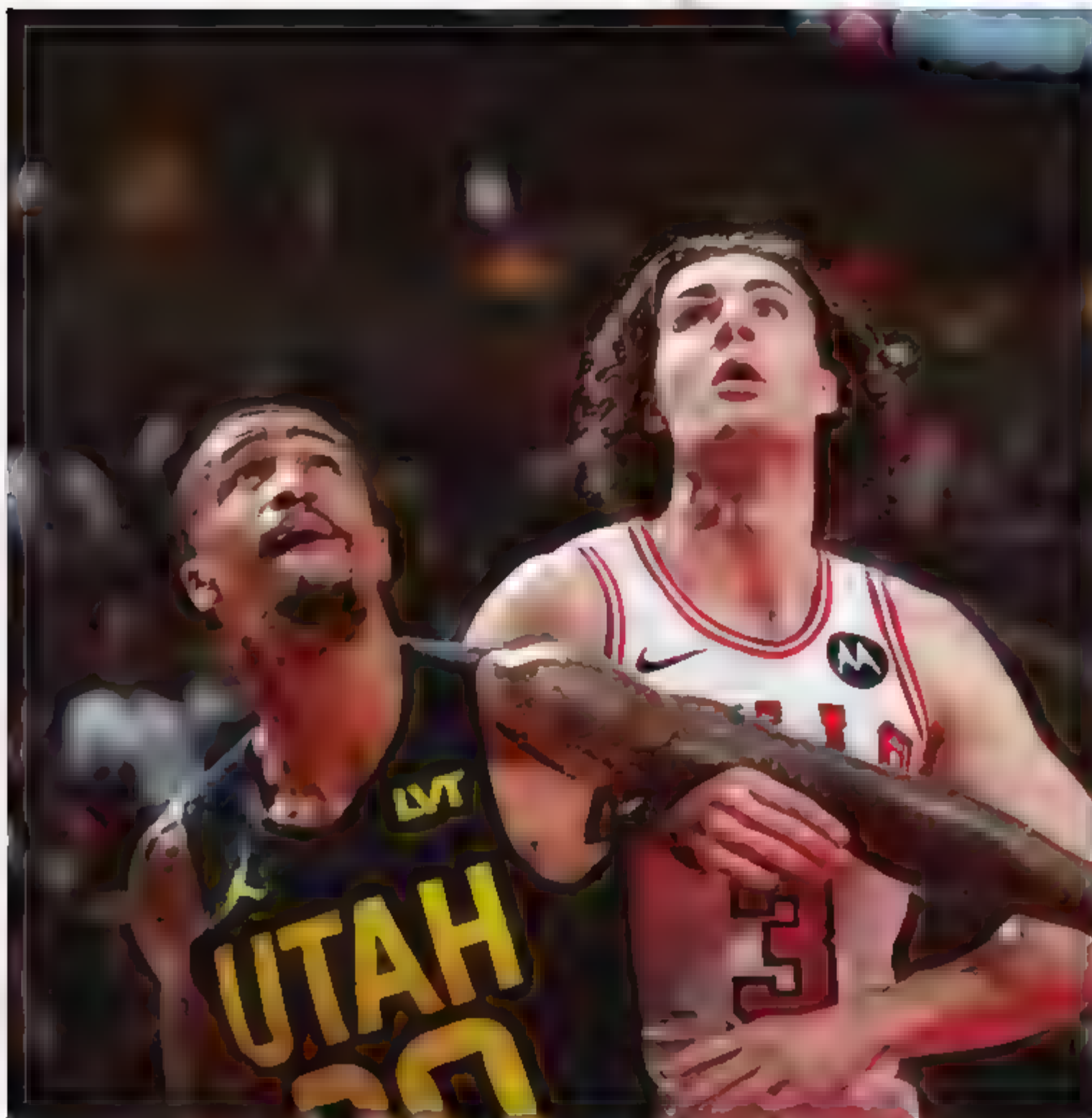


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for everyone because he's always looking for an open teammate. Everybody needs to remember that you have to be ready at all times because he can pass that thing."

Head Coach Billy Donovan also quickly praises Giddey's abilities, pointing to his size, court vision, and basketball IQ. "Josh is a special player," Donovan says. "At his size and how he sees the floor, he makes everyone around him

better. He's made an immediate impact on the way we play."

Giddey's role in Chicago is clear: he's the floor general, the engine that will drive a fast-paced, ball-movement-heavy offense. His unselfishness and ability to create easy scoring opportunities for his teammates are game-changers for a Bulls team that, at times over the last few seasons, struggled with stagnation in its offense.

Josh is the kind of guy you love playing with because he's always looking to make the right play," LaVine adds. "With Josh running the show, I'm excited to see how high we can elevate our offense."

Team Transformed: How Josh Giddey Fits in the Bulls' System

Giddey's versatility opens up a world of possibilities for the Bulls, especially

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with the recent departure of DeMar DeRozan, who was traded to the Sacramento Kings in a three-team deal that also involved the San Antonio Spurs. DeRozan's exit frees room for Giddey to operate as the primary facilitator.

At 6'8", Giddey is a unique point guard who can see over most defenses and take advantage of his size when he attacks the rim. His height and ability to grab rebounds also allow the Bulls to play faster in transition, which Donovan has emphasized this season.

"Josh does a great job of controlling the pace of the game," says Coby

White. "He loves to get out and run, but there's also a calmness to him that rubs off on the rest of us. He has been a huge addition."

One area where Giddey's impact was immediately felt was ball movement. In the past, the Bulls relied heavily on isolation plays, especially with scorers like DeRozan and LaVine. But with Giddey at the helm, the offense has become more fluid, with constant movement and passing leading to higher-quality shots.

Chicago's front office is banking on Giddey's playmaking abilities to

unlock the full potential of their roster. Nikola Vučević, who operates best in pick-and-pop or pick-and-roll situations, has thrived playing with a pass-first point guard like Giddey. Vučević is particularly excited about the prospects for the future.

Josh has that rare ability to make his teammates better," Vučević echoes. "He sees the game differently, and for a center like me, having a point guard who knows how to get you the ball in the right spots is huge. We've already built great chemistry on the court, and the more we play together, the better it will get."



