**HelpCureHD** aims to help improve the quality of life for those affected by Huntington's Disease by contributing financial, emotional, and mental support while trying to find the cure.

### THE PROBLEM

There is no cure for Huntington's Disease. Currently, there is a 50/50 chance a child could inherit the disease if a parent has HD in their family line.

There is a way to stop the gene from being passed on, through in vitro fertilization, or IVF. A procedure that implants embryos that do not have the HD gene can cost upwards of \$25,000 - \$30,000. This treatment is the only way parents who are at risk can guarantee their biological child will be HD-free.

### OUR GOALS

Provide the finances for families who are at risk and in financial need and are willing to undergo IVF in order to stop the HD gene from being passed on in their family line.

Our broader focus is to continue developing partnerships with fertility clinics across the country and raising funds to help cover these costs for many more families.

HelpCureHD has already awarded 135 families through its grant program, which means Huntington's Disease will be eradicated from dozens of family lines FOREVER. HCND has welcomed dozens of healthy babies already born and more on the way.

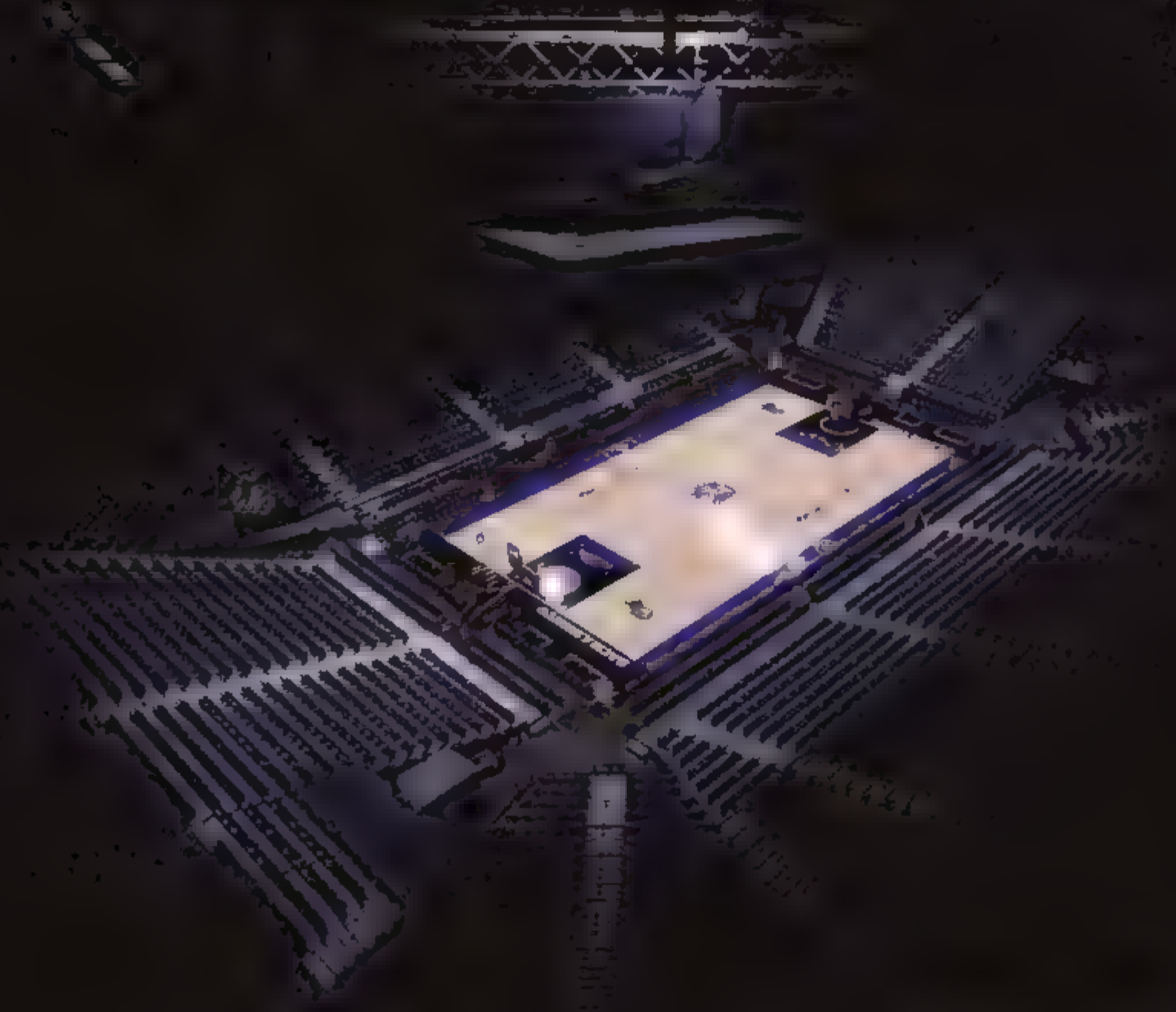

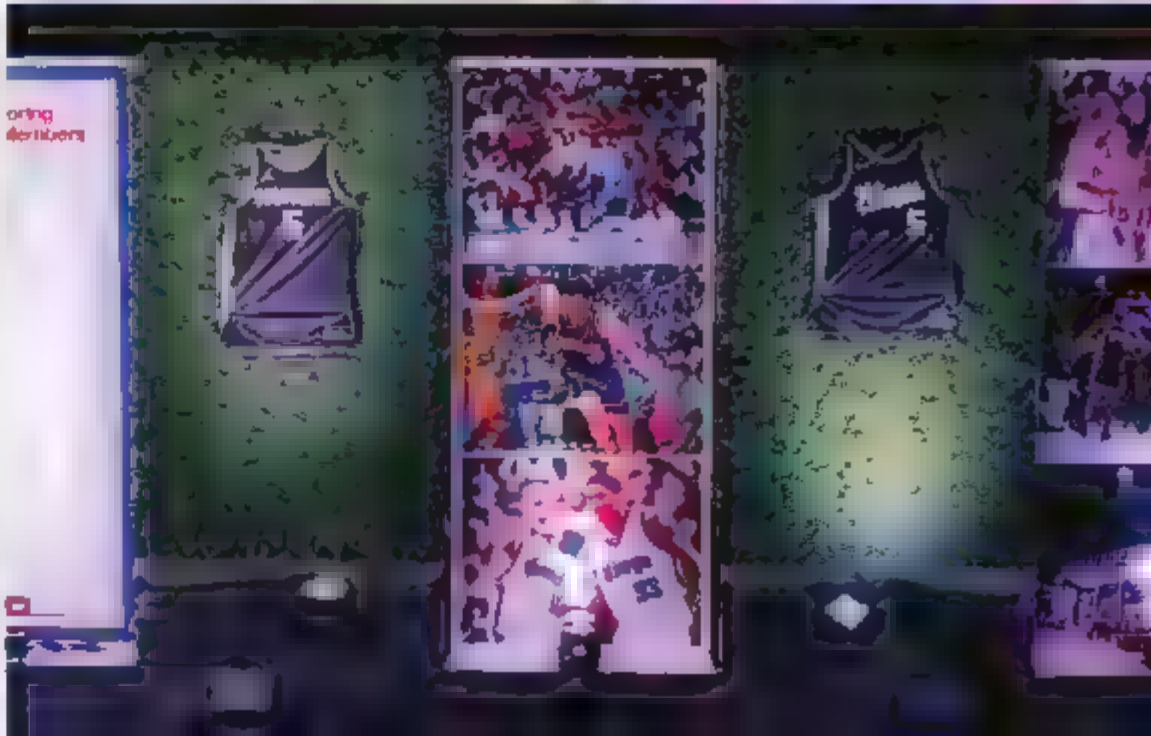
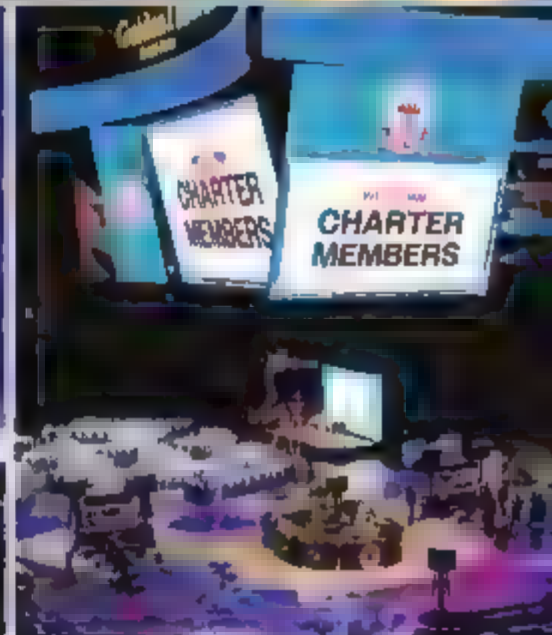
**CHARTER SEASON TICKET MEMBERS HONORED**

The Kings celebrated their 1985 Charter Season Ticket Members by hosting an exclusive dinner on the court alongside Kings Legends, to recognize the fans who have supported the team since their arrival in Sacramento. Additionally, the team immortalized these fans by incorporating their names into the design of a special classic edition court—a testament to their pivotal role in the franchise's journey.