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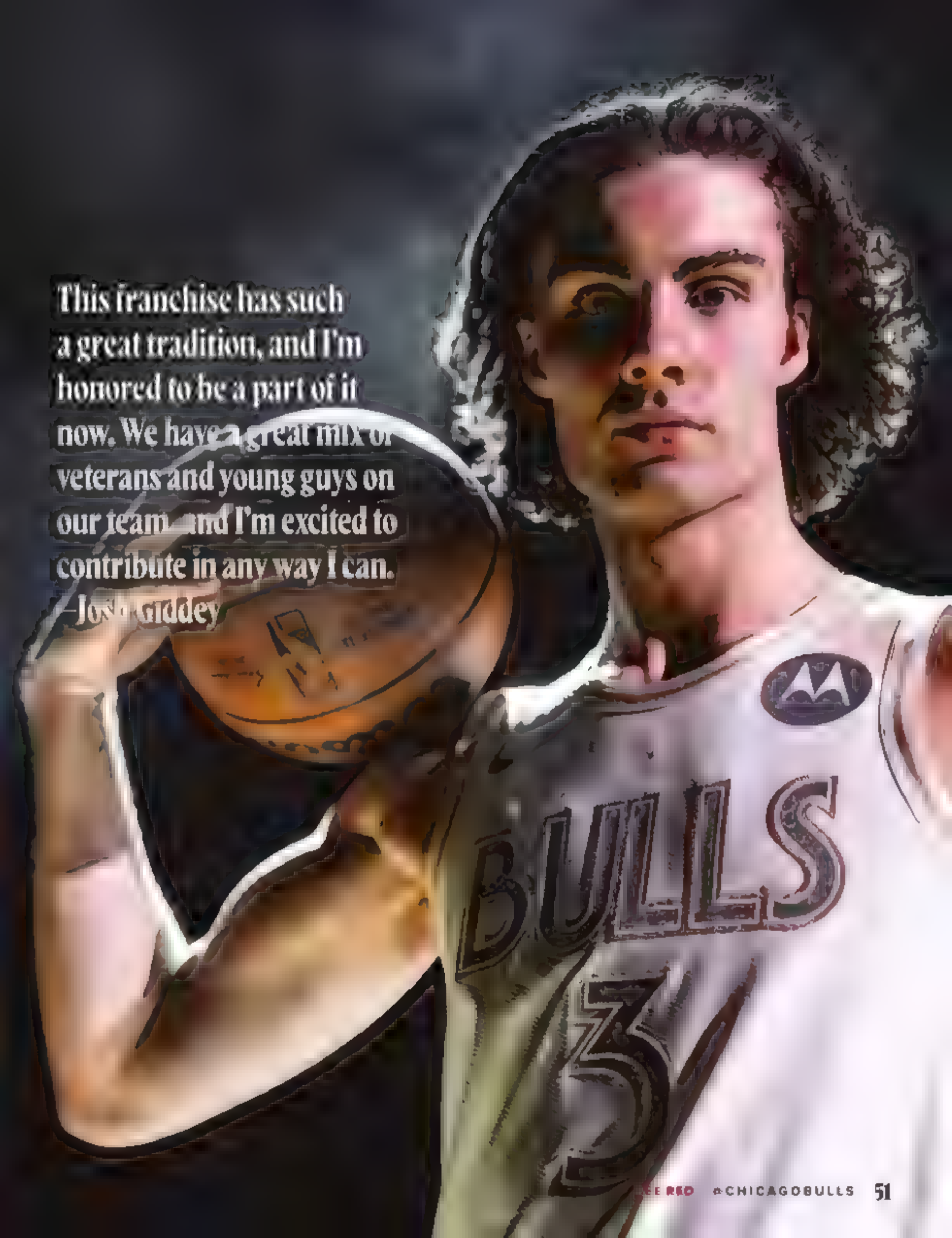

Growing Pains and the Path Ahead

He's no longer the focal point of a rebuilding franchise like in Oklahoma City—now, he's part of a team with higher immediate expectations. His maturity throughout his young career suggests he's more than up for the task.

"I'm excited about playing for the Bulls," Giddey says. "This franchise has such a great tradition, and I'm honored to be a part of it now. We have a great mix of veterans and young guys on our team, and I'm excited to contribute in any way I can."

Filling the Leadership Void

One of the biggest storylines surrounding the Bulls this season is the departure of DeMar DeRozan, who had been a team leader on and off the court since his arrival in 2021. DeRozan's ability to

The Bulls are also looking to LaVine to continue to lead. With Giddey managing much of the playmaking duties, LaVine can focus more on scoring and providing veteran guidance to the younger players. LaVine's budding relationship with Giddey has been a positive factor in the Bulls forging their new identity.

"Josh has been great to work with," insists LaVine. "He's always in the gym, always looking to get better, and that attitude is contagious."

Giddey, for his part, is excited to embrace the challenge.

"I've always loved the game for the way it brings people together," Giddey says. "And I think we have something really special here in Chicago. I look forward to getting on the court with my new teammates every day."

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My job is to make my teammates' life easy," Giddey adds. "I'm trying to get Zach the ball, Coby the ball, get these guys easy looks, and take the load off them. We always talk about how we want to play. Get up the floor, kick the ball ahead, and run. Look at the guys we have on this team. Coby, Zach, Ayo (Dosunmu), Patrick, Julian (Phillips); getting out in transition with these guys can make this team scary."

If we don't run, we're done," Donovan adds. "It's really that simple. If we run, we'll have a lot of fun."

We've got an unselfish group. Everyone tries to give each other good shots," Giddey chimes. "Sometimes we can be too unselfish and turn the ball over too much. But those mistakes come from a good place. It's always better to try and set a teammate up for

a good shot than the opposite. Every one wants to play with guys looking to make the right play."

As the Bulls begin this new chapter, one thing is clear: with Josh Giddey leading the way, the future is bright, and Josh Giddey is ready to take center stage. ■

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Welcome to the Madhouse

The United Center Celebrates 30 Years

In 1994, Chicago witnessed the opening of a venue that would forever alter its landscape: the United Center. This state-of-the-art arena nicknamed "The Madhouse on Madison," was more than just a replacement for the legendary Chicago Stadium—it was the start of a new era in Chicago sports, equipped to bring the city's athletic and cultural life into the modern age. A collaboration between Chicago Bulls Chairman Jerry Reinsdorf and

championships are only a few unforgettable memories in the arena's history. Beyond sports, the United Center also became a cultural landmark, hosting national political conventions twice and artists from around the globe, solidifying its status as a symbol of Chicago's vibrant spirit.