**CELEBRATING THROUGH ART**

In collaboration with the Crocker Art Museum, the Kings unveiled a community art installation, Celebrating 40 Years in Sacramento. ## INTERIM HEAD COACH DOUG CHRISTIE



Doug Christie serves as the Sacramento Kings' interim head coach following two seasons as an assistant coach for the team. Selected 17th overall in the 1992 NBA Draft by the Seattle Super Sonics, Christie played 15 seasons in the NBA, averaging 11.2 points, 4.1 rebounds, 3.6 assists and 1.9 steals per game in 827 career games, 708 starts, with seven teams. During his time with the Kings from 2000-2005, he helped the team reach the postseason in each of his five seasons. He was named to the NBA All-Defensive First Team in 2002-03 and All-Defensive Second Team in 2000-01, 2001-02, and 2003-04. Before joining the Kings as an assistant coach, Christie spent four seasons as the team's full-time color analyst from 2017-21.

The 15-year NBA veteran attended Rainier Beach High School in Seattle, Wash., where he led the Vikings to their first state basketball championship in 1988. After graduating from

Rainier Beach, Christie headed south to Pepperdine University in Malibu, Calif., where he played three seasons for the Waves from 1989-92. Christie ranks third in career steals (168) in program history and won back-to-back WCC Player of the Year awards (1990-92).

Christie lives in Sacramento with his wife Jackie, son Douglas and new four-legged family member Ghost.

ENTER TO WIN!



Jay Triano enters his third season as an assistant coach with the Sacramento Kings, bringing over 20 years of NBA coaching experience, including 308 combined games as a head coach with Toronto and Phoenix. He helps handle Sacramento's offense, which put up the highest offensive rating in NBA history and led the NBA in scoring. Prior to joining the Kings bench, Triano spent four seasons as an assistant coach for the Charlotte Hornets (2018-22) after previously spending two seasons as the associate head coach and interim head coach of the Phoenix Suns from 2016-18.

A native of Niagara Falls, Ontario, Triano entered the NBA in 1996 working a variety of roles with the Vancouver Grizzlies. In 2002 he started his NBA coaching career as an assistant coach with the Raptors and served in that capacity until December 2008, when he was named interim head coach. The first non-American head coach born outside the U.S. in NBA history, Triano went on to serve as head coach of Toronto for the remainder of that season and two more seasons after that. From 2012-16, he was an assistant coach with the Portland Trail Blazers before moving to the Suns as associate head coach in 2016-17. He was Phoenix's interim head coach for 79 games during the 2017-18 season.

Triano has had two stints as the head coach of the Canadian National Team from 2012-2019 and 1999-2004, as he led Canada to a 5-2 record during the 2000 Olympics. In addition, he has experience as an assistant coach with USA Basketball, including at the 2010 FIBA World Championship, where he helped guide Team USA to the gold medal over Turkey.

Prior to the NBA, Triano spent six seasons (1989-95) as head coach at his alma mater Simon Fraser University, where he played at for four seasons from 1977-81. Triano also played for the Canadian National Team for 11 years from 1977-77 and was team captain from 1981-88, representing Canada as a player in two Olympic Games (1984, 1988). He is the only Canadian ever drafted in both the NBA and the Canadian Football League as he was selected in the eighth round of the 1981 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Lakers and by the Calgary Stampeders in the 1981 CFL Draft. Additionally, Triano has authored two books, including *Open Look: Canadian Basketball and Me*, a memoir chronicling his love of basketball and the rise of the sport in Canada, and in 2016 was awarded an Honorary Doctorate of Laws Degree from the University of Calgary.



Luke Loucks enters his third season with the Kings after spending the 2021-22 season with the Phoenix Suns in basketball strategy and personnel evaluation. Prior to his time in Phoenix, Loucks served in multiple roles over five seasons with the Golden State Warriors, including as a video/player development intern (2016-17), two-way development coach (2017-19) and player development coach (2019-21). While with the Warriors, Loucks specialized in on-court tutelage and instruction as he was a part of the Golden State teams that won the NBA championship in back-to-back seasons (2016-17, 2017-18).

Loucks played four seasons at Florida State where he ranks tied for fourth in program history in career games played. He was a part of four straight NCAA tournament appearances, won the ACC Championship in 2012, and was third in the ACC in assists. After his time at FSU, he went on to play professionally for four seasons in Latvia, Cyprus, Belgium, Germany and for the Maine Red Claws and Erie Bayhawks of the NBA G League, before joining the Warriors staff.



Leandro Barbosa enters his third season as an assistant coach with Sacramento following two seasons with Golden State (2020-22), winning the 2022 NBA title with the Warriors. In his time with Golden State, Barbosa served as a player development coach during the 2021-22 campaign following a season as a player mentor coach in 2020-21.

Originally selected by the San Antonio Spurs with the 28th overall selection in the 2003 NBA Draft, Barbosa's NBA career spanned 14 seasons. In 850 career games, he averaged 10.6 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game with the Phoenix Suns, Toronto Raptors, Indiana Pacers, Boston Celtics and the Warriors. Barbosa is ninth in career games played (553) in Suns franchise

history and earned NBA Sixth Man of the Year honors with Phoenix during the 2006-07 season after he posted career-highs of 18.1 points and 4.0 assists in 80 contests. He was a member of the Warriors team that won the NBA title during the 2014-15 season and the club that won an NBA-record 73 regular season games in 2015-16. A Sao Paulo, Brazil native, Barbosa spent three years playing in his home country of Brazil (2017-20). Barbosa has most recently played for the Bat. Hogs of the Big 3 League since 2021, leading the league in assists in both 2021 and 2023.

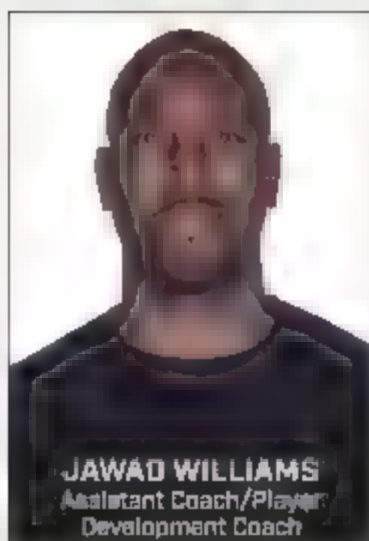
## MEET THE COACHES



Riccardo Foiss enters his first season with the Kings and his third season in the NBA. A native of Olbia, Italy, Foiss joins the Kings after spending three seasons (2021-24) as an assistant coach with the Arizona Wildcats. Prior to his time at Arizona, Foiss spent two seasons from with the Phoenix Suns from 2019-21 in a player development role following five seasons at Gonzaga as the Director of Analytics (2014-19). Foiss began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater Peppederine, for two seasons (2012-14), after his professional playing career in the Serie B Basket in Italy (2009-12).



A Syosset, N.Y. native, Jim Moran enters his first season in Sacramento after serving as the head coach of the Rip City Remix, the Portland Trail Blazers G League affiliate, during the 2023-24 season. Previously, he served as an assistant coach for the Detroit Pistons (2021-23) and Portland Trail Blazers (2015-2021). Moran began his NBA career in player development for the G League's Maine Red Claws in 2013 and was Portland's associate video coordinator for the 2014-15 season. He played his entire professional career from 2001-11 for CB Gran Canaria in Spain's Liga ACB and became the first player in Gran Canaria history to have his jersey retired.



Jawad Williams enters his second season with the Sacramento Kings and his first season as Assistant Coach/ Director of Player Development. Prior to Sacramento Williams was as an assistant coach and Director of Player Development for the Nagasaki Velca of the Japanese B League in 2022.