Architectural Vision and Unique Design Features

The United Center was conceived as a reaction to the limitations of the

Chicago Stadium while creating an experience that embraced the future. At nearly 1 million square feet, the arena was designed to be one of the largest in the country, holding a capacity of over 20,000 for basketball and 19,000 for hockey. The iconic facade—a blend of granite and glass—set a striking tone that symbolized the promise of grandeur and accessibility.

Inside, the arena's design emphasized fan experience and sightlines,

Chicago Stadium, which had served as the home for the Bulls and Blackhawks for decades. Known for its raucous energy and tightly packed seating, the Chicago Stadium was an intimidating arena for visiting teams. But by the early 1990s, it was clear that the building was well past its prime.

Architects from the Kansas City-based firm HOK Sport were hired to design the United Center with one thing in mind: honor the intensity of the

ensuring every seat had a clear view of the action. The bowl was structured to capture the crowd's energy, channeling the cheers from the crowd to echo the infamous intensity of the Chicago Stadium. Meanwhile, the new arena's concourses were wider, bathrooms were more plentiful, and concession stands more accessible, reflecting the changing standards in sports venue architecture and fan expectations. The designers also focused on creating luxury seating areas, with nearly 200



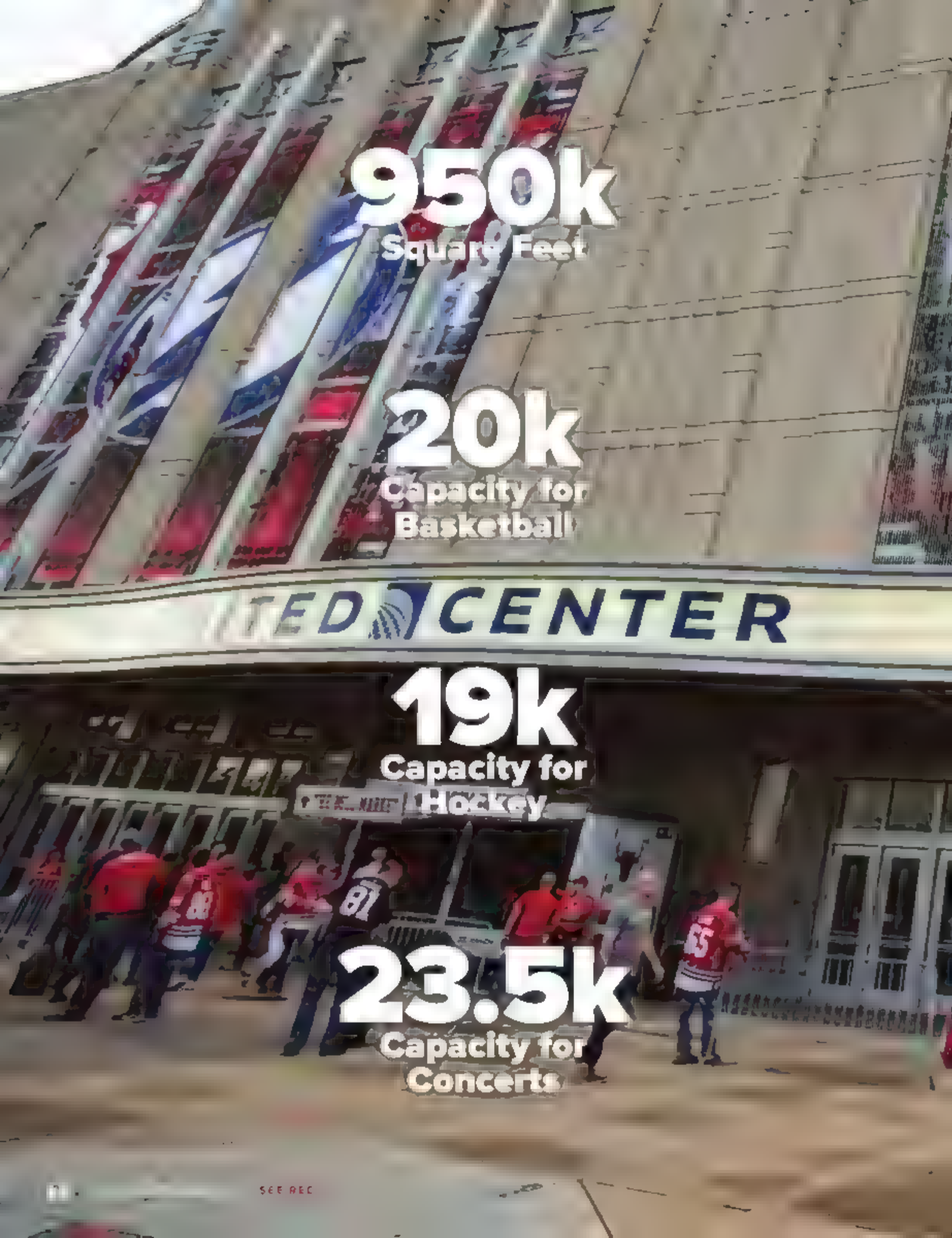
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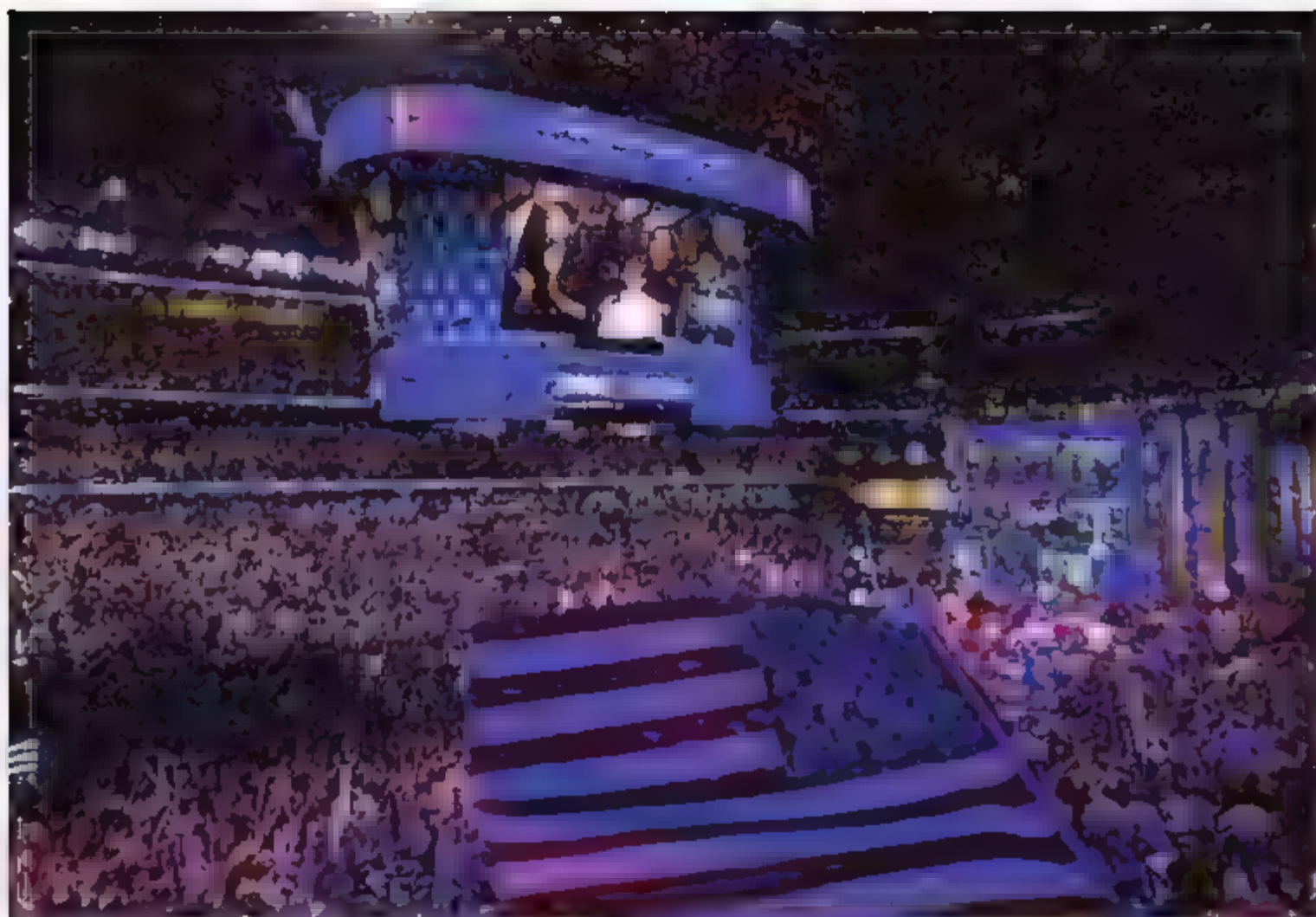