Williams had a 17-year playing career, including playing parts of three seasons for the Cleveland Cavaliers from 2008-11. He played internationally in Spain, Israel, Japan, France, Turkey, Greece and Italy before his final season with the Yamagata Wyverns in 2021-22. Williams spent four seasons at the University of North Carolina, starting for the Tar Heels during his senior season as he helped lead the team to win in the 2005 NCAA National Championship.

A Cleveland, Ohio, native, Williams was named AP and Gatorade Player of the Year in Ohio in 2001 and played in the McDonald's All-American Game. He graduated from JNC with a B.A. in African-American studies.

Robbie Lemons begins his ninth season with the Kings, his third as Senior Director, Coaching Analytics and Strategy and first as an assistant coach. In his role, Lemons serves on the coaching staff and provides analytical insights and strategy. He also supports the front office during the offseason free agency and draft periods. Prior to this role, Lemons worked in the front office as a pro scout, college scout and supported basketball administration.

Before joining the Kings, Lemons graduated with honors from Stanford University in 2015 with a BA in Economics and a MA in Public Policy. He played on Stanford's basketball team from 2010-14 and was a two-time First Team Pac-12 All-Academic

selection (2013, 2014) while also receiving the Pac 12 Leadership Award in 2014. Subsequently, he completed an MSC in Banking and Finance from Newcastle University with distinction, while competing for the university's inter-collegiate and national level teams.



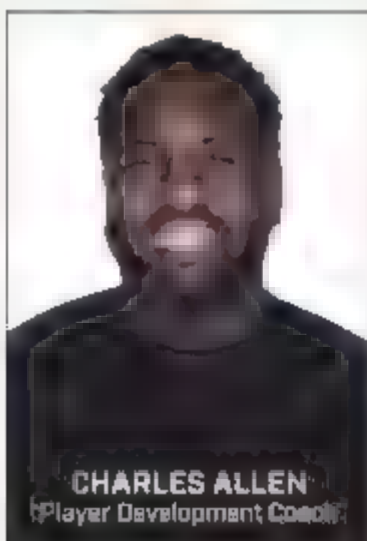
Jimmy Alapag enters his second season with the Sacramento Kings as a player development coach. Prior to his time with the Kings he spent two seasons as an assistant coach with Sacramento's G League affiliate, the Stockton Kings. He first came to Sacramento serving as an assistant coach with the Kings Summer League team in 2019.

A native of San Bernardino, Calif., Alapag played two years at his hometown college, Cal State San Bernardino before being selected 10th overall in the 2003 Philippine Basketball Association draft by the TNT Tropang Texters. He played in the PBA for 13 years, including 12 seasons for the Texters from 2003-2015 and his final season with the Meralco Bolts. Alapag finished his career as a six-time PBA Champion, including two Finals MVP awards, an 11-time All-Star and received

First Team honors three times. He was also won league MVP in 2011 and Rookie of the Year in 2003 and was selected as one of PBA's 40 Greatest Players.

Following his retirement in 2016, Alapag became an assistant coach for the Meralco Bolts in 2016-17 before joining Alab Pilipinas of the ASEAN Basketball League as the team's head coach. He was at the helm for Alab Pilipinas for three seasons from 2017-20 while serving as an assistant with San Miguel Beermen of the PBA.

Alapag played in several tournaments for the Philippines national team, including the team's first World Cup victory in 40 years over Senegal at the 2014 FIBA World Cup in Spain. He was named an assistant coach for the Philippines national team from 2015-2017 and again in 2019.



Charles Allen enters his third season with the Kings and his first as a player development coach. Prior to joining the Kings, Allen spent three seasons with the Utah Jazz as the head video coordinator from 2020-22 after working as the assistant video coordinator for the team during the 2019-20 season. During his three seasons with the Jazz, he focused on player development, advance scouting and video analysis. Allen was also an assistant video coordinator with the Houston Rockets (2018-19) and Phoenix Suns (2017-18).

Before his time in the NBA, Allen worked as an assistant video coordinator (2017) and basketball student assistant & analytics team member (2014-17) at the University of Houston after playing two seasons at Dallas Baptist University. Most recently, Allen served as an assistant coach for the 2024 Bahamas men's national team.

Vivek Ranadive is the owner and chairman of the Sacramento Kings. He is an entrepreneur, technology visionary, New York Times best-selling author and philanthropist recognized for his innovative thinking.

As a technology entrepreneur, he pioneered the use of real-time event processing software and created FISCO, a multi-billion dollar software company. In addition to digitizing Wall Street, his software became the central nervous system for most of the world's largest companies and government agencies. He is known as "Mr. Real Time," which defines his belief that by getting the right information to the right place at the right time, you can make the world a better place.

Ranadive is a longtime basketball fan, which started when he coached his daughter's middle school team. His coaching success was highlighted in a New Yorker magazine article by Malcolm Gladwell as an example of innovators who win big by doing the unexpected and breaking the rules.

He started his foray into professional basketball when he became the vice-chairman of the Golden State Warriors NBA franchise in 2010.

In 2013, he became the first Indian Governor of an NBA team when he purchased the Sacramento Kings, securing the team's future in California's capital city. Under Ranadive's leadership, the Kings have invested \$1 billion in the downtown area, creating thousands of jobs, revitalizing the region and building the next great American city.

At the heart of his investments is the award-winning Golden 1 Center, the home of the Sacramento Kings. This 21st-century coliseum is the greenest and most technologically advanced arena in the world. Golden 1 Center is 100 percent solar powered and is the first sports venue in the world to earn LEED Platinum certification, making it a model for innovative solutions to environmental challenges.

Ranadive is the founder and managing general partner of venture capital firm Bow Capital, a partnership with the University of California with a mission to fund technology companies that advance society and make the world a better place.

As a young boy in his native Bombay, Ranadive listened to the moon landing on the radio and was inspired at the age of 16 to leave India for Cambridge, Massachusetts. 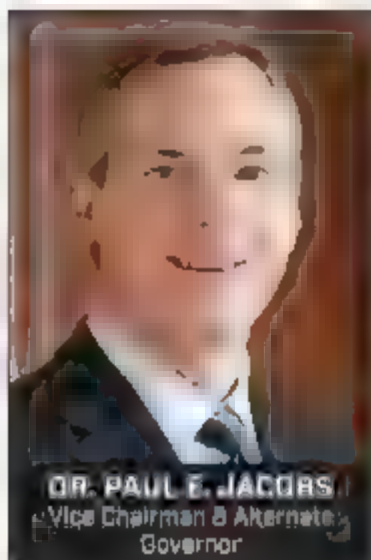

Dr. Paul E. Jacobs is Vice Chairman and Alternate Governor of the Sacramento Kings. Paul Jacobs serves as Chief Executive Officer of GlobaStar. Prior to joining GlobaStar, Jacobs founded XCOM Labs (renamed ViewTX) where he serves as Chairman and CEO.

As former chief executive officer and executive chairman of Qualcomm Incorporated, Dr. Jacobs spearheaded its efforts to develop and commercialize fundamental mobile technology breakthroughs that fueled the wireless, internet and smartphone revolutions. During his tenure as CEO, Qualcomm's revenues quadrupled and its market capitalization doubled. Dr. Jacobs is a prolific inventor with over 80 U.S. patents granted or pending in the field of wireless technology and devices.

He served as a director of Qualcomm Incorporated from June 2005 to March 2018, including as chairman of the board of directors from March 2009 to March 2018 and as executive chairman from March 2014 to March 2018.

He served as chief executive officer from July 2005 to March 2014 and as group president of Qualcomm Wireless & Internet from July 2001 to July 2005. In addition, he served as an executive vice president of Qualcomm Incorporated from February 2000 to June 2005.

Dr. Jacobs is a director of ARM Holdings, Dropbox, Inc. and FIRST. He attended the University of California, Berkeley where he earned a BS in electrical engineering and computer science, MS in electrical engineering, and PhD in electrical engineering and computer science. He founded Berkeley's Jacobs Institute for Design Innovation and was the university's 2017 Alumnus of the Year. Dr. Jacobs is a member of the National Academy of Engineering and a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.



Raj Bhathal is Co-owner of Sacramento Kings Basketball Holdings, which owns the Sacramento Kings franchise of the National Basketball Association (NBA), Golden Center, the Sawyer Hotel and the Downtown Commons entertainment and sports district. He currently serves as Vice Chairman and Alternate Governor of the Sacramento Kings.

Mr. Bhathal has had a lifelong passion for sports, which began with soccer and field hockey as a child in India and evolved towards American sports after coming to the United States for university studies. In 1990, he was awarded the first franchise of the World League of American Football, an international league formed by the NFL (later re-named NFL Europe), the Orlando Thunder. As an American originally from India, Bhathal was the only major NFL owner who was a minority at that time. Mr. Bhathal is the founder of RAJ SWIM, a firm that grew to become the industry's leading house of fashion and celebrates its 57th anniversary in 2024. RAJ designs, markets and manufactures swimwear under a variety of owned, private label and licensed fashion brands. The company has global operations and is headquartered in Orange County, California. Bhathal owned and operated the business with his wife, Marta, from its founding in 1967 until their retirement in 2006. Additionally, Mr. Bhathal has been an active property developer since the 1970s with commercial and residential properties in the western United States.

Raj serves as a Director of Raj Capital Management. He serves as a member on the Executive Board for the NWSL's Portland Thorns FC and WNBA Portland.

The Bhathal family members are strong believers in giving back to the community, especially in the areas of education and the arts. Mr. Bhathal is a Trustee at Chapman University and past Chairman of its Athletic Committee. He is on the Advisory Board of the Orange County High School of the Arts. Previously, he served on the Board of Gerontology at the University of Southern California, served as a member of University California Irvine Foundation and Executive Round Table. Mr. Bhathal was a founding member of the Orange County Performing Arts Center.

Bhathal emigrated from India to the United States in 1962 for university studies, earning his MBA from the University of Arizona.

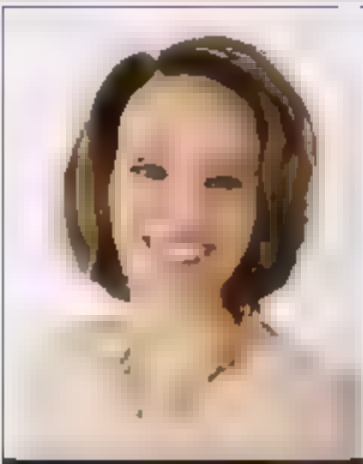

Chief Operating Officer

Entering her 28th season with the NBA, Matina Kolokotronis serves as the Chief Operating Officer (COO) of the Sacramento Kings. Bringing decades of experience in sports and government law, community affairs and contract negotiations, Kolokotronis' leadership has been integral to the development of the award-winning Golden 1 Center as well as its adjacent \$500 million mixed-use development project Downtown Commons. Golden 1 Center is recognized as the greenest and most technologically advanced arena in the world and is the first professional sports venue in the world to achieve LEED Platinum certification. Together, Golden 1 Center and Downtown Commons represent a \$1 billion investment in downtown Sacramento – a great source of pride for the community and driver of significant economic growth in the region.

Prior to her appointment as COO, Kolokotronis was the President of Business Operations. Kolokotronis is the only female in the NBA to hold both COO and President of Business Operations titles. Before being named President of Business Operations, Kolokotronis served as legal consultant for the Kings business and basketball operations teams, negotiating player and staff contracts. During that time, Kolokotronis was an Adjunct Professor of Law at McGeorge Law School, University of the Pacific, where she taught Sports Law.

Prior to that, she served for six years as director of the Sacramento Kings Foundation, overseeing strategic development and fundraising activities. Before joining the Kings, Kolokotronis was an associate with Miller Owen and Trost and practiced contract and sports law where her clients included the Kings and various NBA players.

Kolokotronis' leadership extends beyond the Kings organization and into the community, where she is an advocate for numerous women's advancement groups and non-profits. She is a mentor at She Shares, a Sacramento-based organization dedicated to supporting young female professionals working and creating careers in California. She also serves on the California State Protocol Foundation board as appointed by Governor Gavin Newsom and is the past board chair of the Greater Sacramento Economic Council.

Kolokotronis is a graduate of Loyola University Chicago and received her law degree from McGeorge Law School, University of the Pacific. She and her husband, Sotiris, are long-time Sacramento residents and their three children – Constantine, Marisa and Nicholas – proudly wear purple.



**JOHN RINEHART**  
President, Business Operations

John Rinehart enters his 25th season with the Sacramento Kings and eighth as the President of Business Operations.

In his role as President, Business Operations, Rinehart oversees the day-to-day operations of the NBA's Team of the Year, including the state-of-the-art, award-winning Golden 1 Center as it enters its ninth season. In addition, Rinehart oversees the organization's real estate business holdings which includes the Kimpton Sawyer Hotel and the Downtown Commons shopping and entertainment district, as well as its entertainment portfolio and revenue development strategy.

Through a \$1 billion strategic investment to build Golden 1 Center and Downtown Commons (DCCO) the Kings have profoundly impacted the region's economy, reenergized downtown and created a culture and lifestyle district that has placed Sacramento in the national spotlight.

In September 2022, Rinehart negotiated and led the Companies purchase of the Sacramento River Cats and Sutter Health Park. As the Triple A Minor League Affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, the River Cats provide fans the opportunity to watch the next generation of Major League Baseball players while enjoying fun, family-friendly entertainment.

Prior to becoming President, Business Operations, he served as Executive Vice President, Business Operations and Chief Financial Officer where his duties included contract negotiation, player contract compliance and analysis (NBA Tax and Escrow system), financial analysis, financial reporting, budgeting, financing administration, arena programming and services, legal affairs, insurance and tax requirements.

In his time with the Kings, Rinehart has negotiated several key agreements, including the structure of the public/private partnership with the City of Sacramento, debt financing, cable over-the-air and radio broadcast contracts, ticketing agreements, food and beverage and merchandise agreements and building naming rights. This past year, Rinehart completed the negotiations that will bring MLB's Athletics to Sacramento to play the next three seasons at the organization's Sutter Health Park.

Prior to joining the Kings, Rinehart spent two years as the Director of Finance for Anaheim Sports Inc. where he oversaw the finance and accounting functions of the Anaheim Angels (MLB), Anaheim Mighty Ducks (NHL) and Edison International Field of Anaheim. He also spent two seasons as manager of financial reporting for the San Francisco Giants (MLB). Prior to beginning his career in professional sports, Rinehart spent five years with the public accounting firm Price Waterhouse Coopers LLP in San Francisco.

Rinehart is also an active member in the Sacramento community. He is a current board member of the Sacramento Downtown Partnership and California Chamber of Commerce and a past board member of Visit Sacramento and The Positive Coaching Alliance. In addition, he served as the Chair of The American Heart Association's Heart Ball and Honorary Chair of The American Cancer Society's annual Golf Tournament.

Rinehart graduated with a bachelor's degree in accounting from Vidalia University in 1991. He and his family reside in the Land Park neighborhood of downtown Sacramento.



Monte McNair enters his fifth season with the Kings as General Manager, joining the team on September 17, 2020. As the team's top basketball executive, McNair heads basketball operations for the Kings. In his fourth season, McNair made key additions: Selecting Devin Carter (1st round, 13th pick) in the 2024 NBA Draft; re-signing Malik Monk (Career highs in PPG, AST and 3rd NBA in total points among reserves), acquiring DeMar DeRozan via a 3-Team Trade, and signing Jordan McLaughlin.

The acquisition of DeRozan marked a significant addition to the Kings' roster: DeRozan is a 15-year veteran, six-time All-Star (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2022, 2023), three-time All-NBA honoree (2016-17, 2017-18, 2021-22), FIBA World Cup gold medalist (2014), Olympic gold medalist (2016) and Magic Johnson Award winner (2017-18). Ranks sixth among active players in career points (23,582) and 31st on the all-time NBA scoring list.

The Kings ended the 2023-24 season with an above .500 record for the second consecutive season for the first time in 17 years. Domantas Sabonis became the fifth player in NBA history with 25+ triple-doubles in a season and surpassed Kevin Love for the longest double-double streak since the ABA-NBA merger (1976-77) while earning a 3rd Team All-NBA Selection. De'Aaron Fox eclipsed Sam Lacey (9,895) and DeMarcus Cousins (9,894) for the fifth most points in franchise history while leading the league in steals with 150.

A native of Oak Park, California, McNair returned to his home state from the Houston Rockets, where he previously held the title of Assistant General Manager since 2018. Prior to that, McNair led the analytic efforts of the Rockets' basketball operations department where he worked closely with Houston's coaching staff to provide on-court strategy and analysis along with opponent preparation.