Jerry Reinsdorf, the chairman of the Bulls, and William Wirtz, the owner of the Blackhawks, were pivotal in bringing the United Center to life. The two shared a goal of creating a world-class facility that would not only serve their teams but represent Chicago sports culture's pride and resilience.

Reinsdorf and Wirtz also foresaw the economic potential a new arena could bring to their teams and the surrounding community. However, their ambitious plans came with significant financial risk—at an estimated cost of \$175 million, the United Center was entirely privately funded, a rarity at the time for such a large-scale project.

The arena's construction also marked the beginning of a new era in venue management, with Reinsdorf and Wirtz establishing the United Center Joint Venture (UCJV) to oversee the operations and revenue distribution. The UCJV allowed for streamlined decision-making and revenue sharing, ensuring that both franchises would benefit equally from the arena's success. This partnership model would later inspire other multi-team venues nationwide, setting a precedent for how ownership structures could impact team and venue operations.

Early Reactions

When the United Center opened its doors for a ribbon-cutting ceremony on August 18, 1994, it was a moment of transition for Chicago sports fans. The United Center's first official event came on August 29, 1994, when the World Wrestling Federation hosted its 7th

Annual SummerSlam '94 pay-for-view extravaganza. Shortly after, the Bulls and Blackhawks took to the court and ice, respectively, beginning the venue's dual role as both a basketball and hockey powerhouse.

The inaugural Bulls game on November 4, 1994, saw Chicago take on the Charlotte Hornets. Although the Bulls were without Michael Jordan, who had retired a year prior, fans were eager to experience the new arena. Many expressed nostalgia for the old Stadium, but the improved seating, sight lines, and enhanced amenities quickly won them over. In its first season, the United Center drew nearly 1 million attendees for Bulls games alone—a testament to the city's enduring love for its team.

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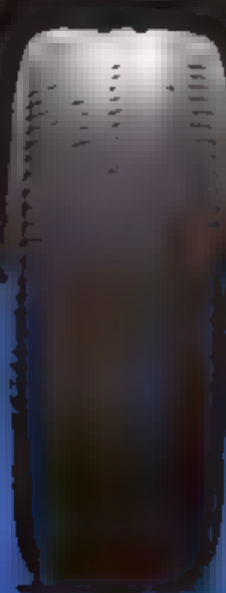
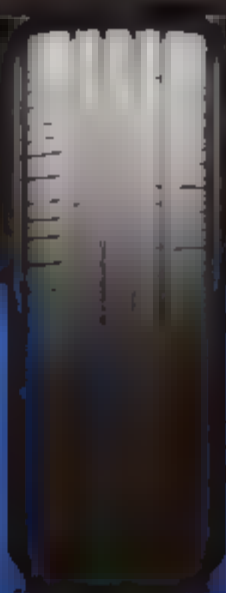
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Known for its loud, frigid atmosphere, the Chicago Stadium's unique character would be difficult to replicate. But on January 25, 1995, when the Blackhawks took on the Edmonton Oilers in their inaugural game at the United Center (the National Hockey League endured a labor dispute before the start of the 1994-95 season. Thus, the season did not start until January 20, 1995), the raw excitement was palpable. When the Hawks took to the ice for the first time, the sellout crowd let out a deafening roar that grew louder throughout the night as the Blackhawks went on to win, 5-1, signaling Chicago's hockey culture remained as strong as ever.