During his time in Houston, the organization reached the NBA Playoffs over the course of eight consecutive seasons, including two trips to the Western Conference Finals, while amassing seven seasons with 50+ wins. Over his 13 years with the Rockets, McNair was involved with all aspects of player evaluation, including trade, free agency and the Draft. He began his career in Houston as a Basketball Operations Senior Analyst in 2007, was promoted to Director of Basketball Operations in 2013 and became Vice President of Basketball Operations in 2016.

Before joining the Rockets, McNair worked as a sports programmer and researcher at STATS LLC. McNair played football at Princeton University, where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in computer science. McNair signed a long-term extension with Sacramento on Jan. 24, 2023, and was named the 2022-23 NBA Basketball Executive of the Year.



Wes Wilcox enters his fifth season with the Kings as Assistant General Manager. Wilcox supports General Manager Monte McNair in all facets of front office operations including roster construction, strategy and player evaluation. He comes to Sacramento with nearly 20 years of experience in the NBA, including serving as General Manager (2015-17) and Assistant General Manager (2012-15) of the Atlanta Hawks. Prior to the Hawks, Wilcox was Director of Player Personnel for the Cleveland Cavaliers and the first General Manager of the Cavs' NBA Development League team, the Canton Charge. He joined the Cavaliers in 2003 and held the roles of Advance Scout, College Scout, Pro Personnel Scout and Assistant Coach, prior to his promotion to Director of Player Personnel.

A native of La Habra, Calif., Wilcox began his career in the NBA as an intern (2001-02) with the Miami Heat in their scouting and video department, before becoming a Video Coordinator with the New Orleans Hornets in 2002-03. He recently served as an Analyst for NBA TV and SiriusXM NBA Radio. Wilcox is a 2001 graduate of Cal-State Fullerton. Wes and his wife Larisha have three children – son, Noah and twins, Ja'eah and Jonah. Larisha spent 10 years working in the NBA in public relations and basketball operations.

Alvin Gentry enters his second season as Vice President Player Engagement of the Kings, bringing more than 35 years of experience to Sacramento. He served as the Kings interim head coach last season and previously served as head coach of the New Orleans Pelicans where he guided the team to 48 wins during the 2018-19 regular season – the third most in team history – and a trip to the NBA Playoffs, advancing to the Western Conference Semifinals for only the second time in franchise history.

Prior to New Orleans, Gentry was the Associate Head Coach of the Golden State Warriors, helping lead the team to the 2015 NBA Championship. Alvin has also previously served as head coach for the Miami Heat (1995), Detroit Pistons (1997-2000), Los Angeles Clippers (2000-2003) and Phoenix Suns (2006-2013). In 1,105 games, Gentry has garnered a career record of 510-595 (.462).

With Gentry at the helm of the Suns, he guided Phoenix to the 2010 Western Conference Finals following a 44-28 regular season record – the fourth best in Phoenix franchise history – and led the NBA in scoring with 110.2 points per game, along with offensive rating (115.3) and finished fourth in pace of play (95.3), while

being the only team in the league to connect on over 40 percent of their 3-point field goal attempts (.412).

During his tenure in Detroit, Gentry led the Pistons to the 1999 NBA playoffs during his only full season as head coach of the club. In Los Angeles, Gentry improved the Clippers' record by 16 wins during his first season in 2000-01 (31-51), and added another eight wins the following season (39-43), marking the franchise's best finish in nearly a decade. During the 2013-14 season, Gentry served as the associate head coach of the Clippers, where Los Angeles led the league in both scoring (107.9 points per game) and offensive rating (112.1), while also finishing seventh in pace of play (95.9). While with the Warriors, Golden State led the league in scoring (110.0 point per game) and pace of play (98.3), while finishing second in offensive rating (117.6).

The Shelby, North Carolina native was a point guard at Appalachian State where he earned a degree in management (1977) prior to his coaching career. Gentry is the proud father of three grown children, daughter Alexis who resides in Denver, along with sons Ryan, a 2020 graduate of University of San Diego, and Jack, a 2023 graduate of the University of Southern California.



Phil Jabour begins his fifth season with the Kings and second as Vice President of Basketball Operations and Player Personnel. In this role, Jabour oversees the structure and processes of the scouting department while supporting 2022-23 NBA Executive of the Year Monte McNair, in key areas of basketball operations such as roster building, strategy, and player-agent collaboration. Jabour played an integral part in the 18-win improvement the Kings boasted between the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons, leading to the club's first Pacific Division title in 20 years.

Entering his 19th season in the NBA, Jabour has led with innovation and a process-driven approach throughout his career. Most recently, as Director of Scouting for the Philadelphia 76ers, he was instrumental in overhauling the team's player evaluation systems, improving how they analyzed players' averaged film, and gathered background information on prospects. He contributed to the team's 42-win improvement between 2015-16 and 2017-18 and helped the 76ers reach the Eastern Conference Semifinals twice during his tenure.

Before Philadelphia, Jabour served as a Scout for the Orlando Magic (2012-2014), focusing on player evaluation and information gathering. His NBA career

began in 2006 as Daryl Morey's first scouting hire with the Houston Rockets, where he worked his way up the personnel ranks after starting as an intern. He played a key role in shaping the 2007-08 Rockets roster that achieved a 22-game winning streak and served as Director of Scouting for the Rockets' minor league affiliate, the Rio Grande Valley Vipers, contributing to two NBA D-League Finals appearances and a championship in 2010.

Jabour's experience extends beyond the NBA, in a continual effort to stay ahead of the curve of personnel processes. Jabour has collaborated with numerous MLB, NFL and NHL organizations to gather ideas and best practices from other professional sports. Additionally, he contributed to the USA Basketball Men's U18 National Team's gold-medal-winning campaign in 2006 and served as a support staff member of Arizona State University's men's basketball program (2002-2006). Jabour graduated from Arizona State University's W.P. Carey School of Business as a Dean's List Honoree with a Bachelor of Science in management and earned a Master's of International Business from the University of St. Thomas.