The United Center's early years also saw many more iconic moments. In 1995, just a year after it opened, Michael Jordan returned to the Bulls, sending shockwaves throughout the sports world. Jordan's arrival electrified the United Center, which soon

became the backdrop for some of basketball's most famous moments, including the Bulls capturing three consecutive NBA Championships (1996-1998).

Key Moments in Bulls History at the United Center

The Bulls' history at the United Center began with a season marked by transition. In the inaugural season of 1994-95, Michael Jordan was retired, and the team was in a rebuilding phase. But on March 18, 1995, Jordan shocked the world with his return to the NBA, famously sending out a press release that simply stated, "I'm back."

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Bulls Guard Ayo Dosunmu Always Rises to the Challenge

Whenever Ayo Dosunmu steps onto the court at the United Center, he is warmly welcomed by the cheers of Bulls fans who see a promising young player and a local kid living out his dream. Selected by Chicago in the second round (38th overall pick) of the 2021 NBA Draft, Dosunmu's ascent from an unheralded rookie to a crucial member of the Bulls' rotation has been inspiring. Known primarily for defensive tenacity, versatility, and a relentless work ethic, Dosunmu has earned his place in the lineup and in the hearts of Bulls fans everywhere.

Early Life and Motivation

Born on a cold, windy day in Chicago on January 17, 2000, Quamdeen Ayo-po Dosunmu grew up a Bulls fan. The youngest child of Quam and Jamarra Dosunmu, Ayo — which means “joy” in the West African language Yoruba — became a star player at Morgan

Park High School on the Southside of Chicago. He later attended the University of Illinois, quickly earning a reputation as an intense hardwood warrior. As a junior, Dosunmu averaged 20.1 points, 5.3 assists, and 6.3 rebounds, stuffing his trophy case full of hardware — including a consensus first-team All-American honor as well as the Bob Cousy award, which is bestowed annually to college basketball's best point guard. The Illini were 24-7 that season and captured the Big Ten Tournament title, earning a No. 1 seed at the NCAA Men's National Championship Tournament. Unfortunately for Illini fans, Loyola-Chicago sent Illinois home early in the second round and Dosunmu fell off the NBA radar. Yet, he never lost faith, especially after the Bulls grabbed him in the second round, knowing Dosunmu would enter the NBA with something to prove. “Growing up here, I always wanted to represent Chicago and the Bulls someday,” Dosunmu recalls. “Not getting

picked early in the Draft didn't matter. It just made me work harder.”

First Impressions

Ask Bulls head coach Billy Donovan about Dosunmu, and you will need to pull up a chair because Donovan can't help but heap endless praise on his young player.

“When Ayo first got here, he stood out because of his attitude,” Donovan says.

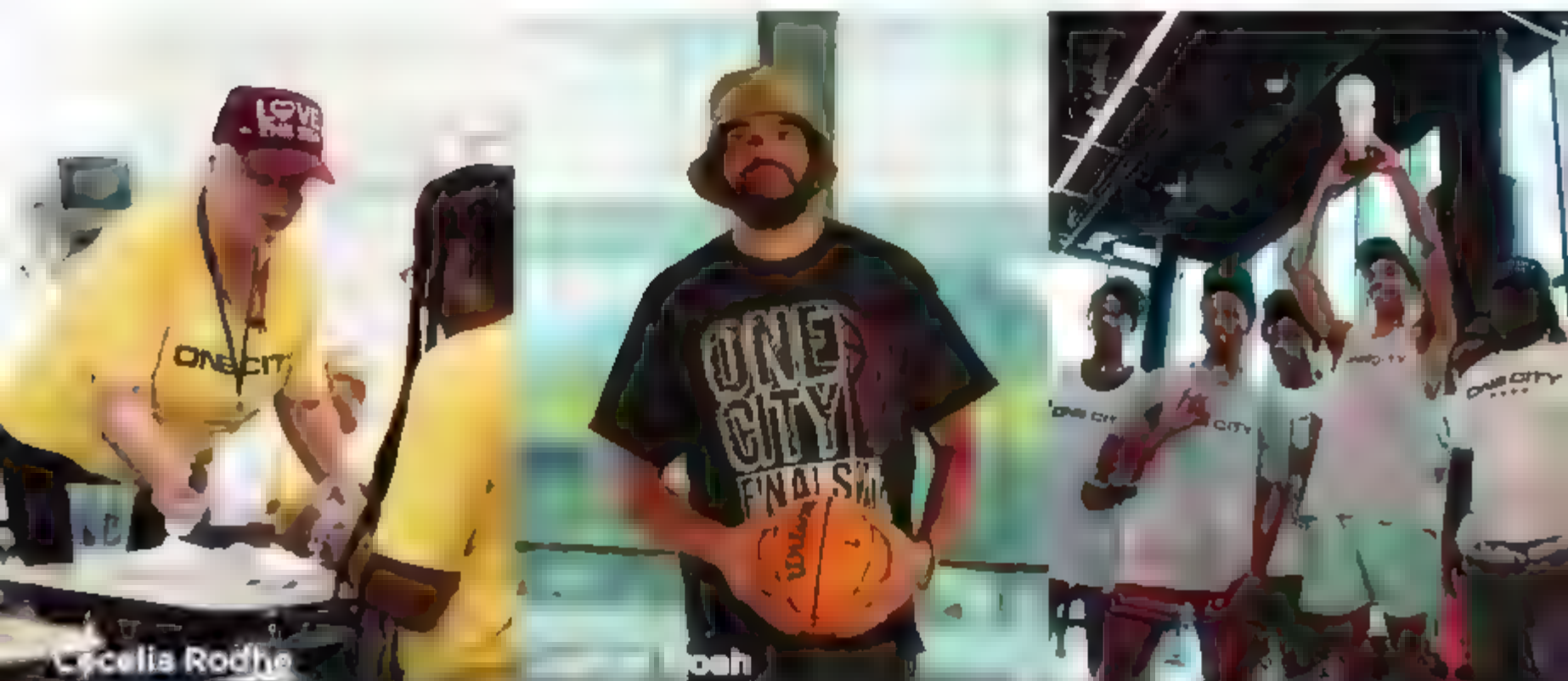
He came in with no sense of entitlement, just pure grit. His willingness to listen, learn, and adapt made a big impression.

Donovan, who has always valued defense and versatility, saw Dosunmu's potential as a multi-dimensional player from the start.

“We saw his natural athleticism, but his basketball IQ really set Ayo apart. He picked up our system fast, which you don't see much with rookies.”

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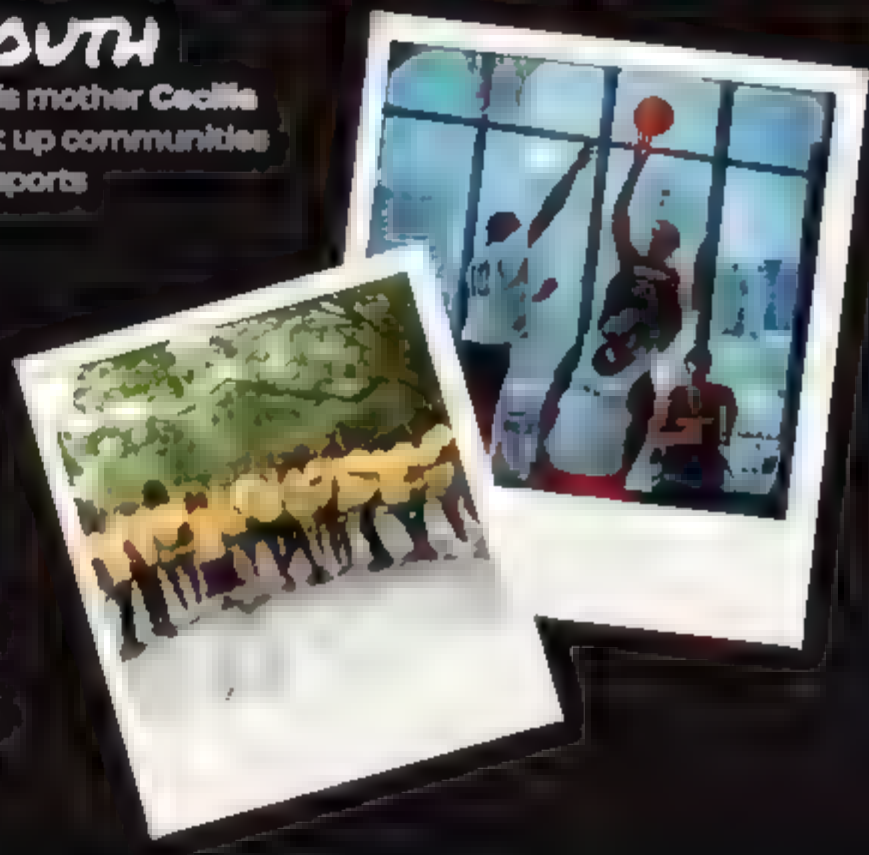

For whatever reason, Ayo doesn't get emotionally upset. I think it's a huge positive quality for him. He handles adversity extremely well," Donovan says.

Ayo leans into adversity and sees it as a challenge, not a threat. He gets more focused and energized. I really admire that."

Stepping into the Defensive Role

Since his arrival, Chicago's defensive schemes have relied heavily on Dosunmu, especially after changes in the lineup following trades and injuries. Known for his ability to effectively guard multiple positions, Dosunmu often takes on the assignment of defending an opponent's top scorer, a role he has embraced wholeheartedly.

"Defense is a mindset," Dosunmu explains. "I've always believed that if I can shut down my man, I'm helping my team. I want to be that kind of player — someone my team can always rely on."

Teammate and fellow guard Coby White has seen Dosunmu's growth firsthand.

"Ayo is relentless on defense," White says. "It's tough because we're both guards, so we push each other every day in practice. Having someone like that makes the whole team better."

White adds that Dosunmu's energy and work ethic also set a standard.

"Ayo's constantly studying opponents, and he's always the first to hit the gym. That level of preparation inspires everyone."

Developing the Offensive Side

Beyond his defensive ability, Dosunmu has also made significant strides on offense. Early in his career, he became known for driving hard into the paint

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and finishing around the rim. Still, his knack for hitting clutch shots from the perimeter, especially from beyond the arc, has improved dramatically over time. Working closely with Chicago's shooting coach, Peter Patton, Dosunmu has increased his three-point shooting percentage from around 31% to over 40% last season. Patton attributes this progress to Dosunmu's willingness to adjust his mechanics and maintain a disciplined regimen.

Ayo's approach to improvement is remarkable," Patton says. "He doesn't just put in the reps, he listens, asks questions, and is committed to getting better every day."

Dosunmu's ever-evolving shooting ability has added another layer to his game, making him a more versatile offensive threat. "It's opened up my game in ways I hadn't expected"

Dosunmu reflects. "Now, defenders must respect my outside shot, which lets me create more plays and keep the defense on its toes."

However, becoming a legitimate threat behind the arc goes beyond taking more 3-pointers. Dosunmu also understands he needs to continue to attack defenders more aggressively — not constantly firing up a shot every time a defender runs out to him, yet still making an opponent pay for giving him space on the perimeter.

"It's very vital in today's game," Dosunmu claims. "Many defenders fear my speed, so they tend to lay back and not get too close to me. When that happens, it's on me to teach them that's a bad decision by becoming a real scoring threat from the perimeter. Becoming a better shooter makes me more dynamic. As a player, that's what you

work for in this league. You want to be as dynamic as possible so defenders can't take anything away from you."

Earning Respect

Opposing teams and players have also taken notice of Dosunmu's tenacity and skill set. Doc Rivers, the head coach of the Milwaukee Bucks, recently said of Dosunmu, "Ayo's the type of player who doesn't make it easy for you. If he's guarding you, you know you're in for a tough fight. And if you fail to guard him, he'll make you pay."

This reputation has earned Dosunmu a growing respect around the league, particularly as he continues to take on assignments guarding high-profile scorers.

Challenges and Resilience

Despite his impressive trajectory, Dosunmu has faced challenges, from

THE PROBLEM

There is no cure for Huntington's Disease. Currently, there is a 50/50 chance a child could inherit the disease if a parent has HD in their family line.

There is a way to stop the gene from being passed on, through in vitro fertilization, or IVF. A procedure that implants embryos that do not have the HD gene can cost upwards of \$25,000 - \$30,000. This treatment is the only way parents who are at risk can guarantee their biological child will be HD-free.

OUR GOALS

Provide the finances for families who are at risk and in financial need and are willing to undergo IVF in order to stop the HD gene from being passed down their family line.