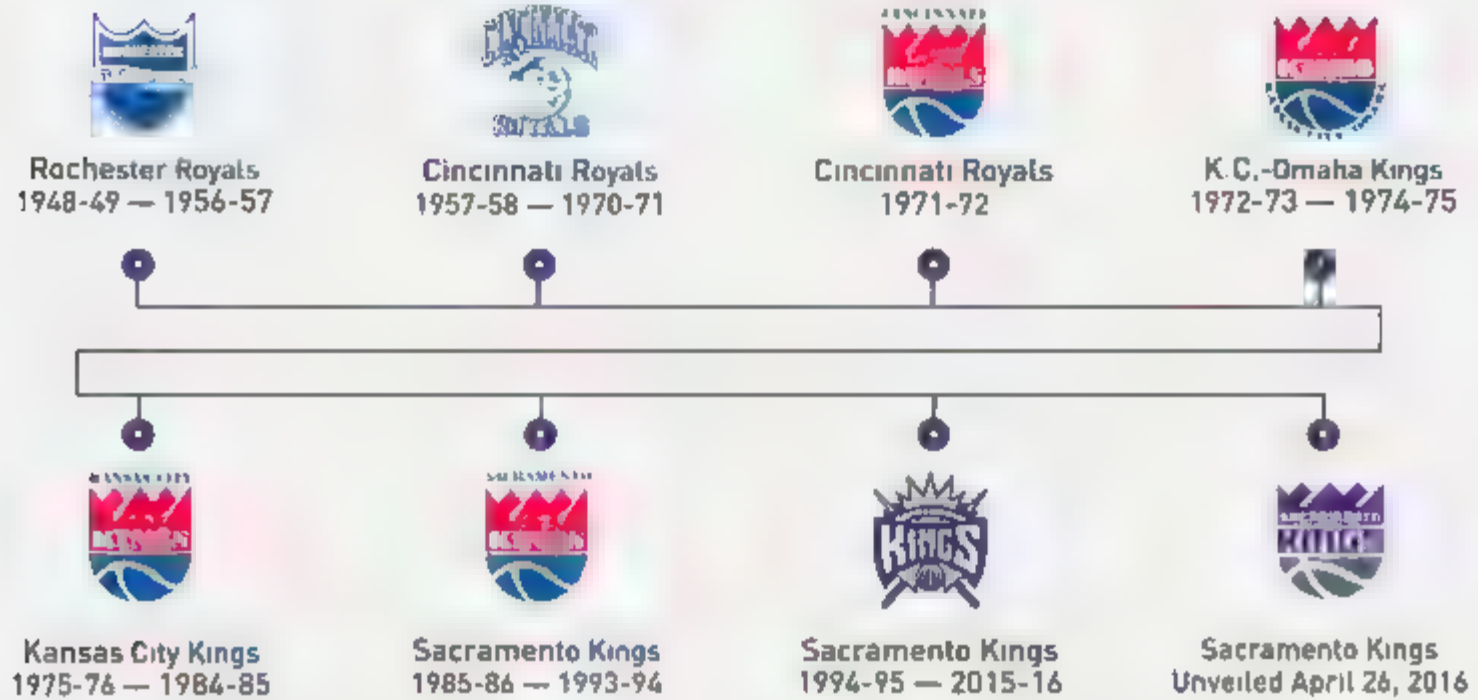


Paul Johnson begins his fifth season with the Kings and third as Vice President of Player Development with involvement in multiple aspects of Kings basketball operations. He previously led the Stockton Kings front office as the team's General Manager and was named the 2022-23 NBA G League Basketball Executive of the Year. Johnson has more than 10 years of experience in the NBA, previously serving as the Assistant General Manager of the NBA G League's Oklahoma City Blue prior to his arrival in Sacramento.

Prior to that promotion, Johnson was a Pro Evaluation Coordinator for the Oklahoma City Thunder. He has also worked as a Referee Operations Analyst with the NBA. Johnson played collegiate basketball at La Salle University in the Atlantic 10 Conference where he was team captain and graduated in 2009.

## THE EVOLUTION OF THE KINGS' PRIMARY LOGO

A chronological look at the evolution of the Kings' primary logo over the franchise's 68-season history



The Rochester National Basketball League franchise was originally nicknamed the Royals in 1946 after 15-year-old Richard Paeth's entry beat out 500 other suggestions in a name the team contest. For his winning entry, Paeth, a native of Rochester, received a \$100 Victory Bond from team president/manager Les Harrison. When the franchise moved to Cincinnati before the 1957-58 campaign, the ownership decided to maintain the Royals moniker. However, when the franchise moved to Kansas City prior to the 1972-73 season, it needed a new nickname because the name Royals was already being used by the city's Major League Baseball team. Wanting to keep the "Royal" theme, the club decided on the nickname of Kings.

On May 22, 1994, the Sacramento Kings unveiled a new primary logo, home and road uniforms, and team colors. The changes marked the first major alteration from the crown and ball logo which had been the franchise's trademark since the club resided in Cincinnati.

On April 26, 2016, the Kings shared a new brand identity with fans during a special preview of Golden 1 Center, the team's future downtown home currently under construction.

"When the Kings moved to Sacramento in 1985, the city was transformed. Today, we aim to do it again," said Owner and Chairman Vivek Ranadive.

"This brand kicks off a new era for our franchise as we move into the most technologically advanced, most environmentally-friendly arena in the world. As Sacramento becomes the next great American city, this identity honors our heritage while moving us forward."

The new primary emblem is inspired by the Kings classic logo. It is reimagined to reflect the civic and franchise pride that has lasted and grown for a generation. Now, with a clean, modern look - a reshaped crown, refined basketball and new typeface that puts Sacramento front and center - the new identity draws from the team's ambitious beginnings and reminds our region

and the world that Sacramento is undergoing a transformation.

Each of the team's new insignia are designed to connect to the elements that define the Sacramento Kings: Our City. Our Pride. Our Foundation.

The secondary logo featuring the lion, pays tribute to the unmatched pride and loyalty of the NBA's best fans. The "Sac" badge is dedicated to the bold and unwavering devotion the Kings organization has for its city. A new crown logo reflects the rich tradition of the team dating back to its origins, reminding the fanbase and the community of Sacramento that, "we are all Kings." The heralding lion crest represents leadership and strength and will be used as the Kings work to make basketball the premier global sport of the 21st century.

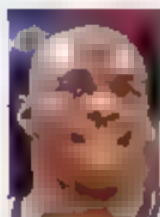

# KINGS RETIRED JERSEYS



**NATE ARCHIBALD:** Nate "Tiny" Archibald played six of his 13 NBA seasons with the Kings franchise. Selected by the Cincinnati Royals in the second round of the 1970 NBA Draft, Archibald started in six NBA All-Star Games. The 6-1, 180-pound guard posted his best season in 1972-73, averaging a career-best 34.0 ppg and 11.4 apg, becoming the only player in NBA history to lead the league in both scoring and assists. Archibald was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 1991.



**MITCH RICHMOND:** Mitch Richmond became the first player in Sacramento era history to have his jersey retired (December 5, 2003). Richmond ranks among the top five in franchise history in points, field goals made and attempted, free throws made and attempted, free throw percentage, steals, three pointers made and attempted, and three-point field goal percentage. He became the first Sacramento King to be named to the All-Star Game, and earned the All-Star MVP award in 1995 after tallying 23 points in 22 minutes off the bench. A sophomore with Sacramento, Richmond represented the United States in the 1996 Olympics, winning a gold medal. On August 8, 2014, Richmond was inducted into the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame.



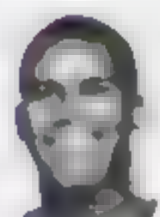
**CHRIS WEBBER:** One of the most talented forwards to ever don a Kings jersey, Chris Webber helped the Kings reach the NBA Playoffs in six straight seasons (1998-99 - 2003-04), earn two back-to-back Pacific Division titles (2001-02, 2002-03) and record a franchise record 61 regular season wins in 2001-02. Acquired from Washington in exchange for Mitch Richmond and Otis Thorpe on May 4, 1998, Webber recorded 51 points and 26 rebounds on January 5, 2001 versus Indiana, both Sacramento era single game records. As a King, Webber was a four-time NBA All-Star and a five-time All-NBA Team selection. He averaged 23.5 ppg, 10.6 rpg, 4.8 apg, 1.5 spg and 1.47 bpg in 377 games with Sacramento. His jersey was retired on February 6, 2009 (Kings vs. Utah).



**6TH MAN (THE FANS):** The No. 6 jersey was retired to acknowledge the support of the Kings fans. The Kings have two of the highest consecutive sell-out streaks in NBA history. A sell-out streak of 497 games stands as the fourth longest sell-out streak in NBA history. The milestone streak began on opening night in 1985, the first season the Kings played in Sacramento, and ended after the second game of the 1997-98 season. From November 26, 1999, to April 18, 2001, the Kings sold out 354 straight home contests, ranking eighth on the NBA's all-time sell-out list. The team sold out every home game in the Golden 1 Center's opening season.



**BOBBY DAVIES:** Bobby Davies, known as the Harrisonburg Houdini, played a total of 10 of his NBA seasons with the Rochester Royals (1945-46 - 1954-55). His two free throws in the final 40 seconds of regulation broke a 75-75 tie in the seventh and deciding game of the 1951 NBA Finals against New York, helping give the franchise its first and only NBA Championship. The four-time All-Star averaged 16.2 ppg, 2.9 rpg, and 6.0 apg in his best statistical season in 1951-52. A 6-1, 175-pound guard, Davies was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 1969.



**MAURICE STOKES:** The 6-7, 240-pound forward played all three of his seasons for the franchise, playing his first two seasons with Rochester (1955-56 - 1956-57) and his last with Cincinnati (1957-58). In his first season, Stokes was named NBA Rookie of the Year and was named to the All-NBA Second Team, posting team highs of 16.8 ppg (11th in NBA), 16.3 rpg (2nd in NBA), and 4.9 apg (9th in NBA). An All-Star in all three seasons, Stokes averaged 16.4 ppg, 17.3 rpg, and 5.3 apg in 1,011 career games. His brilliant career was cut short when he was diagnosed with post-traumatic encephalopathy (brain injury damaging motor control center) after a fall suffered three days earlier in a game against the Minneapolis Lakers (3/12/58).



**OSCAR ROBERTSON:** Known as the Big O, Oscar Robertson displayed an uncanny all-around game. Finishing his 12-year NBA career with 25.7 ppg, 7.5 rpg, and 9.5 apg in 1,040 career games, He played 10 of his 14 NBA seasons with the Cincinnati Royals. His best season came in 1961-62 when the 6-5, 210-pound guard became the first player in NBA history to average a triple double for a season (30.8 ppg, 12.5 rpg, 11.4 apg). He averaged 30 or more points in six of his first seven seasons in the league and 10 or more assists in five of his first seven seasons. Robertson, who led the league in assists in six seasons, ranks among the NBA's all-time leaders in scoring (1,0th), assists (6th), and points (112th). The 12-time All-Star was inducted into the Basketball Hall of Fame in 1979.



**PEJA STOJAKOVIC:** Drafted by the Kings in the first round (14th overall) of the 1996 NBA Draft, Peja Stojakovic went on to play 13 NBA seasons, eight with Sacramento, and finished his career as a three-time NBA All-Star, NBA Champion (2011 Dallas Mavericks), and the Kings' franchise leader in three-pointers made (1,070), and attempted (2,687) and free throw percentage (.893). He ranks in the top 10 in NBA history in several categories, including fifth in career free throw percentage (.893), 18th in three-pointers made (1,760), and tied for eighth with Steve Nash in playoff free throw percentage (.900). His #18 jersey was retired on December 16, 2014, during halftime of the Kings' Thunder game.

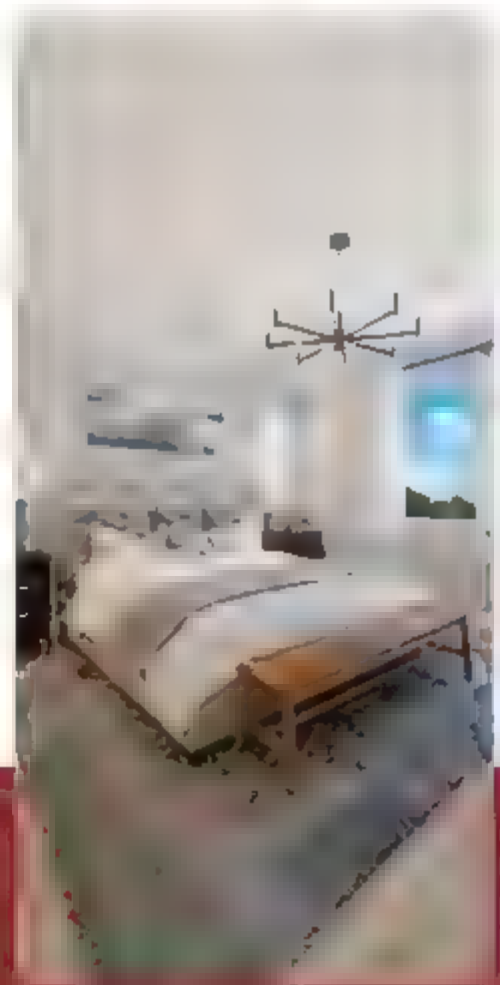

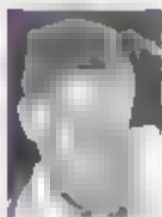

**VLADÉ DIVAC** Known for his craftiness on the court and his generosity off of it, Vlade Divac signed with the Kings as a free agent on January 22, 1999. Divac helped the Kings reach the NBA Playoffs in six straight seasons (1998-99 - 2003-04), while capturing two back-to-back Pacific Division titles (2001-02, 2002-03) and a franchise record 61 regular season wins in 2001-02. An All-Star in 2001, Divac played six of his 16 NBA seasons with the Kings, averaging 13.2 ppg, 7.8 rpg, 3.7 apg and 1.14 bpg in 454 games with Sacramento. He is one of 15 players in NBA history to amass 13,000 points, 9,000 rebounds and 1,500 blocks in a career. His jersey was retired on March 31, 2009 (Kings vs. New Orleans).



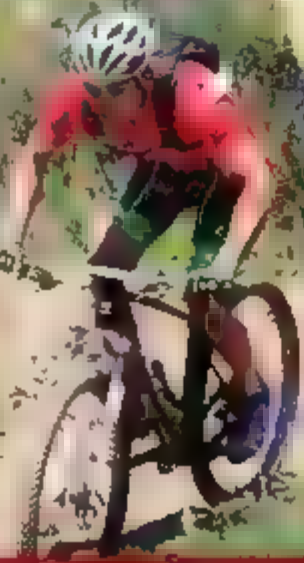
**JACK TWYMAN** A 6-6 guard from Cincinnati, Jack Twyman played all 11 of his NBA seasons with the Kings franchise, two coming in Rochester (1955-56 and 1956-57) and the other nine seasons (1957-58 - 1965-66) in his hometown. Twyman averaged 14 or more points in his first 10 seasons and averaged 31.2 ppg, 8.9 rpg, and 3.5 apg during the 1959-60 regular season. In 1958-59, Twyman ranked second in the league in scoring, posting a 25.8 scoring average. Twyman twice scored 50 or more points in his career, including a 59-point performance versus Minneapolis (1/15/60) which still remains as the Kings franchise single-game scoring record. Among franchise career leaders, Twyman ranks second in points (15,840), field goals made (6,237) and attempted (13,873), and free throws made (3,366, and attempted (4,325). The Hall of Fame inducted the six-time All-Star guard in 1982.



**SAM LACEY** Sam Lacey, a 6-10, 235-pound forward out of New Mexico State, played 11 of his 13 NBA seasons with the Kings franchise. The first selection of the Royals in the 1970 NBA Draft, Lacey averaged a double-double in points and rebounds in his first six seasons in the league. Lacey stands as the franchise leader in games played (1,888) and rebounds (9,353). He ranks in second in minutes played (29,991), fifth in points (9,895) and fourth in field goals made (4,101) and field goals attempted (9,280).

### 2024 YEAR IN REVIEW

#### DO GOOD SUMMIT presented by Raley's

The Sacramento Kings hosted the tenth annual Do Good Summit, an occasion for nonprofits to learn more about the organization's work in the community, including its initiatives and priorities. The event drew nearly 200 organizations and featured presentations by the Sacramento Kings, Stockton Kings, River Cats, and NBA Foundation. The NBA G League prepares players, coaches, officials, trainers, and front office staff while acting as the league's research and development laboratory. Before the club moved to Stockton in 2018, the team was based in Reno, Nevada, where they were known as the Reno Bighorns.

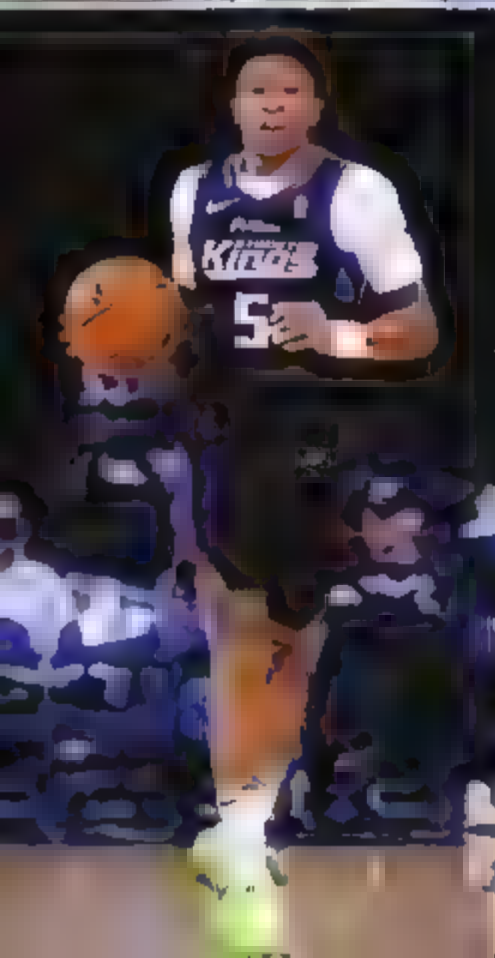

**MASON JONES**

In February 2024, Sacramento signed and then converted guard Mason Jones to a two-way contract. Last season, Jones averaged 15.1 ppg (51.1% FG, 47.7% 3p, 85.2% FT), 4.9 rpg, 7.8 apg, 1.0 spg, and 31.0 mpq in 25 games (.23 starts) and logged a triple double for Stockton in the 2023-24 season, tying the franchise record. A member of Sacramento's 2024 Summer League roster, Jones averaged 5 GP, 27.4 mpg, 47.7% FG, 35.0% 3p, 93.8% FT, 5.8 rpg, 5.8 ast, 2.0 spg. Jones played collegiately at the University of Arkansas, where he was voted SEC Co-Player of the Year (AP, 2019-20), a four-time SEC Player of the Week, and ranked fourth in the NCAA for most 30-point games in 2019-20. This season, Jones is averaging 24.3 points, 3.8 rebounds, and 8.5 assists through 33.5 minutes per game in four games (four starts) with the Stockton Kings.