Our broader goal is to continue developing partnerships with fertility clinics across the country and raising funds to help cover these costs for many more families.

HelpCureHD has already awarded 55 families through its grant program, which means Huntington's Disease will be eradicated from dozens of family lines. FOREVER HDHD has welcomed dozens of healthy babies already born and many are the way.

Becoming a Leader

With roster changes bringing in new faces and veterans, Dosunmu's role has evolved into leadership, even as a younger player. While he doesn't always lead vocally, his actions have set a powerful example. "I'm not the loudest guy on the court, but I try to lead by showing up, working hard, and putting the team first," Dosunmu says.

Chicago means a lot to me, and being a Bull means everything. I want to represent this city the right way.

Coby White notes that Dosunmu's

dedication has positively impacted the team's younger players: "Ayo shows that no matter where you come from or what your draft position is, you can make a big impact if you put in the work."

The two have built a rapport on and off the court, and their combined efforts are shaping the Bulls' future.

The Fans' Connection

Fans have embraced Dosunmu as one of their own, and he draws energy from the support he receives. "Chicago fans are passionate, they expect you to give it everything," Dosunmu says with a smile. "That's what I love about this city. They push me to be better and it's a privilege to play for them."

Billy Donovan also acknowledges that Dosunmu's connection to the fans makes him a unique player for the Bulls. "When you've got a hometown kid giving everything for his city, it

brings something special to the team and the crowd," Donovan explains.

Ayo's become someone our fans can rally behind, and that energy boosts everyone."

WHAT'S NEXT

Dosunmu sees himself as a key part of the Bulls' long-term vision. His goals include becoming a more consistent playmaker and improving his defensive skills. "I want to keep building my game and add more tools each season," Dosunmu says. "I've learned so much from the veterans and coaches here and am excited about the future."

With a solid contract in place and the organization's backing, Dosunmu has positioned himself as a cornerstone player for a team in transition. As the Bulls look to balance developing younger players with adding more talent in the Draft, free agency, and trades, Dosunmu's presence offers stability and potential. ■

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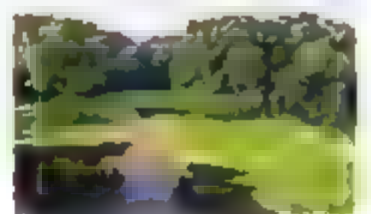
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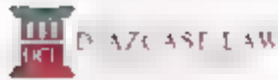

BOTOX® (onabotulinumtoxinA) is a prescription medicine that is injected into muscles and used to prevent headaches in adults with chronic migraine who have 15 or more days each month with headache lasting 4 or more hours each day in people 18 years and older.

It is not known whether BOTOX is safe and effective to prevent headaches in patients with migraine who have 14 or fewer headache days each month (episodic migraine).

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

BOTOX may cause serious side effects that can be life threatening. Get medical help right away if you have any of these problems any time (hours to weeks) after injection of BOTOX.

- **Problems swallowing, speaking, or breathing.** due to weakening of associated muscles, can be severe and result in loss of life. You are at the highest risk if these problems are preexisting before injection. Swallowing problems may last for several months.
- **Spread of toxin effects.** The effect of botulinum toxin may affect areas away from the injection site and cause serious symptoms including loss of strength and a flaccid muscle weakness, double vision,

blurred vision, drooping eyelids, hoarseness or change or loss of voice, trouble saying words clearly, loss of bladder control, trouble breathing, and trouble swallowing.

There has not been a confirmed serious case of spread of toxin effect away from the injection site when BOTOX has been used at the recommended dose to treat chronic migraine.

BOTOX may cause loss of strength or general muscle weakness, vision problems, or dizziness within hours to weeks of receiving BOTOX. If this happens, do not drive a car, operate machinery, or do other dangerous activities.

Do not receive BOTOX if you are allergic to any of the ingredients in BOTOX (see Medication Guide for ingredients) had an allergic reaction to any other botulinum toxin product such as Myobloc®, rimabotulinumtoxinB, Dysport®, abobotulinumtoxinA, or Xeomin®, or if you have a skin infection at the planned injection site.

The dose of BOTOX is not the same as, or comparable to, another botulinum toxin product.

What is the most important information I should know about BOTOX?

BOTOX may cause serious side effects that can be life threatening, including:

- Problems breathing or swallowing
- Spread of toxin effects

These problems can happen hours, days, to weeks after an injection of BOTOX. Call your doctor or get medical help right away if you have any of these problems after treatment with BOTOX:

- Problems swallowing, speaking, or breathing.

These problems can happen hours, days, to weeks after an injection of BOTOX usually because the muscles that you use to breathe and swallow can become weak after the injection. Death can happen as a complication if you have severe problems with swallowing or breathing after treatment with BOTOX.

People with certain breathing problems may need to use muscles in their neck to help them breathe. These people may be at greater risk for serious breathing problems with BOTOX.

Swallowing problems may last for several months. People who cannot swallow well may need a feeding tube to receive food and water. If swallowing problems are severe, food or liquids may go into your lungs. People who already have swallowing or breathing problems before receiving BOTOX have the highest risk of getting these problems.

- Spread of toxin effects. In some cases, the effect of botulinum toxin may affect areas of the body away from the injection site and cause symptoms of a serious condition called botulism. The symptoms of botulism include:

- loss of strength and muscle weakness all over the body
- double vision, blurred vision and drooping eyelids
- hoarseness or change or loss of voice (dysphonia)
- trouble saying words clearly (dysarthria)
- loss of bladder control
- trouble breathing
- trouble swallowing

These symptoms can happen hours, days, to weeks after you receive an injection of BOTOX.

These problems could make it unsafe for you to drive a car or do other dangerous activities. See "What should I avoid while receiving BOTOX?"

There has not been a confirmed serious case of spread of toxin effect away from the injection site when BOTOX has been used at the recommended dose to treat chronic migraine, severe underarm sweating, blepharospasm, or strabismus.

What is BOTOX?

BOTOX is a prescription medicine that is injected ~~intramuscularly, intradetrusorly, or intradermally~~.