**DEXTER DENNIS**

In September 2024, the Stockton Kings signed Dexter Dennis, who came off a season with the Dallas Mavericks/Texas Legends after going undrafted in the 2023 NBA Draft. Dennis played collegiately at Wichita State (2018-2021) and Texas A&M (2021-23). At Wichita State, Dennis averaged 8.8 ppg (36.8% FG, 34.4% 3p, 76.5% FT), 5.0 rpg, 1.1 apg, and 27.7 mpq in 112 games (194 starts). Dennis was the AAC Defensive Player of the Year (2022), AAC All-Freshman Team (2019), AAC All-Academic Team (2019), and a four-time AAC Player of the Week. At Texas A&M, Dennis averaged 9.5 ppg (39.2% FG, 31.0% 3p, 77.1% FT), 5.7 rpg, and 1.2 apg in 28.7 mpg in 34 games (34 starts). He ranked third on the team in ppg (19.5) and had a team best of 5.8 rpg. Currently for Stockton, Dennis is averaging 13.2 ppg (40.2% FG, 39.6% 3p, 80.0% FT), 4.6 rpg, 2.3 apg, 1.2 spg, and 33.8 mpq in nine games (eight starts) on the season. He has scored double digits in seven of nine games this season, with a season high of 19 points.



**HEAD COACH**

**QUINTON CRAWFORD**

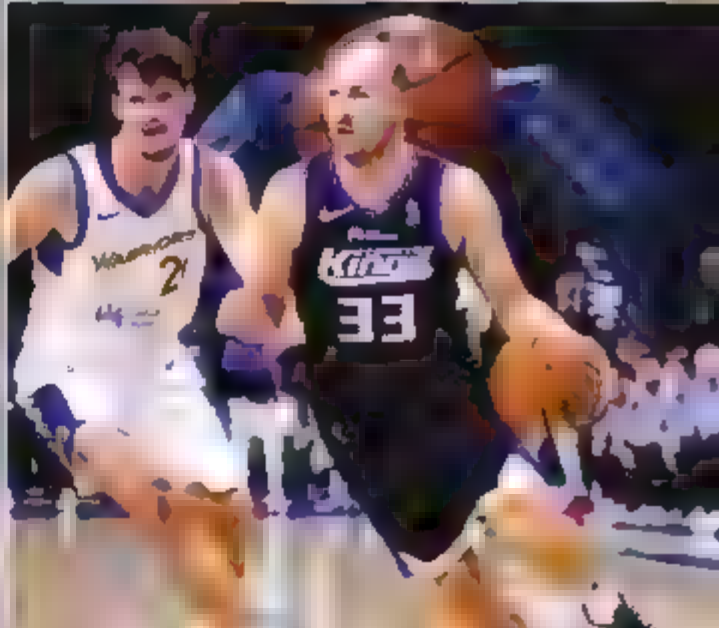
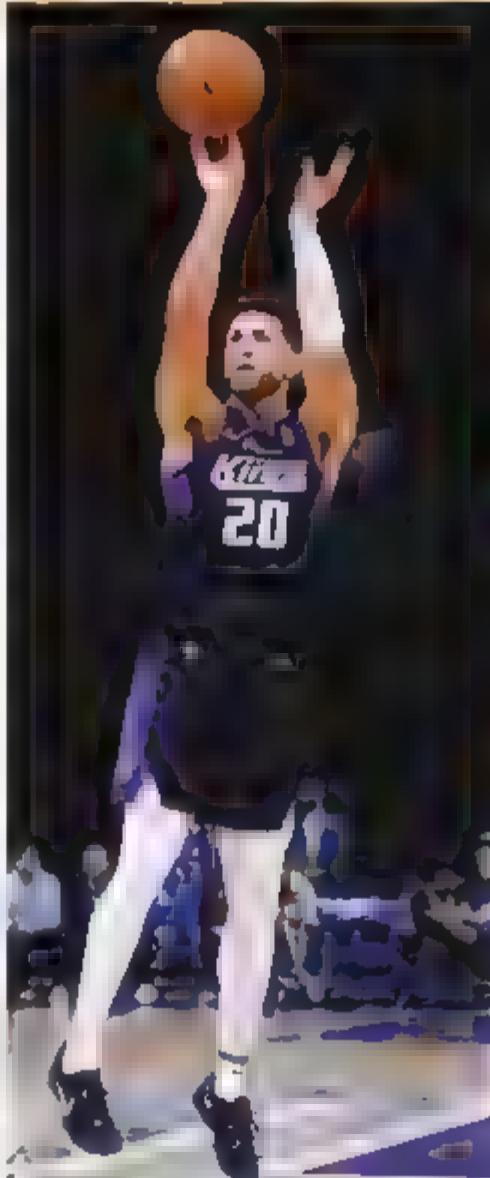
In October 2024, the Stockton Kings named Quinton Crawford as their new head coach. Crawford joins Stockton after spending last season as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns. Prior to the Suns, he served as an assistant coach with the Dallas Mavericks and the Los Angeles Lakers where he helped the Lakers win their 17th NBA championship title in 2020. Before joining the Lakers, he served as the head video coordinator and player development coach with the Charlotte Hornets. Previously, Crawford worked for the Orlando Magic serving as head video coordinator with a role in player development. Crawford began his professional career as an assistant video coordinator with the Sacramento Kings in the 2015-16 season.

The Old Bridge, New Jersey native played collegiately at Middlesex Community College (2008-2010) in Edison, before joining the University of Arizona Wildcats as a walk-on transfer (2011-13). His tenure in Arizona included a Sweet 16 run in 2013. He later earned his master's degree in education/psychology from Pepperdine University where he served as a graduate manager and video exchange coordinator for two seasons (2013-15) for the men's basketball program. Crawford becomes Stockton's 11th head coach in franchise history.

**GENERAL MANAGER**

**GABRIEL HARRIS**

In the offseason the organization named Gabriel Harris as the team's general manager. Harris is in his second season with Stockton, having served as the assistant general manager for the Kings last season. He assisted in building the roster that achieved the G League's best record during the 2023-24 season. The former Stanford Cardinal was a four-year scholarship athlete and was selected to the PAC 12 All Academic Honorable Mention team. Harris earned his bachelor's degree in psychology (2009-2013) and master's degree in communication and media studies (2014-15). He later earned certification from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology Applied Data Science Program (2022-23). The Birmingham, Alabama native played professionally for the Pee Dee Vipers of the Premier Basketball League.

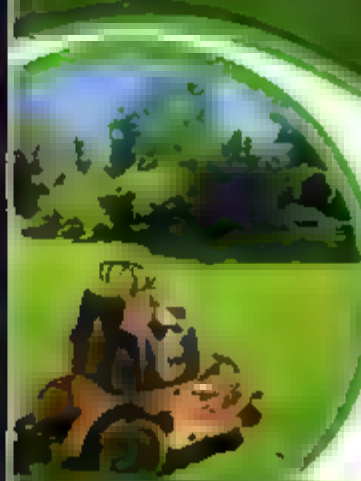

**FIT KIDS**

**209 PANTRY**

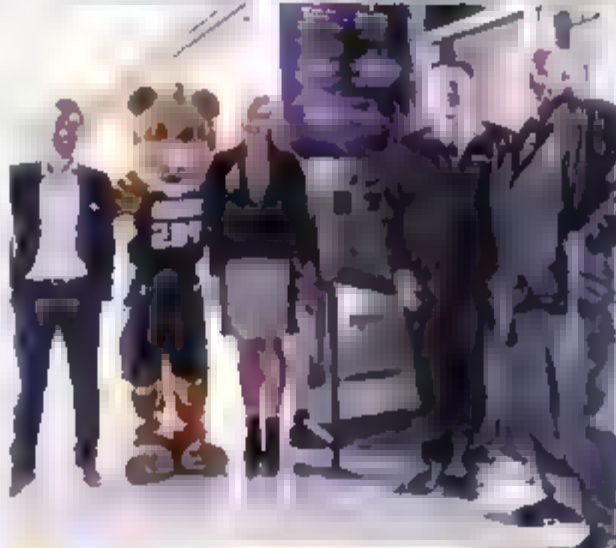