- to treat overactive bladder symptoms such as a strong need to urinate with leaking or wetting accidents (urge urinary incontinence); a strong need to urinate right away (urgency); and urinating often (frequency) in adults when another type of medicine (anticholinergic) does not work well enough or cannot be taken
- to treat leakage of urine (incontinence) in adults with overactive bladder due to neurologic disease when another type of medicine (anticholinergic) does not work well enough or cannot be taken

BOTOX is also injected into the skin to treat the symptoms of severe underarm sweating (severe primary axillary hyperhidrosis) when medicines used on the skin (topical) do not work well enough.

It is not known whether BOTOX is safe and effective in people younger than:

- 18 years of age for treatment of overactive bladder with urinary incontinence
- 5 years of age for the treatment of overactive bladder due to a neurologic disease
- 18 years of age for treatment of chronic migraine
- 18 years of age for treatment of cervical dystonia
- 18 years of age for treatment of hyperhidrosis
- 12 years of age for treatment of strabismus or blepharospasm
- 2 years of age for treatment of spasticity

Who should not receive BOTOX?

Do not receive BOTOX if you:

- are allergic to any of the ingredients in BOTOX. See the end of this Consumer Brief Summary for a complete list of ingredients in BOTOX.
- had an allergic reaction to any other botulinum toxin product such as Myobloc® Dysport® or Xeomin®.
- have a skin infection at the planned injection site.
- are being treated for urinary incontinence and have a urinary tract infection (UTI).
- are being treated for urinary incontinence and find that you cannot empty your bladder on your own (only applies to people who are not routinely catheterizing).

What should I tell my doctor before receiving BOTOX?

Tell your doctor about all your medical conditions, including if you:

- have a disease that affects your muscles and nerves (such as amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS or Lou Gehrig's disease), myasthenia gravis or Lambert Eaton syndrome). See "What is the most important information I should know about BOTOX?"
- have allergies to any botulinum toxin product
- had any side effect from any botulinum toxin product in the past
- have or have had a breathing problem, such as asthma or emphysema
- have or have had swallowing problems
- have or have had bleeding problems
- have plans to have surgery
- had surgery on your face
- have weakness of your forehead muscles, such as trouble raising your eyebrows.

- have symptoms of a urinary tract infection (UTI) and are being treated for urinary incontinence. Symptoms of a urinary tract infection may include pain or burning with urination, frequent urination, or fever.

- are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed. It is not known if BOTOX passes into breast milk.

Tell your doctor about all the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins and herbal supplements. Using **BOTOX** with certain other medicines may cause serious side effects. **Do not start any new medicines until you have told your doctor that you have received BOTOX in the past.**

Especially tell your doctor if you:

- have received any other botulinum toxin product in the last four months
- have received injections of botulinum toxin, such as Myobloc® (mabotulinumtoxinB), Dysport® (abobotulinumtoxinA), or Xeomin® (incobotulinumtoxinA) in the past. Be sure your doctor knows exactly which product was received
- have recently received an antibiotic by injection
- take muscle relaxants
- take an allergy or cold medicine
- take a sleep medicine
- take anti-platelets (aspirin-like products) or anti-coagulants (blood thinners)

Ask your doctor if you are not sure if your medicine is one that is listed above.

Know the medicines you take. Keep a list of your medicines with you to show your doctor and pharmacist each time you get a new medicine.

- bacteria, white blood cells, and blood in the urine of children being treated for urinary incontinence
- inability to empty your bladder on your own and are being treated for urinary incontinence. What should I avoid while receiving BOTOX?

BOTOX may cause loss of strength or general muscle weakness, vision problems, or dizziness within hours to weeks of taking **BOTOX**. If this happens, do not drive a car, operate machinery, or do other dangerous activities. See "What is the most important information I should know about BOTOX?"

What are the possible side effects of BOTOX?

- headache
- neck pain
- eye problems: double vision, blurred vision, decreased eyesight, drooping eyelids, swelling of your eyelids, and dry eyes
- drooping eyebrows
- urinary tract infection in both children and adults being treated for urinary incontinence

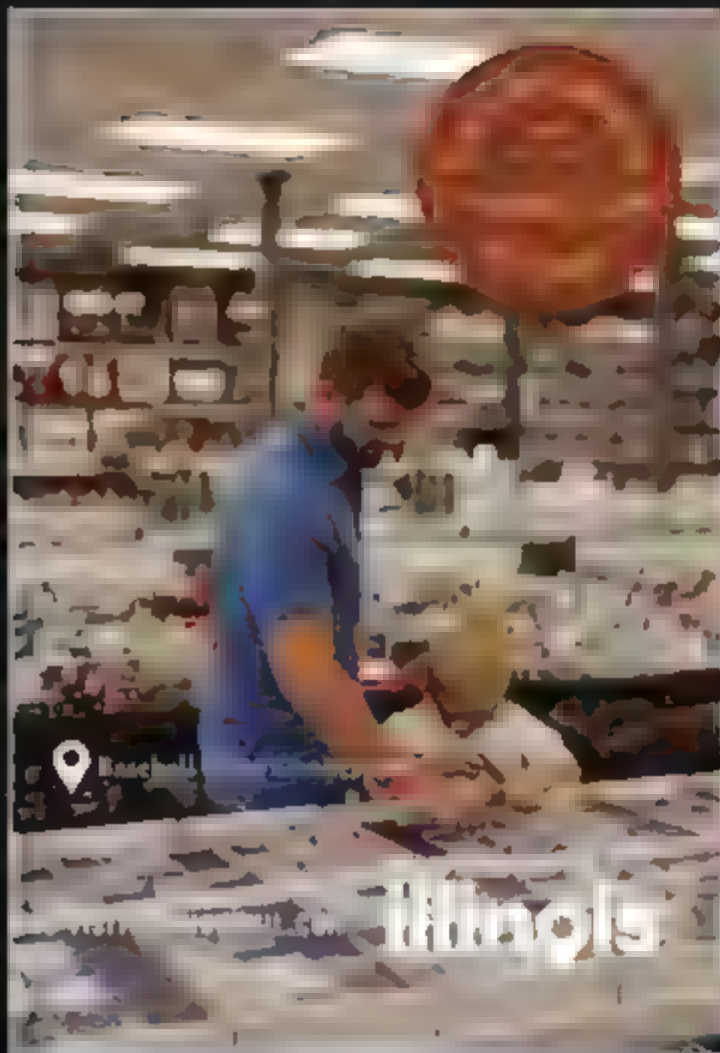
